Apostles Peter and Paul

FIRST CENTURY
FEAST DAY: JUNE 29

These apostles share a feast as founders of the church in Rome. Peter, a Galilean fisherman chosen by Christ as one of the Twelve Apostles, became the undisputed leader of the fledgling church after Pentecost. Paul, a Pharisee and Roman citizen who had persecuted Christians, became after his dramatic conversion the church's greatest missionary, its "apostle of the gentiles." By tradition both were martyred in Rome. Their adventures are recounted in the Acts of the Apostles, and letters from them are included in the New Testament.

Pastor's Message

Dear brothers and sisters, summer is here and we are all enjoying the beautiful weather, picnic with family and friends, outing, social event etc. There is also a little challenge that summer bring as days get warmer at time. We want to keep cool by using the lightest clothes we can find at home. What is the virtue that regulate the proper way of dressing especially when we have to attend Mass? As Catholic we are moved by the virtues, and one of virtues that regulates the way of dressing and acting, is the virtue of modesty. The catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, that the baptism gives the grace of purifications from all sins, but we must continue to struggle against the concupiscence of the flesh and disordered desires but with the help of God's grace we can prevail. Cfr ccc2520.

The Catechism expounds upon these principles: "Modesty protects

the intimate center of the person. It means refusing to unveil what should remain hidden. It is ordered to chastity to whose sensitivity it bears witness. It guides how one looks at others and behaves toward them in conformity with the dignity of person and their solidarity.

Modesty protects the mystery of persons and their love. It encourages patience and moderation in loving relationships; it requires that the conditions for the definitive giving and commitment of man and woman to one another be fulfilled. Modesty is decency. It inspires one's choice of clothing. It keeps silence or reserve where there is evident risk of unhealthy curiosity. It is discreet" (#2521, 2522).

As disciples of Jesus we called to bear witness to love, purity, humility, modesty. Then we can ask ourselves is my way of dressing in the

Church shows my witnesses to love, purity and humility? Remember the way we dress send a certain message, and reveal the spiritual disposition of a person.

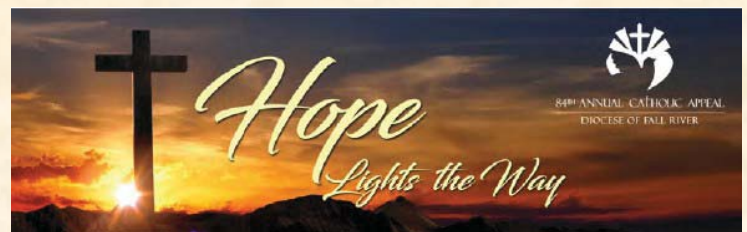

Mensaje del P. Mariano

Queridos hermanos, el verano ya está aquí y todos estamos disfrutando de estos días, a veces ya sea con un picnic familiar, salidas, evento sociales etc. El verano también nos plantea un pequeño reto, ya que los días son cada vez más calurosos. Queremos mantenernos frescos usando la ropa más ligera que podamos encontrar en casa. ¿Cuál es la virtud que regula la forma adecuada de vestir, especialmente cuando tenemos que asistir a misa? Como católicos nosotros debemos regularnos por las virtudes, y una de las virtudes que regula la forma de vestir y actuar, es la virtud de la modestia. El catecismo de la Iglesia Católica enseña, que el bautismo da la gracia de la purificación de todos los pecados, pero debemos seguir luchando contra la concupiscencia de la carne y los deseos desordenados, pero con la ayuda de la gracia de Dios podemos prevalecer. Cfr ccc2520.

El Catecismo desarrolla estos principios: "El pudor protege el centro íntimo de la persona. Significa negarse a desvelar lo que debe permanecer oculto. Se ordena a la castidad, de cuya sensibilidad da testimonio. Guía la manera de mirar a los demás y de comportarse con ellos en conformidad con la dignidad de la persona y su solidaridad. El pudor protege el misterio de las personas y su amor. Fomenta la paciencia y la moderación en las relaciones amorosas; exige que se cumplan las condiciones de la entrega y el compromiso definitivos del hombre y la mujer entre sí. El pudor es decencia. Inspira la elección de la vestimenta. Mantiene el silencio o la reserva cuando existe un riesgo evidente de no sanar.

Como discípulos de Jesús estamos llamados a dar testimonio de amor, pureza, humildad, modestia. Entonces podemos preguntarnos si mi forma de vestir en la Iglesia muestra mi testimonio de amor, pureza y humildad. Recuerda que la forma en que nos vestimos envía un cierto mensaje, y revela la disposición espiritual de una persona. Por eso hay que vestirse modestamente para venir a la Iglesia.

Que tengan un hermoso 4 de Julio disfrutando con su familia, y que todos tengan una maravillosa temporada de verano y disfrutando el tiempo con sus hijos, o nietos. Que tengan un feliz y bendecido domingo!.

Pedro, un pescador galileo, escogido por Cristo como uno de los Doce Apóstoles, se convirtió en el indiscutible líder de la naciente iglesia después de Pentecostés. Pablo, quien era fariseo y ciudadano romano y que había perseguido a los cristianos, luego de su dramática conversión se convirtió en el más grande misionero de la iglesia, en el "apóstol de los gentiles". Por tradición, ambos fueron martirizados en Roma. Sus aventuras están narradas en los Hechos de los Apóstoles y, en el Nuevo Testamento, se incluyen cartas escritas por ellos.
