PART ONE

2022-23 SEASON REVIEW

It is a pleasure to present my second Chair's Report for what I humbly consider to be the best cricket club in the world. Reflecting on the 2023/24 season, it was nice to have overseen a largely "normal" season on the field after 3 seasons of Covid and Auckland flood interruptions. It was a season of fluctuating fortunes but culminated with a bang in our first ever 'End-of season Extravaganza', a combined festivity of junior prize giving, annual Old Boys game, parents v coaches game, and lots of fun fundraising activities. Aided by celebrity appearances from two of our resident Black Caps, Jimmy Neesham and Finn Allan, the day produced the largest ever turn out I have witnessed at Ken Maunders Park in over 20 years of being involved in the Club. It was a fitting end to another busy season as the largest senior club in New Zealand but with an enthusiastic and growing junior club base to boot. We may have just started another annual tradition worth repeating every year.

Throughout the course of the season, there were many highlights that I will touch upon below and will be further detailed in the annual report that follows. However, the season was not without its challenges, the most confronting being a nearly 40% drop in our grant funding. Over the winter, we had budgeted on a small loss for the season as we looked to significantly increase our spend on coaching, but the unfortunate and unexpected decline in grant funding meant that we were forced to dip into our rainy-day fund more than we would have liked. Thankfully, the Club's finances are well placed to weather a one-off loss after a number of years of prudent management and spending, but it does mean the Committee is now very focussed on growing our revenue base through greater sponsorship and fundraising efforts to avoid large increases to fees. I therefore encourage all members to help promote and support the fundraising efforts in the coming season. The Executive already has two big events planned so please mark your calendars and get behind them: an opening season race night on 12th October and fundraising dinner with guest speaker Merv Hughes on 30th January. Both nights will be great social occasions and a chance to raise some much-needed funds. Please keep an eye out for details and get involved! With the club now boasting over 1,000 members, there are great opportunities for club members to direct market their businesses to the club base through different sponsorship options: a win-win!

The highlight of the season was arguably receiving one of New Zealand Cricket's most prestigious community awards, the Leadership in Diversity, Equity and Inclusion. The award acknowledges an association, club, or school for an innovative initiative that ensures accessible, welcoming, and inclusive cricket experiences for communities that may have previously been overlooked. Through our exceptional work on growing the women and girls' side of the club, plus our investment in programs such as Cricstars, we were recognised nationally for being leaders in growing our great game into new communities. Fittingly, this season also saw our Premier Women finish 3rd in the Pearl Dawson T20 Comp – exceeding expectations in their first season at Premier Level. At the ACA Cricket Awards, Anika Tauwhare was awarded the Rangatahi Wahine Leadership Award and Natalie Nelson won the prestigious Carson Cup as volunteer of the year for all of Auckland for her tireless work as Chair of the Suburbs Junior Committee and Western Districts Cricket. The one negative to an otherwise amazing season for the women and girls was the sad departure of Trevor Payle, who decided to step back from his dual coaching roles at Suburbs (Premier Women and Mens 3rds/4ths) after many seasons to pursue other interests. Trevor has been a huge part of growing the women's game at the Club, so we were very sad to lose him but wish him all the best for the future and know that he will continue to be part of the Suburbs family.

The 2023/24 season has also seen the Club bid farewell, at least in an official capacity, to some of our most dedicated and long serving volunteers. Natalia Nelson has relinquished the Junior Chair role but will stay on as an Executive member. Steve Pickett and Brendon Muir spent many years on the junior committee helping turn that committee into a well-oiled machine that runs our growing junior base. Malcolm Greenstreet was part of the first Junior Committee when it was reestablished 6 or so years ago, before spending the last 3 years on the Executive and this last season as one of Suburbs Trustees on the Ken Maunders Part Trust Board. All have been excellent and hardworking volunteers and on behalf of the Club, we sincerely thank you for your service. Last year's AGM witnessed the appointment of SNLCC's latest Life Member, the greatest honour the club can bestow on one of its members. Chris (Woodsy) Woods was honoured for a playing career that spanned at least 12 seasons culminating in 2950 runs @ 28.92 with 3 hundreds. More importantly, this was coupled with being part of the Executive for over

10 years. During that time, Chris held the all-important Treasurer role for 7 years over 2 stints, overseeing the Club moving to online banking and accounting software, and being part of an exceptional teams that prudently led the Club into the stable financial position it now finds itself in. Woodsy was always up for the social side of the Club as well, regularly MCing our events and being our go-to Quiz Master. Now resigned from the Exec, we look forward to Woodsy continuing to volunteer for life!

Our on-field success was somewhat mixed compared to the Club's recent high standards. We continue to invest more heavily into coaching than we ever have previously and recognise the importance of harnessing and developing our talent through junior and youth to hopefully continue to produce top quality senior cricketers. However, this must be balanced against a need to grow the game and ensure enjoyment for all. With limited funding, this is a perennial juggle for the Executive.

Congratulations to our One-Day teams the Auckland Titans and the Royal Maratha, which both won their respective competitions. In the junior space our U12 squad of two teams were both undefeated for the entire season and our U13 SS Reece Young went undefeated in the Summer Series Competition. While the Premier Women exceeded all expectations in their new competition, I think it is fair to say the Premier Men are still in a re-building phase. A T20 semi-final gave a glimpse into what might have been, but they finished mid-pack in the other competitions, although crucially maintained their top 8 slots. Club legend Michael Barry has decided to step back from playing this coming season as he and his wife look to adapt to being first time parents but will continue to coach the Premier squad. No doubt we all hope to see Baz don the Burbs colours again but if this does represent the end of the road on the field, it is important we acknowledge what a truly remarkable career it has been with 11,588 runs (@ 39) and near 286 wickets (@ 20) for the Club.

Suburbs players continue to over-represent at representative level. A huge congratulations to Adi Ashok and Ben Lister who made their debuts for the Black Caps during the season, joining our other Burbs reps, Jimmy Neesham and Finn Allan. Those four also represented the Aces throughout the season, together with Sean Solia, who captained much of the Aces campaign, and Marty Guptill, who was given a rousing farewell from Eden Park in a tribute game of sorts. Burbs old boys (but always Burbs at heart) Ajaz Patel and Jeet Raval continued to dominate for their respective associations and in Jazzy's case, when limited opportunities present at international level. Both have stayed closely connected to the club and we are grateful for them always volunteering to help out when they can. Congratulations also to the following ACA Age Group Reps: Anika Tauwhare, Divyanshi Chauhan, Liam Ireland, and Jaskaran Sandhu.

I want to conclude by thanking a few specific people. Firstly, to our long-serving General Manager, Kate Hillier-Cook. Kate brings a unique skill set to the club and does an outstanding job trying to wrangle 1,000+ members into a cohesive enterprise. Kate has signalled this coming season will be her last as General Manager so she will be leaving very intimidating shoes to fill. Kate is very ably supported by a strong Junior Committee which has seen our junior base continue to flourish. Special thanks to Natlie for her time as Chair and the many hours of service that fittingly culminated in the Carson Cup award. Finally, to the Executive Committee who volunteer their time to ensure the overall health and direction of the Club. We are blessed to have so many people willing to give up their time to see the Club do well. My sense is that the Burbs club spirit is very much alive and well and I look forward to the coming season showcasing that with renewed success.

Player of the Year Awards

The club for the second year has worked with Champion Displays to create an online template that each of our teams can use to promote and celebrate the success of their players. SNLCC Award Winners!

As a club we were delighted to be presented by New Zealand Cricket with the Leadership in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Award. This award acknowledges an association, club, or school for an innovative initiative that ensures accessible, welcoming, and inclusive cricket experiences for communities that may have previously been overlooked. The judging criteria includes how clubs or associations engages under-represented communities and provides significant cricket experiences either on or off the field.

When presenting the award NZC stated that:

“Over the past few seasons Suburbs New Lynn Cricket Club has implemented changes to their club offerings to ensure it is a place for all to enjoy cricket.

Since the implementation of a women and girls strategy and the appointment of a Women's Cricket Development Manager, the women & girls programme has gone from strength-to-strength. Looking at their local community, Suburbs New Lynn engaged the female students from a local Islamic School, IQRA. None of the girls had ever been offered cricket as a sporting option, but many took the opportunity to get involved in the club's “Girls Smash” programme led by players from the club.

Community initiatives such as this have directly translated to success of the women's programme and playing numbers at the club. This season represents the first in club history that a Premier Women's team could be fielded – who recently finished third in ACA's T20 competition.

Aware of a change in the ethnicity and gender of their membership, Suburbs knew it was important their club evolved as well. Now as a matter of course, halal and vegetarian food are always served within the club; a dedicated prayer area has been established for those who wish to use it; and they monitor the membership of their committees to ensure that their different groups are being represented.

Additionally, SNLCC have recently partnered with Ellerslie Cricket Club to deliver “CricStars” – an adaptive cricket programme for tamariki and rangatahi with physical or intellectual disabilities.

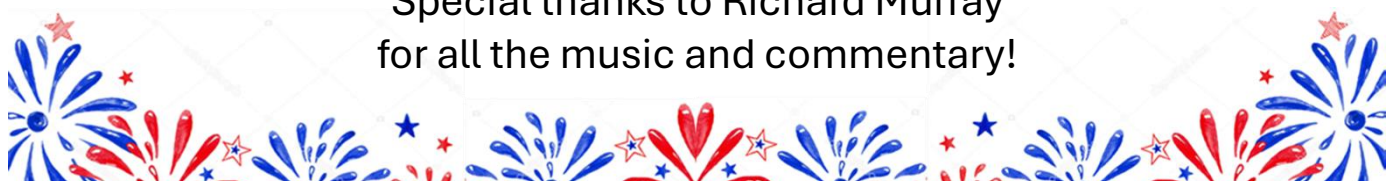

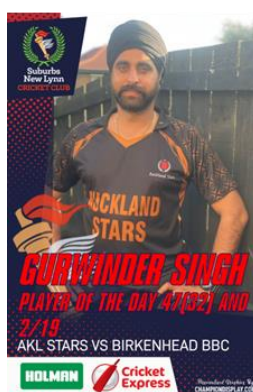

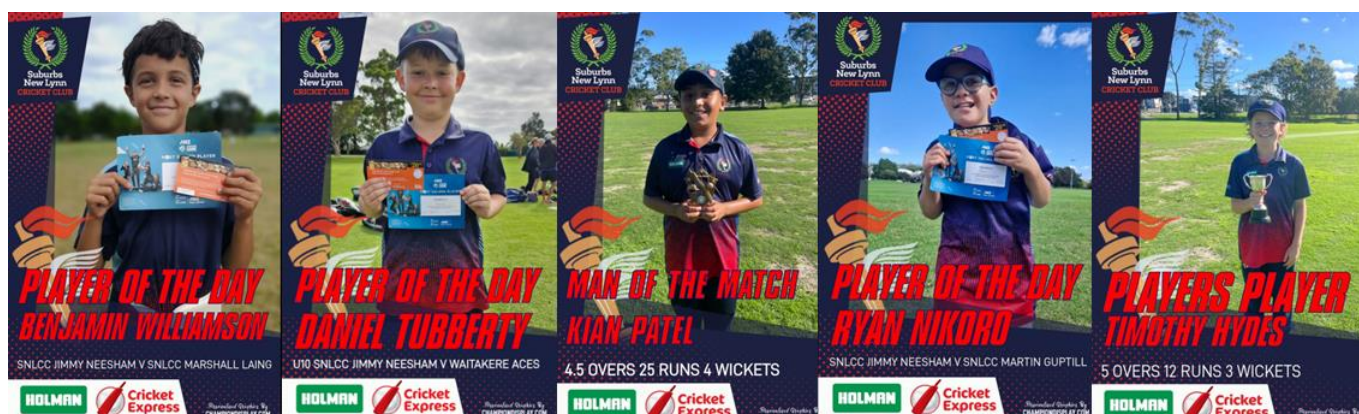

We finished off the season the way we knew we could, with a comprehensive victory over Takapuna, led with the ball by English overseas Max Tryfonos' 5-wicket bag, and closed in style by a classic Michael 'Baz' Barry batting performance with four sixes in five balls to end the season.

The developing core group of young players who contributed to the team throughout the season should give us all confidence in the future years. There is plenty to take away from this season, but there is also much more learning to come. Once again, a massive thank you to Baz for his continued support of the squad and club with his coaching and experience. Thanks to VJ—for his unceasing groundwork, to Kate, all the scorers, volunteers and supporters for their unending passion for the team that we are all so grateful for. Let's keep building!

Mens Premier Reserves Team Report

The 2023/2024 season for the Premiere Reserve Men was unfortunately a tale of being on the wrong side of some close results and key fixtures being abandoned due to weather. A young squad filled with promising talent assembles for preseason, with the added twist of developing and buying into a new squad culture. The boys were ready to hit the ground running.

The season started with a bang as we travelled to Devonport Domain and returned with an innings and 7 run win to kickstart the two-day campaign. After restricting North Shore to a respectable 226, our openers nearly completed the first innings win on day one as we would go on to amass 389. Parth Tailor scored a phenomenal 145, while Owen Marshall (our overseas player) notched up an impressive 115 in his first hit out in New Zealand. As the game looked destined for a draw late on day two, Hamish Nelson (4-12) produced his best spell of the season to ensure the innings outright victory was secured. This was followed by a narrow 5-run first innings loss to Grafton, then a heavy defeat away at Parnell in a rain affected fixture.

Come the start of December, we switched into white ball mode with the one-day and 20/20 campaigns kicking off. Disappointingly, the one-day campaign began with a string of 4 defeats, including a tight 10 run loss to 7th placed Grafton. This saw us sit rock bottom at the crunch point of the season and in search of our first points in an attempt to avoid relegation. The 20/20 campaign was also affected by rain. In the first round we convincingly defeated Kumeu by 93 runs, with Owen Marshall taking 5 for 11 in a three over spell. We then defeated Waitakere on DLS to set up a top of the table clash versus Birkenhead. However, a wet outfield prevented any play and Birkenhead progressed to the semi-finals with a superior net run rate.

Back to our favoured red-ball cricket, we quickly gathered momentum through the back half of the season and would finish a respectable fourth in the two-day competition. On the field our junior teams all had successful years whether that's measured via participation and enjoyment within the younger grades or winning games/grades amongst the older age groups all had seasons to be proud of. We had above average results in the Summer Series competitions, the U17 and U15 A teams both finishing runners up and the U13 team went undefeated throughout in their first experience in the competition. Suburbs also had 4 excellent ACA grade wins, congratulations to the U16s Downs Girls team and the U13 Barry T20 Boys team for their successful seasons. Special mention to both the LO30 U12 teams (U12 Guptill and U12 Neesham), heading into the season expectations were high amongst this squad and both delivered incredible seasons. U12 Neesham won the North/West Division whilst the U12 Guptill team won the Central/East Division, both teams went undefeated and, in the process, U12 Guptill extended their 5-year undefeated streak to 63 games. Their combined success earned the overall squad the 'Junior Team of the Year' award.

CLUB HISTORY & STATISTICS

Club History

Suburbs New Lynn Cricket Club is still relatively young having just finished our 52nd season. We were formed in 1972 as a result of the amalgamation of the Suburbs and the Blockhouse Bay - New Lynn Clubs, both old clubs with proud traditions.

In the early years Suburbs New Lynn was based at the Rosebank Road (now Eastdale Reserve) ground. We moved to Ken Maunders Park in the mid-1970's and together with the Western Districts Hockey Club built the pavilion which has been our headquarters ever since. The pavilion was built through club labour, a shining testimony to the commitment of the early members.

For 30 years the cricket and hockey clubs shared Ken Maunders Park with the Lynn-Avon Football Club which had its own separate clubrooms. In the 1990s Western District Hockey moved its base away from Ken Maunders as all club hockey began to be played on artificial turf. Then in 2010 in a major joint venture between cricket, football and the council the football clubrooms were demolished and replaced with a magnificent indoor training centre to be used by both clubs and the community.

At the same time the cricket clubrooms became home to both clubs and an independent Ken Maunders Park Trust was created to manage both the indoor training centre and the clubrooms.

Playing Success

Through the 1970's and 1980's Suburbs New Lynn fielded strong sides producing many Auckland representatives from whom Hedley Howarth, Geoff Howarth, John Reid, Peter Webb and Stuart Gillespie went on to play for New Zealand. The club's first 'golden age' took place in the 1980s. We won the Premier Two Day Championship in 1980-81 and then again in 1984-85. In that amazing season Suburbs also won the One Day Championship as well as the Grosvenor Cup for best fielding team. Suburbs also finished runners-up in the two day championship in 1987-88 and 1990-91.

The second 'golden age' arrived in the late 2000's. In the 2008-09 season for the first time in 25 years the club won the Hedley Howarth Trophy for the Premier Two-Day Championship. This was the beginning of an amazing run for the club's Premier side and was followed up with T20 titles in 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2014-15 and 2016-17. Further Two-Day Championships were added in 2011-12, 2013-14 and 2020-2021. The Jeff Crowe Cup for the Premier One-Day title was also won in the 2013-14, 2015-16 and 2019-20.

SNLCC was also awarded the Club Championship for the leading Principal Club in Auckland in the 2011-12 season. This period also saw a number of New Zealand representatives emerge, including Martin Guptill, Reece Young, Daryl Tuffey, Michael Bates, Jimmy Neesham, Jeet Raval, Ajaz Patel and most recently Kyle Jamieson, Ben Lister and Adithya Ashok. In 2021 SNLCC was also awarded the prestigious "New Zealand Community Cricket Club of the Year Award" by NZC.

50th Anniversary Book

The club has released a special book to celebrate its 50th anniversary. **'We don't play for adulation – 50 years of cricket at Suburbs New Lynn'** is packed with photos and captures many of the best stories, great characters and playing highlights of our club to this time. Copies are available for purchase from the Club Manager for just \$30.

Statistical History

In the early 1980's work was started on a Club Statistical History. By going back through the Annual Reports a profile on every player to represent Suburbs New Lynn was formed. Each year this file is updated from PlayHQ and the latest Annual Report (we are dependent on the quality of statistics lodged on PlayHQ by team captains). Record partnerships and season aggregates are also recorded. Most cricketers are statistically minded and the "Hall of Legends" have provided a lot of interest.

Over the last 24 months we undertaken a major review of the Annual Reports over the last 20 years and discovered

that a number of players have actually reached these landmarks but they had been overlooked in this Career Records section. This led to an additional 30 players being added to the batting and 75 players to the bowling. We have also discovered some runs and wickets for various players that had been previously overlooked. These have now been updated so some of the player statistics in the Hall of Legends will have changed and a number of new players now appear. Take a look and see if you are there.

There were also some significant milestones passed in 2023-24 including:

- Current players **Lithira Fonseka** and **Aman Chandi** have joined the 2000 Runs Club.
- Current outstanding Junior player **Jay Topiwala** has joined the 100 Wicket Club.
- **Bill Devereaux** has moved past Chris Fawkner to be the 2nd highest wicket taker of all time with 513 wickets (long way to go to catch Donners though).
- **Luke Devereaux** has become just the 16th player to reach 300 wickets.
- **Michael Barry** is closing in on Peter Guptill and now needs just another 314 runs to move to second on the all-time run scorer list.
- In scoring over 1000 runs this season **Xander Hibberd** features for the second time already on the Record Season Aggregates Table despite still being a junior.

In the records below current players are shown in **red**.

Postscript: It is also worth noting that we have now been able to create a comprehensive database of all players who have scored over 100 runs or taken over 10 wickets. Collating this information has been a huge task but it is now organised in such a way that it can be updated every year and players can find and review their own records as they are presented alphabetically. This means that now over 1500 past and present players can view their historical data.

Access to this statistical information will be made available before next season on the website

Treasurer's Report 2023/2024

This year saw a big financial change for the club in that we registered a loss of \$10k for the 2023/24 Financial Year. Please note that \$3k of Prizegiving expenses relate to the 2022/23 Financial Year. The club income still grew when compared to the prior year with a \$23k increase in the Trading Income which shows that the club is still in a strong position of continual growth.

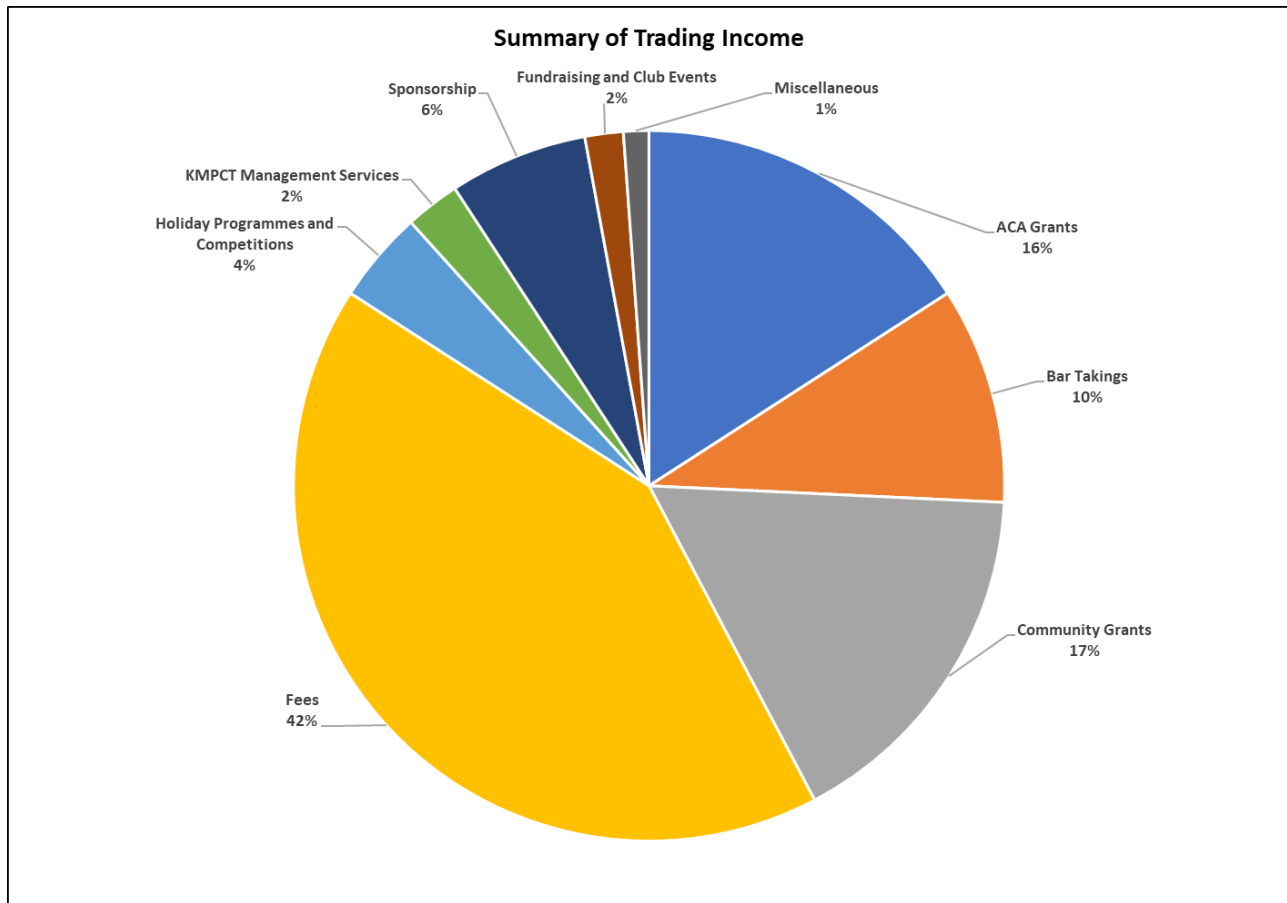
The Expenses have had a large increase as well of \$36k – as mentioned in the Chair's report this is a direct result of an intentional increased investment into the junior and youth areas of the club through increased coaching and development opportunities for members. We see this area of expenditure as necessary so that the club can continue to produce quality cricketers to represent our club.

The club has been able to manage this tougher year because of the good work and prior planning that has taken place in the prior years. The club remains in a strong financial position, however there will be an increased focus on ensuring our Income will continue to be able to cover our Expenses year on year.

Income



Key Trading Income changes from the prior year are outlined below -

Fees – Up \$22.9k on prior year

The increase in fees is due to the consistent growth in the cricket club, as well as a sign that the PlayHQ system has played a key role in ensuring fee payments are taking place.

Bar Takings – Up \$12.1k on prior year

With a less interrupted season the club saw bar takings increase with more opportunities for members to be at the bar after trainings and after games.

Holiday Programmes and Competitions – Up \$6.5k on prior year

This has increased in line with the extra investment that the club has made into the junior aspect of the club by offering holiday programmes and extra coaching opportunities to junior members.

ACA Grants – Up \$5.8k on prior year

The ACA grants have returned to the expected pre-covid amounts after years of limited availability of funding.

Community Grants – Down \$31.5k on prior year

Community Grants was the main reason for the deficit recorded in the year, being down by \$31.5k on the prior year amount. Due to the club's strong financial position and strong prior year financial performances, it was much harder to obtain these grants as the club was seen to not be needing the extra funding. 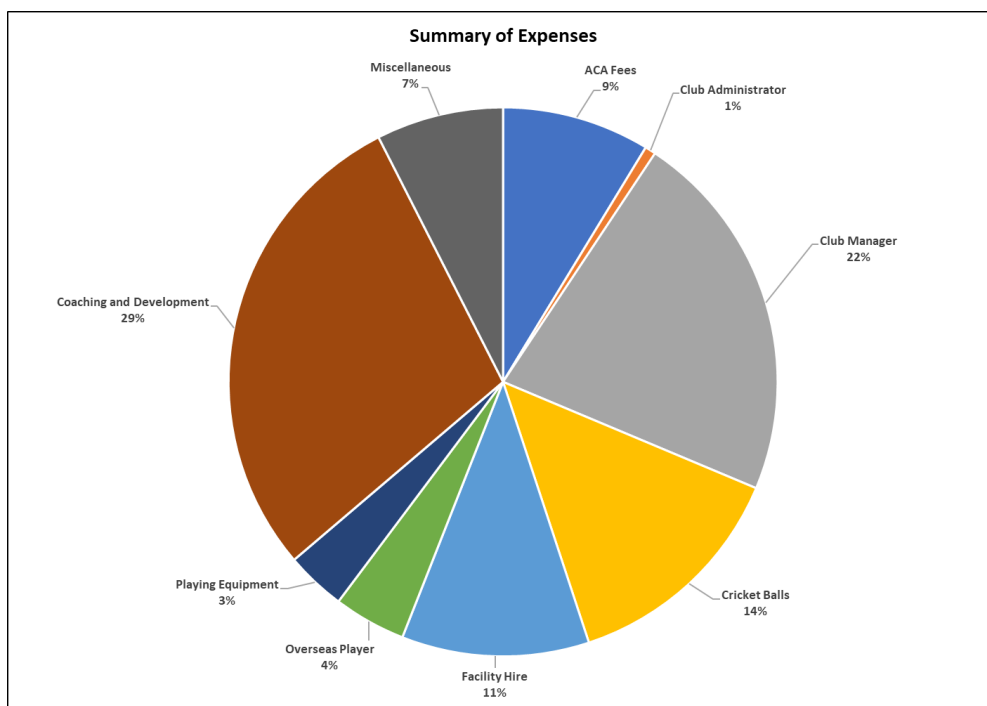

Other Income

Interest Income – Up \$4.3k on prior year

The club has made an increased effort in using spare funds to make investments that does not exceed our risk appetite. This has become small but steady source of income.

Expenses



Key Expense changes from the prior year are outlined below –

Junior and Senior Coaching and Holiday Programme and Competition Expense – Up \$22.8k on prior year

As mentioned in the annual report above there was a decision made to increase the amount spent on coaching, especially in the juniors as they are key investment in the future of the club. This has also extended through to coaching programmes during holidays and even youth cricket tournaments and camps.

Cost of Sales – Up \$14.4k on prior year

The cost of sales has increased due to the increase in demand from attendance at the bar, while also increasing due to the Premier lunches being purchased through the bar.

Overseas Player – Up \$13.1k on prior year

The club took on three overseas players this year – one for the Premier Men and two for the Premier woman.

Cricket Balls – Up \$11.7k on prior year

Through the increased playing numbers and teams and cost of cricket balls this is a necessary expense throughout the cricket season.

Prizegiving – Up \$6.4k on prior year

This amount reflects both the 2022/23 and 2023/24 seasons prizegiving's, the expenses are consistent year on year.

Clothing - Down \$17.8k on prior year

A bulk clothing order was taken in the prior year so less clothing was required this year. This balance fluctuates year by year as clothing needs to be replaced and upgraded so this is line with expectations.

Conclusion

Although the club has experienced a loss this year this was not unexpected, driven mainly by the decrease in community grants which was a direct consequence of the strength of the club's prior year results. This will be taken into consideration when preparing the budget for the next financial year.

The positive side is that as a club we were well prepared to have a year like this with enough reserves built up so that the club was able to operate as per usual. The executive committee will now place a focus on increased fundraising opportunities and are excited for what the future holds, we also look forward to the continued support from our club members through these future events.

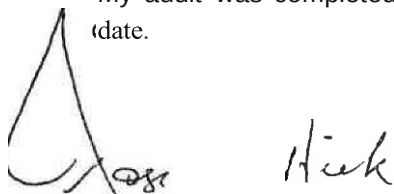
