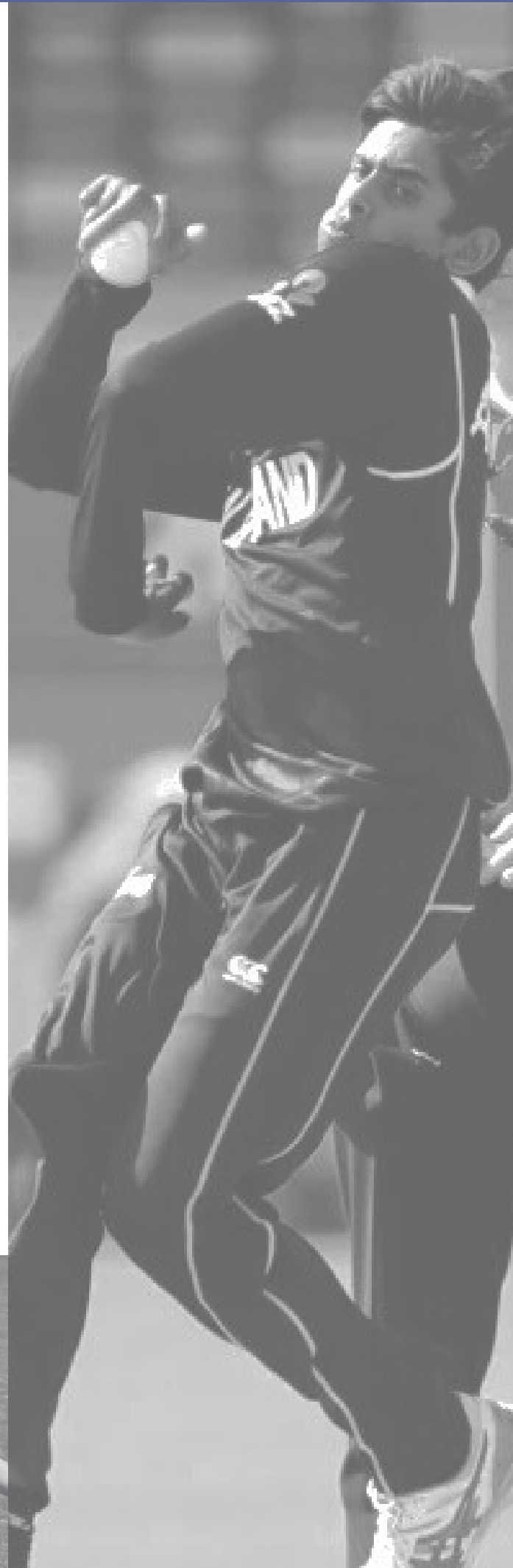

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CHAIR REPORT

It is a pleasure to present the 2024/25 SNLCC annual report and my chair's report summarising the season. I am proud to say that the Club remains in great health across almost every measure. We again tipped over the thousand-member mark for the third season in a row. This makes us the third largest club by overall member numbers in Auckland but with the largest senior club by some margin. We have exciting growth in the women's and girl's space and continue to implement new initiatives to grow the junior and youth space.

Running a club of the size comes with many challenges, but they've been well handled by a highly effective Executive Committee, with valuable support from a dedicated junior committee, and the guidance of our now departed general manager Kate Hillier-Cook. Kate finished up her role at the end of the season after five demanding years in the job, but will stay on in her capacity as one of the clubs' representatives on the Ken Maunder Park Trust, that operates our facilities. I want to personally thank Kate on behalf of everyone at the Club for the excellent service she provided us over those 5 years in transitioning the club into a new era of professionalism.

We are very excited to have replaced Kate's General Manager role with a newly created Director of Cricket role. Paul Young, who has extensive experience operating cricket clubs in the Wellington region, started this role in July 2025 and will also be the new Premier Women's coach. Paul will be ably supported in running the club by a soon to be appointed Club Administrator, another new role. This restructure has arisen from the realisation that servicing a large membership base can no longer be handled by one General Manager with volunteer support. We are excited about how cricket will be delivered to our members under this new structure and wish Paul well in this new direction for the Club.

The Club continues to perform well financially despite the ongoing challenges in obtaining grant funding. After incurring a larger than budgeted loss in the previous season, the Executive was pleased to achieve a near breakeven season in 2025, despite significant capital expenditure. Through a combination of fundraising efforts and targeted grant funding applications, the club now has a magnificent new electronic scoreboard named after club legend and Life Member, Ian "Donners" Donnelly. You can read more about that in the following pages.

We continue to spend more on delivering coaching, equipment, and facility hire to our members than ever before. Pleasingly we have managed to deliver these additional services, without having to rely on our 'rainy-day' fund to any great extent. That fund remains largely untouched from last season with only interest earned from the capital going towards the running of the Club. This continues to allow the Club to pursue new opportunities for members and the delivery of an exceptional membership experience.

We continue to produce exceptional talent as a club with no less than four members donning the black cap of the national team during the season. Congratulations to Adi Ashok, Ben Lister, Finn Allan, and Jimmy Nesham for that fantastic achievement. We are all very proud of you. In addition to those four players, Sean Solia and Martin Guptill also represented the Auckland Aces, with Sean skippering much of the season. Martin was recognised for his outstanding contribution to the Auckland Aces set up with a fantastic testimonial match in which he reminded everyone that he still had plenty to offer the game. We are also particularly proud of Anika Tauwhare for making her debut for the Auckland Hearts, capping a magnificent season of development for the women and girls' section of the club.

We are excited by the ongoing growth of the women's and girl's space. The Club now sports teams in Premier, Premier Reserve, Under 16, 13 and under 11, together with participation growth amongst the under 8 and 9s and Guppies (5&6 year olds). The women's premier team was supported by three overseas players at different times during the season, culminating in them making the final of the T20 pearl Dawson competition. An amazing achievement in just the second year of participating in the Premier competition. Congratulations to all those involved in making this space such an important area of the club's development but particularly to Kelvin Gatland who worked tirelessly across numerous roles (convenor, coach, parent, and overseas player host!).

The junior club continues to go from strength to strength as well. Thanks to the junior chair, Ryan Hibbard, and his passionate team of volunteers making up the junior committee for helping the club thrive in that space. There were some exceptional individual and team results achieved that can give the club confidence that there will continue to be a steady stream of talent entering the senior club over the next few years.

At the Auckland Cricket Awards, our efforts to make cricket more inclusive for all were recognised with the Diversity, Inclusion and Equity Award, off the back of winning the equivalent award at the NZ Cricket awards the previous season. We were also awarded the Club of the Year, recognising that we are excelling in all aspects of the Club.

At the AGM in July 2024, we bestowed the highest honour the Club can award in the form of life memberships to two of our very long serving members and dedicated volunteers. Kevin and Ginny Barry were thoroughly deserving of this award after nearly 40 years of membership and service.

I wish to thank in my fellow Executive Committee members for their exceptional support over the season. In particular, a big thank you to Tim Elliot and Paul Rowe who have decided not to stand again for the committee next season. Also to Natalie Nelson who took on the lion share of Club operations after Kate finished in April and before we appointed Paul in July. That was a herculean effort. To all the volunteers that give up their time in any small way, and often in very big ways, a massive thank you. The club could not operate without you.

I feel very positive heading into next season so wish everyone a happy and productive 2025/26 season.

IAN “DONNERS” DONNELLY SCOREBOARD

What can you say about Donners. The clubs leading wicket taker by over 200 wickets he bowled with magnificent accuracy throughout the 1970's and 80's – and occasionally even turned one or two.

A foundation member Donners is still actively involved today as Premier team scorer. For 50 years he has been a central figure at the club and is probably the single person most synonymous with the name Suburbs New Lynn. He served on the Executive committee for over 30 years and was the Club Captain for seven season.

When Donners first started playing for SNLCC, it was a tough period – the renowned left arm spin bowler Hedley Howarth was in our Premier team with Donners in the support role. Donners was the ultimate club man. He would have played Premier cricket anywhere in Auckland, but he was happy to play seconds and then step up each time Hedley was called away on representative duty. It wasn't until 1978 when Howarth left the club that Donners had a full season of Premier cricket and he immediately made his mark taking 41 wickets.

PREMIER MEN

2024/25 for the Premier squad was another campaign filled with both challenges and highlights. While consistent form did not come easy, there was plenty of grit and flashes of quality throughout the season.

The early rounds of the Hedley Howarth Two-Day Competition didn't bring the start we hoped for. However, our third game against Grafton sparked some much-needed momentum. Luke Devereaux had a standout all-round performance, claiming 5 wickets with the ball and backing it up with a composed 57* to steer us home with the bat. He was well supported by Sam Cook, who delivered a brilliant second innings bowling effort of 6 wickets—an excellent team win that showed what we were capable of when it clicked.

Moving into the Jeff Crowe One-Day Competition, we had an early hard-fought win over Hibiscus Coast. Young season-debutant Jaskaran Sandhu made an immediate impact, top-scoring with 69* and then backing it up with 4 wickets to lead the team to a great win. Unfortunately, as the competition progressed, our performances were hit and miss. We often put ourselves in strong positions regularly but struggled to close out games. In the final round, we were staring down the barrel of relegation and faced top-of-the-table Auckland University. The team dug deep in all-round effort, clinching a dramatic win by 5 runs in the final over. Despite this heroic performance, other results didn't go our way, and we ultimately finished bottom in the one-day competition.

In the Martin Guptill T20 Competition, after a strong round-robin stage we again made it through to the semi-finals—this time facing Takapuna. It was a tight encounter where we played well, but fell short in the final stages of our run chase, continuing the trend of near misses in big moments.

We returned to the two-day format to close out the season, and again saw glimpses of our potential. Against North Shore, Luke was at his best again with another 5-wicket haul, while Sam Cook played a crucial knock of 40 batting at number nine to get us over the line in a nail-biting finish. While the final few games didn't go our way, we finished the season comfortably clear of the relegation zone.

While consistency and execution in key moments were lacking at times, the team showed resilience and glimpses of what could be. The development of young players, strong individual performances, and the ability to rise in high-pressure moments give us a solid foundation to build from.

A big thank you again to Baz for his continued leadership and support, VJ for consistently producing great wickets, and to Kate, our scorers, volunteers, and loyal supporters who keep everything ticking behind the scenes. More to come!

Premier Women's Season Wrap – 2024/2025

What a season it's been for our Premier Women! From hard-fought battles to major milestones, the 2024/25 season was a true journey of growth, resilience, and camaraderie. While the road wasn't always smooth, the team emerged stronger, more connected, and with a renewed hunger to push further in seasons to come.

Heading into the season, expectations were higher following our promising debut last year. With a tight-knit squad and a clear goal to win 11 out of our 17 matches, we knew we were up for a challenge but also up for the fight. What unfolded was a season of two contrasting halves, filled with valuable lessons, tough results, and an inspiring turnaround that showcased the character of this group.

We were fortunate to welcome three overseas players during different stages of the season, each bringing their own experience, energy, and professionalism to the team. Gwen Davies joined us from the start and immediately made an impact with both bat and leadership. Holly Whitfield arrived about a month into the season and returned later to finish strongly. And it was great to have Heather Siegers back for a short stint at the end after her efforts last season. Their contributions, both on and off the field, were instrumental in shaping our culture and lifting performance standards.

The Prichard Cup 40-over competition proved a testing challenge. Despite strong effort and determination in every game, the results didn't go our way, and we finished the competition without a win. While that was undoubtedly tough to take, the experience proved crucial in building resilience and allowed us to lay the foundation for what came next. The squad's attitude never faltered; they continued to show up, compete hard, and support one another.

Our turning point came in the T20 Pearl Dawson competition. With a fresh mindset and better cohesion, we found our rhythm and delivered some outstanding performances. The team grew in confidence and consistency with each match, culminating in a fantastic run to the final. While we didn't clinch the trophy, reaching the final was a huge step forward and a proud achievement for this group.

There were several standout individual performances across the T20 campaign. On the bowling front, Heather Siegers took 8 wickets from just 4 games, showing her international class. Divyanshi Chauhan was a key contributor throughout, finishing with 12 wickets from 12 games, and Holly Whitfield chipped in with 9 wickets across 10 matches. With the bat, Gwen Davies was sensational, amassing 414 runs in 12 games with a high score of 70. Amelia Harvey also made a strong contribution with 102 runs from 9 innings, including an unbeaten 48*. These efforts not only helped drive the team forward but also placed several of our players

among the top performers in the competition. Gwen was among the leading run-scorers, while Divyanshi finished as one of the top wicket-takers.

This season also marked a significant milestone for our squad depth. Over the past two years in the Premier Women's competition, 24 players have now made their debut for Suburbs. That's an incredible reflection of the talent coming through and bodes well for the future of the Programme. A big congratulations to all those who wore the cap for the first time this year, you've done yourselves and the club proud.

As we look back, this season wasn't just about results. It was about growth, connection, and laying down markers for the future. We went into our one-day campaign low on confidence and facing bottom 8 cricket for the first time as a team. The 24/25' season was another great year for the junior club. We had one of our more successful seasons on the field across many grades, we introduced and successfully ran some new club competitions, there were some incredible individual achievements and as always plenty of fun, passion and effort displayed from all our wonderful junior members. Sadly we farewell Kate Hillier-Cook after many successful years managing the club. Kates time at the club will be remembered fondly - she facilitated many new incentives both on the field and in the community leading us to numerous NZC / ACA awards and further entrenching Suburbs standing in Auckland and NZ as one of the major cricket clubs. We wish her all the best on her next venture and hope to see her continuing to support the club.

On the field the club had a really successful year performance wise; we had tournament wins in multiple age bands, numerous ACA grade champions, some unlucky runners up results and encouraging improvements within the girls grades, in particular the u13s competing for the first time in the top grade division.

Summer Series cricket is considered the top club competition in Auckland with both an LO40 competition (runs throughout the season) and a T20 tournament (held in January). Thanks to our large youth membership we once again managed to enter the most teams amongst the ACA clubs into the various Summer Series grades. Our u17 Summer Series team, winners of this years junior prizegiving 'Team of the Year', had a very memorable season winning both the T20 and LO40 competitions beating long term rivals East Coast Bays in both. These finals were extremely close, the T20 final went down to the last ball and the LO40 match played on KMP #1 was a low scoring thriller seeing our bowling and fielding efforts strangle the opposition defending the well under par total.

Our u15 team had a strong T20 tournament making it to the final where they were cruelly beaten by a slow over rate penalty, a difficult lesson to learn for the boys but a wonderful tournament all the same. The u13 boys had their first Summer Series experience in the LO40 competition, we had 2 teams compete, one in the top grade and the other in the development grade - both had undefeated seasons winning all games in dominant fashion. An amalgamation of these teams also travelled and competed in the national Hawkes Bay tournament winning that with consistent all round team performances, of the 27 teams competing none of the 5 other ACA clubs participating managed to finish inside the top 12. These tournaments held in January are such a wonderful experience; travelling together as a team, playing on grass wickets with more traditional rules. I encourage in particular our year 7 and 8s to strongly consider participating each year.

Last season saw the clubs continued success in the Saturday ACA club cricket grades. Due to such a passionate and deep u12 grade we decided for the first time to enter 3 LO30 teams, we needed not worry that diluting the teams would lead to poorer results. Incredibly these 3 teams finished 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the North West division, they then moved into the semi finals vs the top Central

East teams winning both fixtures creating a Suburbs vs Suburbs ACA final, winning the Auckland u12 LO grade for the second consecutive season. Our youngest grades (u11 and below) continue to develop playing shorter format T20 competitions and training consistently and effectively. Whilst winning is important for some, success is better measured by enthusiasm, improvement and enjoyment in these early years. Developing a love for the game at a young age is the best method for on field results in the competitive years ahead.

With all the team success comes plenty of individual excellence, we were well represented amongst the u17 Auckland rep team and academies.

Congratulations Liam Ireland (team), Om Patel (team) and Vaibhav Vijayaragavan (academy) on their selections and tournament performances. Two of our u16 girls earned their first premier women's team caps, well done to Aaliyah Jain and Arishta Dube on the special achievement. Also a special mention to u12/u13 Willoughby Wheldale, breaking the junior batting season aggregate record (set last season) with an incredible 1109 runs, a genuine batting talent with a bright future.

Girls cricket continues to thrive at Suburbs, each year we see a steady increase in participation, performance and passion. We added an extra u11 team this season, participation grew amongst Guppies, u8s/u9s and we retained all of our members in the u16 and u13 teams.

The junior committee are always looking to expand opportunities, we currently offer more alternatives to our juniors than any other club in Auckland particularly within the youth age groups. Last season we had our first edition of the YPL (Youth Premier League). This was a 3 day in-house T20 tournament held for college aged boys who had finished school for the year in mid December, participation was strong with 60 keen lads, plenty of fun and some good quality cricket was had. We continued with our 2nd season of the JPL (Junior Premier League), had record participation in our 2 midweek hub competitions and continued the wonderful cricstars initiative offering cricket based activities for children with physical/mental disabilities. During the winter we have our indoor competition and our winter academies which are due to start in a few weeks. Incredibly we reached capacity (110) in just 6 days which will hopefully increase to cater for the demand on a waiting list, we have an elite team of coaches on board to deliver another successful programme.

Junior cricket thrives with passionate participants, dedicated volunteers and a club commitment to resource development from a young age. Suburbs delivers on all of this and has sent a strong signal by employing a director of cricket (as well as an administration manager) that this will not only continue but improve even further. I wish all our members another enjoyable and successful season ahead.

CLUB HISTORY AND STATISTICS

Club History

Suburbs New Lynn Cricket Club is still relatively young having just finished our 53rd season. We were formed in 1972 as a result of the amalgamation of the Suburbs and the Blockhouse Bay - New Lynn Clubs, both old clubs with proud traditions.

In the early years Suburbs New Lynn was based at the Rosebank Road (now Eastdale Reserve) ground. We moved to Ken Maunder Park in the mid-1970's and together with the Western Districts Hockey Club built the pavilion which has been our headquarters ever since. The pavilion was built through club labour, a shining testimony to the commitment of the early members.

For 30 years the cricket and hockey clubs shared Ken Maunder Park with the Lynn-Avon Football Club which had its own separate clubrooms. In the 1990s Western District Hockey moved its base away from Ken Maunder as all club hockey began to be played on artificial turf. Then in 2010 in a major joint venture between cricket, football and the council the football clubrooms were demolished and replaced with a magnificent indoor training centre to be used by both clubs and the community. At the same time the cricket clubrooms became home to both clubs and an independent Ken Maunder Park Trust was created to manage both the indoor training centre and the clubrooms.

Playing Success

Through the 1970's and 1980's Suburbs New Lynn fielded strong sides producing many Auckland representatives from whom Hedley Howarth, Geoff Howarth, John Reid, Peter Webb and Stuart Gillespie went on to play for New Zealand. The club's first 'golden age' took place in the 1980s. We won the Premier Two Day Championship in 1980-81 and then again in 1984-85. In that amazing season Suburbs also won the One Day Championship as well as the Grosvenor Cup for best fielding team. Suburbs also finished runners-up in the two day championship in 1987-88 and 1990-91.

The second 'golden age' arrived in the late 2000's. In the 2008-09 season for the first time in 25 years the club won the Hedley Howarth Trophy for the Premier Two-Day Championship. This was the beginning of an amazing run for the club's Premier side and was followed up with T20 titles in 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2014-15 and 2016-17. Further Two-Day Championships were added in 2011-12, 2013-14 and 2020-2021. The Jeff Crowe Cup for the Premier OneDay title was also won in the 2013-14, 2015-16 and 2019-20.

SNLCC was also awarded the Club Championship for the leading Principal Club in Auckland in the 2011-12 season. This period also saw a number of New Zealand representatives emerge, including Martin Guptill, Reece Young, Daryl Tuffey, Michael Bates, Jimmy Neesham, Jeet Raval, Ajaz Patel and most recently Kyle Jamieson, Ben Lister and Adithya Ashok.

In 2021 SNLCC was also awarded the prestigious "New Zealand Community Cricket Club of the Year Award' by NZC.

50th Anniversary Book

In 2022 the club released a special book to celebrate its 50th anniversary. 'We don't play for Adulation – 50 years of cricket at Suburbs New Lynn' is packed with photos and captures many of the best stories, great characters and playing highlights of our club to this time. Copies are still available for purchase from the Club.

Statistical History

In the early 1980's work was started on a Club Statistical History. By going back through the Annual Reports a profile on every person to play for Suburbs New Lynn was formed. Each year this file is updated from PlayHQ and the latest Annual Report (we are dependent on the quality of statistics lodged on PlayHQ by team captains). Record partnerships and season aggregates are also recorded. Most cricketers are statistically minded and the "Hall of Legends" have provided a lot of interest.

Every year we can now celebrate players who have reached new milestones and at the same time highlight some special highlights to look forward to in the next season.

Significant Milestones achieved in the 2024-25 Season included

- Michael Barry moving past Peter Guptill on the batting legends list and becoming only second player in the club's history to top 12,000 runs.
- Sean Solia moving past 4000 career runs
- Shlok Malhotra, Dhruv Patel, Shikhar Verma, Jaskaran Sandhu, Cameron Spick and Tanishq Taylor all joining the 2000 runs club.
- Malay Patel, Nick Watson, Divyanchi Chauhan, Daniel Winstone, Shlok Malhotra and Noah Mead all joining the 100 wickets club.
- Cameron Spick, Kevin Gattu and Logan MacDougall all moving past 100 wicket keeping dismissals
- Kaia Tauwhare joining the wicket keepers 50 dismissal club
- Hamish Nelson joining the fielders 50 catches club
- Willoughby Wheldale, Sujal Patel, Abhin Prashar, Samirkhan Pathan, Gwen Davies, Shehbaz Gulam Mumshi, Trushiy Amin, Rajiv Anand and Muthukumar Ramaiah all joining the record season aggregate club with over 600 runs this season.
- Samirkahn Pathan and Luke Devereaux both taking over 40 wickets in the season.
- Sujaz Patel and Muthukumar Ramaiah both joining the highest individual score club with innings of over 150.

Special achievements to watch out for next season include

- The big one - Michael Barry just needs another 392 runs to overtake Graham Crooks as the club's leading all time run scorer (one more season Bazza)
- A big season for the Presidents team with Gordon Armstrong only needing 82 runs to go past 4000 and Bill Devereaux needing 54 to go past 3000.
- Others with a good chance of going past 3000 runs are Sean Playle (2921), Kevin Gattu (2841) and Sachin Variath (2769).
- And watch out for the following players who all have a great chance of joining the 2000 run club next season – Parthes Patel (1992), Kaia Tauwhare (1920), Nikunj Vithalani (1895), Hamish Nelson (1880) and Krishna Falgun Patel (1856).

- Luke Devereaux needs just 7 wickets to become just the 13th bowler to reach 350 wickets, William Burroughs needs just 6 more to join the 300 club, while Sam Cook and Sam Devereaux needs only a few more wickets to reach the 250 milestone.
- And on the verge of joining the 100 wicket club are John Cope (96) , Surbhi Bahl (93) and Sean Playle (90).

Postscript: It is also worth noting that we have now been able to create a comprehensive database of all players who have scored over 50 runs or taken over 5 wickets for the club. Collating this information has been a huge task but it is now organised in such a way that it can be updated every year and players can find and review their own records as they are presented alphabetically. This means that almost 2000 past and present players can view their historical data. Access to this statistical information will be made available before next season on the website and in the clubrooms.

TREASURERS REPORT

On the face of the Financial Statements, it was another tough year for the club, as the Income Statement shows the club registered a loss of \$9k. This has continued the trend that we saw in the prior year where a \$15k loss was registered.

What other trend also occurred was the total revenue for the year also increasing from \$347k in 2023/24 to \$355k in 2024/25. This remains a positive indication that the club is continuing to expand its revenue streams as we face struggles in other revenue areas.

The club increased revenue in two main areas, the Academies, Programmes and Competitions line (\$15k in 23/24 to \$28k in 24/25), as well as the Fundraising line (\$1k in 23/24 to \$21k in 24/25). The increased winter academies and holiday programmes are the key drivers to this increase, and with the Xero Accounting Software now being integrated with the PlayHQ platform, this revenue is better recorded.

The Fundraising that occurred during the year was strong sign of the support that the club has behind it. The introduction of a pre-season Race Night (special thanks to Michael Barry) as well as the Merv Hughes Night were key factors in the successes of Fundraising this year.

Once again, the club had a decrease in the amount of Community Grants received, once again showing the difficulty in current times in obtaining these Grants. The club will do well to focus on accessing further community grants as well as further fundraising events to keep the club revenue growing.

The overall expenditure remained consistent compared to the prior year (\$344k). Large areas of expenditure continue to be Cricket Balls and Coaching as these are unavoidable costs in the nature of the cricket club.

There was an increase in the Events Expense (\$15k) that relates largely to the Merv Hughes Night, that was offset by a decrease in the Overseas Player expense.

On the Balance Sheet there is one major change. Under the Current Liabilities there is now an Income in Advance line for \$48k. This relates to the purchase of the new Electronic Scoreboard, this was funded by a mixture of grants as well as the Race Night Fundraising event. This Income in Advance will be recognised over the useful life of the Electronic Scoreboard (approximately 15 years).

Regarding the Cash position of the club, we remain in a strong position with money in the bank to meet obligations as they arise. This means that while we search for additional income sources we are covered by our bank balance that we have done well to maintain over the last few years. The Club continues to perform well financially despite the ongoing challenges in obtaining grant funding.

The 2023/24 season resulted in a larger than expected budgeted loss and this season we again budgeted on a small loss to allow for an increase in coaching budget and uncertainty around grant funding for operations. The Executive was pleased to come in close to budget, despite significant capital expenditure. Through a combination of fundraising efforts and targeted grant funding applications, the club now has a magnificent new electronic scoreboard named after club legend and Life Member, Ian "Donners" Donnelly. You can read more about that in the following pages.

**AUDITORS REPORT TO THE READERS OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
OF THE SUBURBS NEW LYNNCRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED**

I have audited the financial statements set out on pages 82-84. The financial statements provide information about the past financial performance of the Club as at 30 April 2025.
