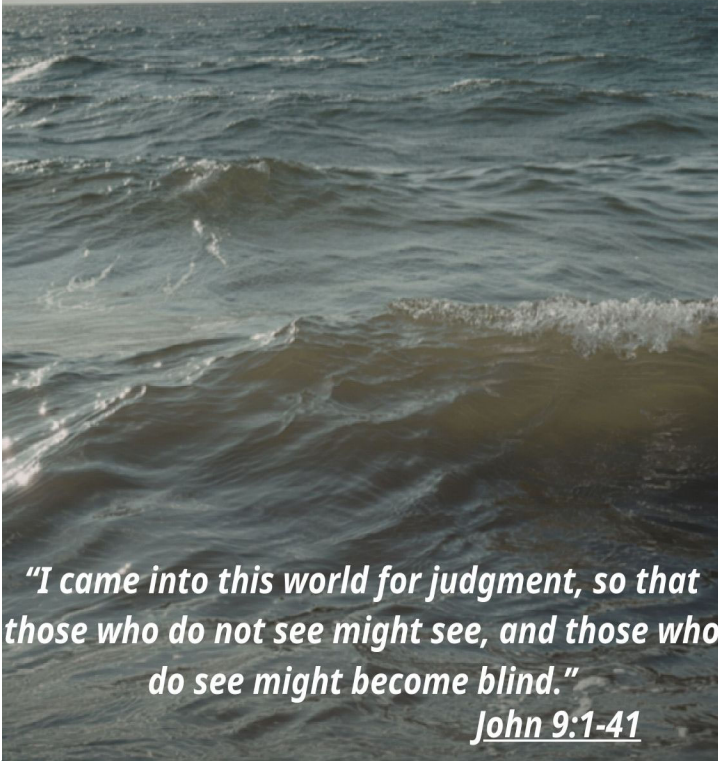

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we begin our Lenten journey and as we embrace the Church's call to penance, I want to briefly remind you what the law of the Catholic Church asks of us regarding the fasting and abstinence. Catholics from age 18 until the beginning of their 60th year are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those ages 14 and older are bound to abstain from meat on those days and on all Fridays of Lent. Fasting traditionally means one full meal, two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, and no eating between meals (liquids are permitted). Those who are ill, pregnant, elderly, or otherwise unable to fast are not strictly bound. Remember my dear brothers and sisters, these practices are not merely rules – they are gifts.

Through fasting and abstinence, we grow in self-discipline, deeper conversion of heart, and closer union with Christ's sacrifice. Let us undertake these acts of penance with love and sincerity, offering them for the glory of God and the good of our souls.
