Daily morning programming includes group therapy as well as group skills. Families work with their home school districts to determine the best academic programming for their child.

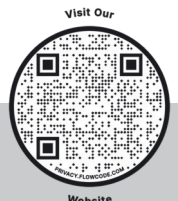
Central Minnesota Foster Grandparent Program

HOUSING COORDINATION

Provides Housing Coordination for the Four County Adult Mental Health Initiative (CAMHI) for the Bridges and CommUNITY housing vouchers. Eligibility requirements are a mental health diagnosis and residency within the four county service area.

Scattered site housing model that offers supportive housing services and teaches independent living skills through one-to-one case management for up to 24 months for youth ages 16 through 24 who are homeless or at risk of homelessness (couch hopping or eviction prevention). Short-term limited financial assistance might be available for some move in costs for a new apartment, or for 1 or 2 months past due rent to prevent eviction, all dependent upon available funding at the time of request.

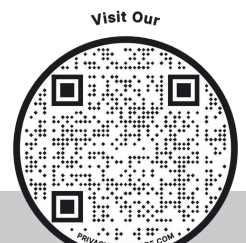
