Planning a Funeral Mass

Your first step is to contact a funeral home.

They will help begin the planning process and guide you through the practical details. The funeral home director will then reach out to our Liturgy Coordinator and work directly with them to plan the Vigil, Funeral Mass, and Committal services. The funeral home can also assist you with identifying and arranging cemetery options.
