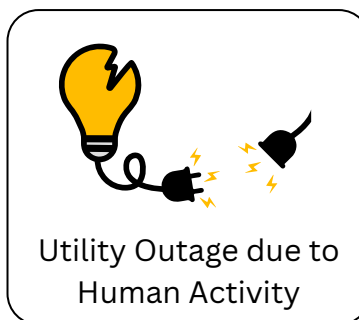


CRITICAL INCIDENT ACTIVATION GUIDE

1. Protect personnel
