MINUTES SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL JULY 18, 2024, 5:45 p.m.

The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Special Called Council Meeting on Thursday, July 18, 2024, in a meeting room of Spirit Walk Ministries.

PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION Councilmember Bixler gave the invocation.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Bixler, Gray, and Hickman. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa Cook and Town Attorney Nancy Kirby.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Bigley asked the Council to review the meeting agenda. He called for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made and seconded.

NEW BUSINESS

Ordinance 2024-9 Police Jurisdiction

Pertaining to the Ordinance 2024-9, Mayor Bigley gave a summary of the Attorney General's Opinion received by the Town on establishing a police jurisdiction. Information was provided of the ordinance and reviewed by the Council. A motion to adopt this ordinance was made and seconded. Mayor Bigley called a roll call vote. All present voted in favor of passing this ordinance. Mayor Bigley thanked Attorney Kirby for her efforts getting the Attorney General's Opinion.

Update on Avenu and Sales Tax

Mayor Bigley and Town Clerk Cook provided an update of the collection of sales tax that was effective July 1, 2024. Avenu had contacted all but two businesses in the Town limits and police jurisdiction to ensure they had received the informational letter on the implemented taxes and directed them to register online with Avenu.

Probate Office Billings

It was discussed the current billings from the Probate Office for the annexations. These billings total \$173 and are to be paid as long as the funds are in the Town's checking account.


Upcoming Billings
