## In the ‘Last Days’

*“And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh:” – Acts 2:17*

When you are planning an event, you must remember to answer the 4W’s: Who, What, When, and Where. God did that in the first part of verse 17. Let’s look at them. God did not leave us in the ‘dark’ as to what He was planning to do, when He was going to do it, or where He was going to do it. Let’s see what the scripture reveals:

**Who?** The scripture clearly tells us what **God** is planning to do. No spirit, no principalities, no power, no man can keep God from doing what He said He will do.

**What?** God reveals first in Joel 2:28 and then in Acts 2:17 that He intends to **pour out of His Spirit**. Yes, He sent the Holy Spirit or Holy Ghost to dwell inside of man on the day of Pentecost 40 days after Jesus arose from the dead. Now, He is saying He will pour out of His Spirit.

**When?** So often as we read the scriptures, we question what God is saying. We want to have **all** our questions answered. God usually doesn’t answer all of them; however, this time He is telling us that **‘in the last days’** is when He intends to pour out of His Spirit. We, however, do not know if He only meant at the end of the world as we know it, or did He also mean at the end of a person’s life? God isn’t going to reveal **all** His plans with us because we would only mess them up by trying to ‘help’ Him do what He said He will do.

**Where?** God has revealed that He will pour out of His Spirit in the last days, but we want to know where. We want to be ‘where’ the action is. That is only human nature. Guess what? You won’t be left out because God intends to pour out of His Spirit **upon ALL flesh**. That includes you! It also includes **every human being** on the earth whether they are living for God right now, are far from Him, or have rejected Him! God’s desires will not change. He wants every human!

**How?** Isn’t that just like us? We want to know ‘how’ this is going to happen as if we could do it ourselves if we knew the ‘how.’ If you will take your Bible, or use your phone, and continue reading Acts 2 verses 17 through 20 you will find the ‘how.’ God tells us that **sons, daughters, servants, and handmaidens will prophecy, young men will see visions and old men will dream dreams from God**. There will also be **wonders in heaven and signs in the earth, the sun will turn into darkness** (the light will be put out) **and the moon will turn into blood**. Yes, it also states that this will be **before** the great and notable day of the Lord coming. However, when we die, isn’t the Lord coming for us at that moment in time?

**Why?** The Lord usually doesn’t reveal to us the whole picture; however, this time He is sharing with us ‘why’ He is going to pour out of His spirit upon **all flesh** and not leave anyone out. In verse 21 of Acts 2, it reads: **“And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”** God is desiring **everyone** to call upon His name and be saved. The price of redemption has already been paid. It is now up to each individual to accept or reject God; however, God is pulling for each person to come to Him. In II Peter 3:9 it is written: **“The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.”**

God is desiring to put the enemy of our soul in his rightful place, under our feet. We **must** stand strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. He

has given us the weapons of our warfare. Let us pick them up with confidence, **claim our loved ones**, and **trust God** to do exactly what His heart wants to do in each life.

## **Deacon Johnny Kinsey's Travels** **April 14, 2026**

Deacon Johnny was selected to go on the Honor Flight to Washington, D.C. Tuesday, April 14. At 6:30 a.m. he left Toledo airport and arrived at the Reagan National Airport at 7:30 a.m. where he began a 2-hour bus ride before he reached the Marine Corp Museum.

He was on a very busy and time-constraining schedule. At 10 a.m. he arrived at the 9/11 Pentagon Memorial and Air Force monument where he saw benches that honored the deceased from the plane and employees from the Pentagon.

When he arrived at the Women's Military Memorial at 11:05 a.m. he was served a great BBQ dinner complete with cookies. By 12:30 p.m. he arrived at the Navy Memorial which featured a lone soldier by a water fountain.

1:35 p.m. found him at the Vietnam/Korean Memorial and he was able to walk to the WWII Memorial which was not a scheduled part of the tour. Pictures were taken under the OHIO pillar.

He arrived at the Arlington National Cemetery at 3:15 p.m. and was fortunate enough to view the changing of the guards. A father and a son on the trip, both veterans, were selected to lay a wreath, donated from the Findlay area, at the grave site.

He was served another meal at 4:45 p.m. and after eating and relaxing, the Honor Flight leader led him to the Martin Luther King. Time did not permit him to see the Roosevelt.

At 6:25 p.m. he arrived at the Reagan National Airport for a restroom break and the beginning of a lengthy flight home. The time of departure was delayed until 8 p.m., but still they encountered rainy weather, which required them to fly around the Columbus area before they safely landed at Grand Aire Hanger at the Toledo Airport.

Everyone on the Honor Flight was welcomed home with a surprise party where they were greeted by friends and family.
