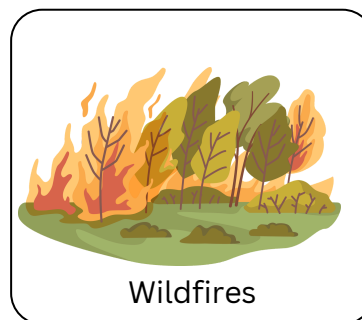
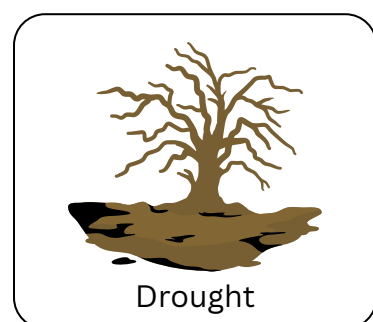
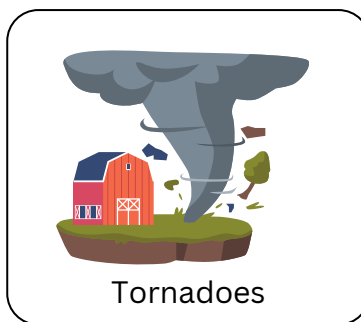
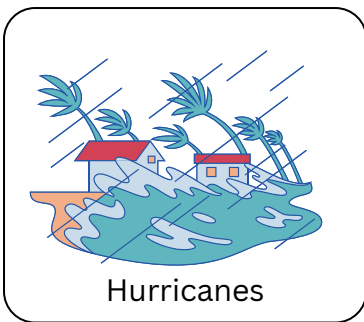
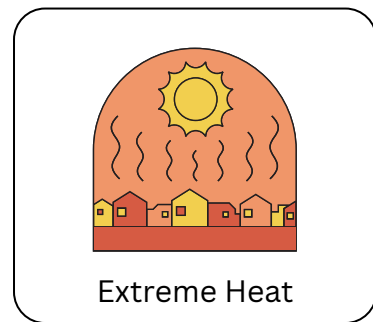
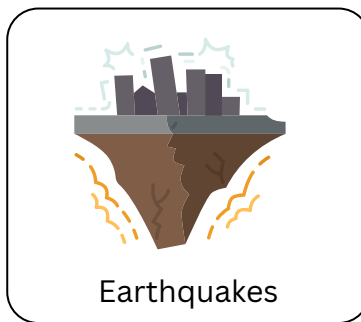
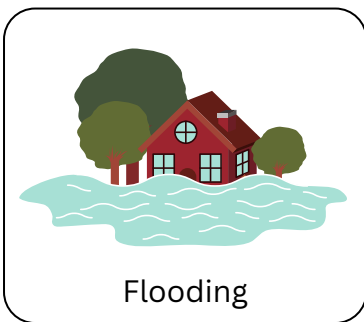


NATURAL DISASTER ACTIVATION GUIDE

D. Activation Priorities

1. Protect life and safety
2. Secure facilities
3. Protect critical records
4. Notify staff
5. Communicate with residents and clients
6. Coordinate with local emergency management

- Damage assessments
- Insurance claims
- FEMA documentation
- Service restoration
- Community recovery engagement
