MINUTES REGULAR MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MAY 9, 2024, 5:45 p.m.

The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Regular Meeting on Thursday, May 9, 2024, in a meeting room of Spirit Walk Ministries.

PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION Councilmember Bixler gave the invocation.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Bixler, Gray, Hickman, and Worcester. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa Cook, Town Attorneys Nancy Kirby and Nikki Ivey.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Bigley asked the Council to review the meeting agenda. He called for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Councilmember Worcester and seconded by Councilmember Bixler.

Mayor Bigley made a motion and was seconded by Councilmember Worcester.

OLD BUSINESS

Ordinance 2024-2, Sales & Use Tax

Mayor Bigley read the amendments to the ordinance. A motion to suspend the rules of order was made by Councilmember Hickman and was seconded by Councilmember Worcester. A motion the adopt the amended ordinance was made by Councilmember Worcester and was seconded by Councilmember Bixler. By roll call vote, the amended ordinance passed unanimously.

REPORT OF MAYOR

Mayor Bigley provided an update on the Independence Day Celebration being held on July 6, 2024. He provided the number of vendors, food trucks and parade entries. He stated that the Town needs more volunteers and that there has been positive feedback of this event.

Mayor Bigley shared information on the Marbury High School Graduation being held on May 21 and the need for more parking volunteers.

Mayor Bigley presented the logo chosen by the Council. A motion was made by Councilmember Worcester to accept the submitted logo designed by Nicole Moates, Marbury High School, as the Town Logo. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Bixler and this passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Financial Report Mayor Bigley read the report aloud.

Cash App & Venmo There was a discussion of the forms of accepting payments. It was decided that there should be more research into these before implementing these.

Town Limit Signage Mayor Bigley provided a status report on the signage. It was discussed the need for four signs. Mayor Bigley shared that the estimated cost will be \$300 – \$400.

Town Limit Map The current map was provided to the council and it was noticed that the northern boundary was incorrect. Town Clerk Cook stated that she would contact Marshall Anderson with the Central Alabama Regional Planning & Development Council for the map to be redrawn.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public to comment.

Councilmember Bixler asked if there were any current annexations. Mayor Bigley stated there were none at that time.

Attorney Kirby stated that there is no update on the Attorney General's Opinion request submitted on the police jurisdiction of the Town.

Mayor Bigley shared that there will now be required training for elected officials through the Alabama League of Municipalities. Governor Kay Ivey just signed this bill into law.

Mayor Bigley thanked the Autauga County Sheriff's Office Deputy for his attendance at the meeting and that we appreciate their efforts to provide safety for our Town and community.

ADJOURNMENT There being no further business the meeting was adjourned present.
