Dear Christ Church and Christ Church School Community,

We are grateful to share a meaningful update following our recent Church Conference held on Sunday, April 12. Rev. Vidalis Lopez, District Superintendent of the Southeast District of the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church, presided over the meeting as we gathered to consider the preliminary plans for the Christ Church School expansion. In her opening remarks, Rev. Lopez reflected on Nehemiah 2–3, reminding us of Nehemiah’s vision to rebuild the wall in Jerusalem—seeking permission, casting vision, and inspiring others to join in the work. Like the people of Jerusalem who responded, “Let us start rebuilding,” we, too, are called to step forward in faith and unity.

On behalf of the Building Committee, Randall Vitale presented the preliminary plans for the expansion. Following discussion and prayerful consideration, the recommendation to move forward was approved by a vote of 37 in favor and 2 opposed, representing 95% approval by those in attendance—well exceeding the required simple majority.

We are thankful for the strong support and engagement of our church and school community. This vote allows us to move forward to the final Church Conference vote on May 11, where the next phase of this important project will be considered.

We also want to share our gratitude for the beautiful Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Easter Sunday services at Christ Church. It was wonderful to gather in worship together—thank you to all who attended and helped make these services so meaningful.

Thank you to all who attended, participated, and prayed over this important step. We look forward to gathering again on May 11 as we continue discerning God’s vision for the future of Christ Church and Christ Church School.
