Pastor's Message

Dear brothers and sisters, July is the month dedicated to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. Devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus is one of the oldest devotions in the Church. Our Blessed Mother adored the Most Precious Blood of her



infant Son on the day of His circumcision as the first drops of His Precious Blood were shed amongst many tears for the salvation of our sinful humanity. This devotion is a powerful one since it is through the shedding of the blood of God's Son that we were reconciled with

God. Through the shedding of the blood a sacrifice has been accomplished, and God accepted the blood of Jesus's suffering for the cleaning of all mankind. There are seven mysteries of the precious blood of Jesus as followed: 1) Jesus shed His Blood in the Circumcision, 2) Jesus shed His Blood in the Agony while praying in the Garden of Olives, 3) Jesus shed His Blood in the Scourging at the Pillar, 4) Jesus shed His Blood in the Crowning with Thorns, 5) Jesus shed His Blood while carrying His Cross to Calvary, 6) Jesus shed His Blood in the terrible Crucifixion, 7) Jesus shed Blood and water from His side pierced by the Lance. Here is a prayer to the Precious Blood of Jesus

Lord Jesus, You became Man in order by your Passion and Death and the draining of your Blood on the Cross, might prove to us how much You, our God, love us.

Protect us, dear Jesus, from ever running away from the sight of blood. Strengthen our weak human wills so that we will not only not run away from the cross, but welcome every opportunity to shed our blood in spirit in union with your Precious Blood, so that, dying to ourselves in time we might live with You in Eternity. Amen

Nuestra Santísima Madre adoró la Preciosísima Sangre de su Hijo el día de su circuncisión, cuando las primeras gotas de su Preciosísima Sangre se derramaron entre muchas lágrimas



por la salvación de nuestra humanidad pecadora. Esta devoción es poderosa, ya que mediante el derramamiento de la sangre del Hijo de Dios hemos sido reconciliados con Dios. Mediante el derramamiento de la sangre se realizó un sacrificio, y Dios aceptó la sangre del sufrimiento de Je-

sús para la purificación de toda la humanidad. Los siete misterios de la Preciosa Sangre de Jesús son los siguientes: 1) Jesús derramó su Sangre en la Circuncisión; 2) Jesús derramó su Sangre en la Agonía mientras oraba en el Huerto de los Olivos; 3) Jesús derramó su Sangre en la Flagelación en el Pilar; 4) Jesús derramó su Sangre en la Coronación de Espinas; 5) Jesús derramó su Sangre cargando su Cruz hacia el Calvario; 6) Jesús derramó su Sangre en la terrible Crucifixión; 7) Jesús derramó sangre y agua de su costado traspasado por la Lanza. Aquí les dejo esta oración a la Preciosa Sangre de Jesús:

Señor Jesús, te hiciste hombre para que, mediante tu Pasión y Muerte, y al derramar tu Sangre en la Cruz, nos demostraras cuánto nos amas, Dios nuestro. Protégenos, querido Jesús, de huir de la presencia de la sangre. Fortalece nuestra débil voluntad humana para que no solo no huyamos de la cruz, sino que aprovechemos cada oportunidad de derramar nuestra sangre en espíritu, en unión con tu Preciosa Sangre, para que, muriendo a nosotros mismos en el tiempo, podamos vivir contigo en la Eternidad. Amén.
