MINUTES SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MAY 20, 2024, 5:45 p.m.

The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Special Called Council Meeting on Thursday, May 20, 2024, in a meeting room of Spirit Walk Ministries.

PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION Councilmember Bixler gave the invocation.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Bixler, Gray, and Worcester. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa L. Cook.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Bigley asked the Council to review the meeting agenda. He called for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Councilmember Worcester and seconded by Councilmember Bixler.

NEW BUSINESS

Pertaining to the annexation Ordinance 2024-10, Autauga County Board of Education, Mayor Bigley gave a summary of the amendments being made to the ordinance. There was a motion to suspend the rules of order by Councilmember Worcester and was seconded by Councilmember Gray. A roll call vote was conducted by Mayor Bigley and it was passed unanimously. A motion was made by Councilmember Worcester to pass the Ordinance 224-10 as amended. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Bixler. The amended ordinance passed unanimously.

OTHER DISCUSSIONS

Mayor Bigley shared that we are getting phone calls and emails concerning the Town limits, annexation opportunities and subdivision zoning. He stated that there is a possible 244 home neighborhood being built. It was discussed that the Planning & Development Committee should discuss the future zoning within the Town limits. Councilmember Worcester shared information on the coding within a municipality.

GENERAL DISCUSSIONS

- Mayor Bigley stated that Central Alabama Electric Cooperative has requested a zoning change to the Autauga County Commission at a future meeting.
- There was a discussion of having a memorandum of understanding versus a contract to conduct future building inspections.

- There was a discussing of changing the work session to the day of the regular council meeting dates.
