

Catholic Century Farm Award Catholic Charities of the Diocese of St. Cloud

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of St. Cloud would like to honor Catholic families who have farmed and nurtured the same land for 100 years or more.

A registrant must be:

- Catholic family within the St. Cloud Diocese that has owned a farm for at least 100 years (current calendar year of application) according to abstract of title, land patent, original deed, county land records, court file in registration proceedings, or other authentic land records.
- Farm must be at least 50 acres and currently be involved in agricultural production.
- Family must be currently involved in farming. "Family" is defined as parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, sons, daughters, first cousins and direct in-laws (father, mother, brother, sister, daughter, son-in-law).
- Continuous residence on farm is not required, but ownership must be continuous.
- At least one family member must be a practicing Catholic.

Only one award is given in the case of shared ownership.

We are now taking applications for recognition in 2023. Registration deadline is July 1, 2023 for presentation at the 2023 special Mass with Bishop. Recipients will receive a certificate noting their inclusion on the Catholic Century Farm Registry, and an award for their home.
