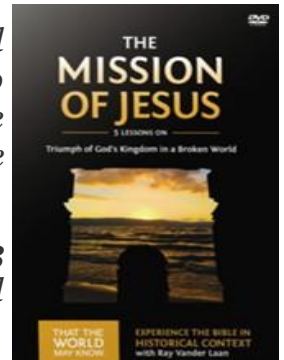
The Mission of Jesus Bible Study

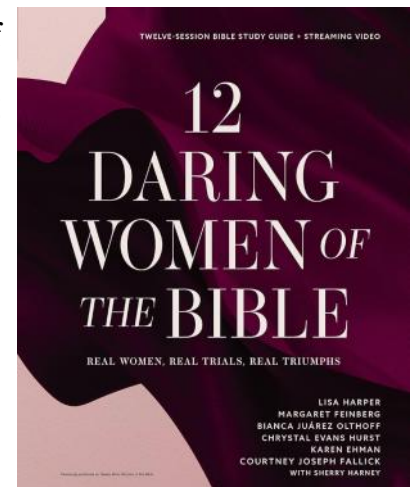
As we explore their lives, you will discover how to:

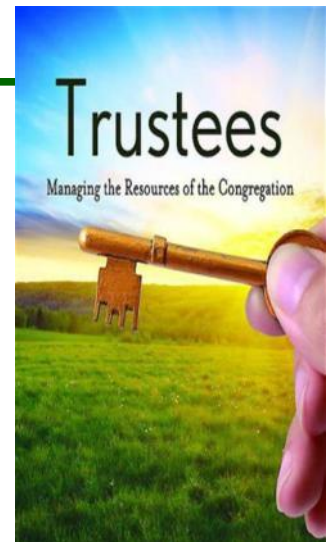
Notes from your Trustees
