Dear Christ Church and Christ Church School Community,

As we look toward the future of Christ Church School, the question many are asking is, "Why build a middle school and expand now?" The answer is simple: God has opened a unique window of opportunity. CCS continues to grow, our programs are thriving, and families are seeking a place where their children can learn, lead, and grow in faith through 8th grade. Expanding now positions us to meet these needs with excellence and intention.

Why is the Christ Church School pursuing a Middle School now?

Christ Church School is at an inflection point. Enrollment has increased by 11% over the past five years, classrooms are full, and waitlists continue to grow as families seek to join our community. Parents consistently express a strong desire for continuity—the ability to keep their children in an environment where they are known, supported, and challenged from Pre-Primary through 8th grade. We are uniquely positioned to meet that need. With a solid financial foundation, no debt, and steady year-over-year growth, CCS has both the stability and the space to expand. By reimagining our existing footprint, we can create additional learning environments that enrich the student experience and allow us to add Grades 6, 7, and 8—ensuring a seamless CCS Journey.

South Florida's population boom, rising demand for faith-based education, the decline of elementary-only independent schools across the state, and the limited availability of middle school seats at non-covenant schools all point to one clear conclusion: The time to grow is now.

Architect Selection Process

Our Owner's Representative has guided us through the first major step: identifying the right architectural partner. From an initial group of five well-qualified firms, four submitted full RFPs. Those firms are currently being interviewed, and we expect to have results in the coming days and weeks. This is a significant milestone as we continue to shape the vision for a future middle school and campus expansion.
