Are You Accountable?

The world needs what God has put inside of you. God has chosen you for a particular unique purpose. No one else will have the same exact purpose you have; therefore, you are important to the Lord. What are you doing about it? What are you planning to do about it and when? Are you keeping it hidden because you don't want to be different from those around you? If that is so, could you be surrounded by the wrong group of people? Are you sharing with others what God has given you? The Bible says, "Give and it shall be given unto you good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over." Luke 6:38 Often, we hear that quoted when people are referring to financial blessings; however, it isn't limited to just finances. Do you want to know more about God? Give to others what you currently know about God and God will reward you with a closer and more intimate relationship with Him.

Why do I find it easier to trust and believe people (who may or may not be telling me the truth) than trusting God (who has proven Himself over and over for thousands of years through the scriptures). Is it because I don't keep the old landmarks – the former blessings and miracles – fresh in my mind? Is it because I listen to people who look at things from the world's perspective instead of listening to those who see things through God's eyes? Am I a constant complainer, which puts unbelief into action? Do I realize my complaining reveals my lack of faith in God?

God is always willing to help us right where we are. God told the Israelites several things to help them live holy, blessed lives. These same instructions will help us as well. 1) Be obedient to God. Whatever God says to do, don't question it,

just do it! Obedience to God welcomes His presence and His blessings and offers an environment ripe for human flourishing. Remember: obedience is your responsibility. The outcome is God's responsibility. 2) God has set you apart from all other people. People are not naturally moral or holy. God chooses who He chooses and then empowers them to live life the way He desires. Do not let the customs of other people influence or challenge how God has told you to live. It is the Lord who makes you holy - not what you think or do by yourself. However, God has instructed us to 'Be ve holy; for I am holy.' I Peter 1:16. 3) God's laws are never arbitrary. We cannot pick and choose which ones we will follow and which ones we will ignore. God's laws reveal His standards. We often think of laws as restrictions. Well, I guess they are, but let's think of them as our safety net. They keep us in God's favor and blessings; plus, they help us to avoid pitfalls set to destroy us. To live with God demands sacrifice, selfrestraint, faith, and obedience.

Take time and read about the Israelites journey from Egypt to the land of Canaan. Exodus 2:23-25, Exodus 12:31-42, Exodus 14:5-31, Exodus 16:1-36, Exodus 17:1-7, Exodus 32:1- 35 As you read you will find that God performed many miracles for them even in the midst of their complaining. Yes, God did get upset with them, well truthfully, He got very irate with them. He got so overcome with anger that God told Moses to step aside so He could destroy the Israelites. They had experienced miracles from God and then shortly after that they were overcome with distrust and unbelief in the same God that had just blessed them. Wait a minute! Don't throw any judgment stones on them, don't you and I do the same thing? God gets us out of one mess, we rejoice, and then a new situation arises, and we wonder where is God? We begin to question: Will He help me? Does He even care I'm going through this?

You know what, we need to change our thought pattern, so we are constantly thinking: I wonder how God is going to handle this in my life. Let's begin to look for expected results after we pray instead of looking for negative results. Let's begin to do what Pastor Stephen shared with us: 1) Confidently expect that God is working things out for your best. 2) Wait in prayerful worship while God is working. 3) Even in the silence, God is working behind the 4) Don't waste the "Waiting Period" strengthen your faith through the Word of God and Prayer as you worship your deliverer. Yes, God is our Deliverer! He can deliver us from any situation or problem that comes our way. Now, what are you waiting for?

- Sign up to distribute BBQ flyers and mention where you are posting them and leaving pre-order sheets.





Circumstances can never change the promises of God, but the promises of God can change your circumstances.
