Building for the Future: Middle School Progress Update

The Building Committee continues to make meaningful progress toward the expansion of Christ Church School. The team is currently in the process of selecting both an Owner's Representative and an Architect—two key steps in ensuring a well-planned and thoughtfully executed project.

As we move forward, the Committee remains focused on creating a financial plan that will sustainably fund the project while supporting the long-term growth of Christ Church and Christ Church School. Our goal is to build a Middle School that not only provides outstanding facilities and professional excellence but also nurtures each child's educational and spiritual potential. Christ Church and Christ Church School share a unique partnership within the Fort Lauderdale community. This new space will strengthen that bond, allowing for even greater collaboration on programs that inspire faith, service, and creativity—just like the ones happening this fall & spring:
