Important Working Relationships: Christ Church Clergy, Director of Music Ministry, Director of Children's Ministry, Staff, Pastor of School and Family Ministries, Christ Church School

Functions: To lead and steward the life of Youth Ministries Christ Church (6th-12th grade), including the Parkway campus. Creates a budget for Youth Ministries.

Alignment:

- Must be committed to living and growing as a disciple, a follower of Jesus Christ.
- Must be committed to the United Methodist Church and to the Wesleyan Way of making disciples: Passionate worship, radical hospitality, extravagant generosity, serving people in need, and intentional discipleship.
- Must be committed to the Mission and Vision of Christ Church UM: Reflect the love, hope, and joy of Jesus Christ to our community.
- Must be regularly present in worship at Christ Church UM (unless sick or out of town).

Responsibilities:

Youth (Freeway) Ministry Program

- Lead, plan, grow, and execute the youth group

- Lead, plan, and develop weekly small group opportunities for youth
- Lead, plan, and develop opportunities for Youth to serve in our church and community
- Lead the youth in participating in Florida Conference opportunities such as the Warren Willis Camp Summer Camp, Mission Trips, and other opportunities
- Welcome youth to worship and encourage/plan youth participation in the worship service
- Provide appropriate ministry care for youth and their families
- Ensure adherence to the Safe Church Policy of Christ Church, providing the safest environment possible for all who participate

Large Events:

- Coordinate with Lead Pastor(s), Associate Pastor, Pastor of School and Families, Coordinator of Children's, and Director of Music Ministry to plan, organize and facilitate large events (such as Trunk or Treat, Family Christmas Eve worship service, Easter Egg Hunt)
- Coordinate with the Coordinator of Outreach and Parkway Pantry to assist with ministries, and meal opportunities at the Parkway campus

Other Ministry Responsibilities:

- Database management for Freeway
- Purchasing, credit card requisitions
- Create, oversee, and manage budget for Youth Ministries
- Respond to inquiries and difficulties with clear communications and collaborative and future-oriented information
- Ensure that the Student Ministry manual (including the calendar and youth directory) is appropriately revised and up to date
- Visit the website regularly to unsure that it is updated with Youth events and activities
- Communicate student news (monthly or whatever is deemed necessary) with the Council, congregation, and the staff.
- Attend staff meetings as needed.
- Participate in Worship Events that include families and children (Christmas Eve, Concert Events, Special Events, CCS/CCUM events)
