

# Town of Pine Level

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## MINUTES REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MARCH 13, 2025, 5:45 p.m.

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The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Regular Meeting on Thursday, March 13, 2025, in a meeting room of Spirit Walk Ministries.

### PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION Pastor Mack Farley gave an invocation.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Zachary Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Bixler, Gray, Hickman, Moore and Worcester. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa Cook and Town Attorneys Nancy Kirby and Nikki Ivey.

Before the meeting began, those in attendance sang Happy Birthday to Attorney Ivey.

### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Bigley asked the Council to review the meeting agenda. A motion was made to approve the agenda by Councilmember Gray and seconded by Councilmember Hickman.

Mayor Bigley called for a motion to approve the minutes as reviewed. Motion was made by Councilmember Moore and was seconded by Councilmember Worcester. The motion carried by majority vote.

### OLD BUSINESS

#### Town Hall Property Update

Mayor Bigley provided an overview of the property status. He stated that he had been encouraged to contact the YMCA concerning the property's swimming pool and they are not interested in the use of the pool.

#### Business License Ordinance

Mayor Bigley provided an update on the review and status of this ordinance. An ordinance will be purposed at a later date.

#### Lawrence Annexation Requests

The three ordinances for the annexation of the Steve Lawrence property were presented to the Council. A motion to approve these annexation ordinances was made by Councilmember Moore and was seconded by Councilmember Gray. The motion passed with no objections.

#### Legislative Annexation

Mayor Bigley provided an update. He had talked with property owner Richard Waugh about attending the meeting but was unable to attend. Mayor Bigley said the Mr. Waugh is in favor of the legislative annexation.

#### Town Logo Use Request

Mayor Bigley called on Michael Petty to share information on the PLCC request to use the Town's logo. He stated as he understood it that the logo would be used on the restroom doors and the score board. He shared that the score board would be vinyl wrapped and the art class would possibly be painting the logo. There were discussions of the current Pepsi score board, Marbury Youth League and a written agreement of logo use. Usage on a case-by-case basis motion was made by Councilmember Hickman and was seconded by Councilmember Gray.

### NEW BUSINESS

#### Financial Report – February, 2025

Mayor Bigley reviewed the reports aloud. Councilmember Gray asked about road maintenance and there was a brief discussion on this. A motion to accept the report as presented was made by Councilmember Moore and seconded by Councilmember Worcester. This passed unanimously.

#### Councilmember Position Ordinance 2025-22

This ordinance designates that there are five council seats elected at large. These are number Council Positions. There was a motion made by Councilmember Worcester to suspend the rules of order and was seconded by Councilmember Bixler. Attorney Kirby provided clarification to the Council of the reasons this necessary with a Council At Large. Passed unanimously by roll call vote. A motion to adopt this ordinance was made by Councilmember Worcester and seconded by Councilmember Gray. This passed unanimously.

#### Legislative Annexation

Mayor Bigley provided a summary of this annexation and the process. He stated that he will be speaking at the Autauga County Commission Meeting on March 18, at 5:00 p.m. He invited the Council to attend the meeting as well. A motion to suspend the rules of order was made by Councilmember Worcester and seconded by Councilmember Gray. All voted in favor of this. On Resolution 2025-11, a motion was made by Councilmember Moore and seconded by Councilmember Worcester. This resolution passed unanimously.

#### Ordinance 2025-26: CAEC/Rural Loan Promissory Note (Town Hall Project)


