PITCHES

Arrive **30 mins**
before KO

Warm up to the sides of
pitches - not in dugout area

LITTER & FOUR LEGGED FRIENDS

Use the bins provided
Dogs must remain on lead at
all time

FACILITIES

Waders Tea Hut
Hot food, drink & snacks
Toilets on the terrace via the
turnstiles gate

RESPECT

Officials and coaches
Barriers or respect lines
Players by allowing them to play

PARKING

Park sensibly, straight and closely to the next car to maximise
the parking available for others

SITE SAFETY

Use the pathway & be mindful when crossing the car park
Do not leave children unsupervised please escort to the toilets
Please do not smoke/vape at pitch side
If the ball goes out play in the road/carpark, please retrieve it
Do not allow players to climb the banks or fencing

DO NOT.....

- Block gates on site
- Park or stop on the driveway
- Enter the field of play
- Roam the site, remain the pitch location

Consent from both team
coaches must be granted

Use shoes with metal studs or "Blades"
Allow dogs on the pitch
Allow spectators on the pitch
Drag goals or heavy items across the surface
Allow bikes on the pitch
