- Attend Chamber events and activities as an Ambassador
- Serve as a representative for the Chamber in new member recruitment and welcome.
- Keep regular communication with the Chamber office at all times
- Be yourself!

SPECIFIC TASKS:

- Volunteer as a greeter at the following functions on a regular basis:
 - New Member & Current Member Grand Openings, Ribbon Cuttings, Seminars, etc
 - Chamber Business After Hours /Power Breakfasts/Coffee Connections
 - Other Chamber events (Cherry Festival, Membership Picnic, Starlight Parade, Annual Awards Banquet).

 - Participate in ambassador committee fundraising activities
 - Assist on an as-needed basis for Chamber functions and on event committees
