MINUTES SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL NOVEMBER 23, 2025, 5:45 p.m.

The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Special Called Meeting on Sunday, November 23, 2025, in a meeting room of the Town of Pine Level Town Hall.

PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION

An invocation was given by Pastor Mack Farley.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Zachary Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Bigley called roll. In attendance were Councilmember Greg Bixler, Councilmember Jae Gray, Councilmember Randy Hickman, Councilmember Noell Moore, Attorney Nancy Kirby, and Clerk Theresa Cook.

PUBLIC HEARING

Resolution No. 2025-31: Contribution to Pine Level Community Center/Christmas Event

Mayor Bigley gave a summary of this proposal of \$8,500. To pass this Resolution, a motion to suspend the meeting rules by Councilmember Gray and seconded by Councilmember Moore. This passed unanimously; with Councilmember Gray abstaining. Mayor Bigley called for a motion to pass this Resolution. A motion was made by Councilmember Hickman and seconded by Councilmember Bixler. This passed unanimously with Councilmember Gray abstaining.

Resolution No. 2025-32: Contribution to Marbury Middle School

Mayor Bigley called attention to this Resolution and discussed with the Council the needs that Marbury Middle School has requested help with. To pass this Resolution, a motion to suspend the meeting rules by Councilmember Moore and seconded by Councilmember Bixler. This passed unanimously. Mayor Bigley called for a motion to pass this Resolution. A motion was made by Councilmember Hickman and seconded by Councilmember Gray. This passed unanimously with excluding "wooden" from the table wording.

Mayor Bigley discussed with the Council the needs that Marbury High School has requested help with. It was decided to postpone this until additional information is received.

Yearly Audit


The information from Jackson Thornton was shared to the Council for the audit. It was decided to have two additional firms present a proposal for the audit.
