Liturgy Corner

LITURGICAL COLORS

White – Christmas Time and Easter Time; celebrations of the Lord (except of his Passion), of Mary, of the Angels, and of Saints who were not Martyrs; solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity, All Saints, the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, feasts of the Conversion of St. Paul, of the Chair of St. Peter, and of St. John; also permitted in the United States at Masses for the Dead.



Red. The color red is used on Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion and on Friday of Holy Week (Good Friday), on Pentecost Sunday, on celebrations of the Lord's Passion, on the "birthday" feast days of Apostles and Evangelists, and on celebrations of Martyr Saints.



Green. The color green is used in the Offices and Masses of Ordinary Time. Worn on all days when no other color is prescribed. Masses for Various Needs, on the other hand, are celebrated in the color proper to the day or the time of year or in violet if they have a penitential character;



Violet. The color violet or purple is used in Advent and Lent. It may also be worn in Offices and Masses for the Dead. Besides the color violet, the colors white or black may be used at funeral services and at other Offices and Masses for the Dead in the Dioceses of the United States of America.



Rose. The color rose may be used, where it is the practice, on Gaudete Sunday (Third Sunday of Advent) and on Laetare Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent). We don't have to confuse pink with rose color. The proper name is rose color.



Ritual Masses are celebrated in their proper color, in white, or in a festive color; Votive Masses are celebrated in the color suited to the Mass itself or even in the color proper to the day or the time of the year. Black color is worn in Masses for the Dead.

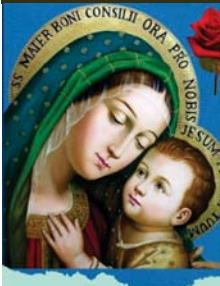

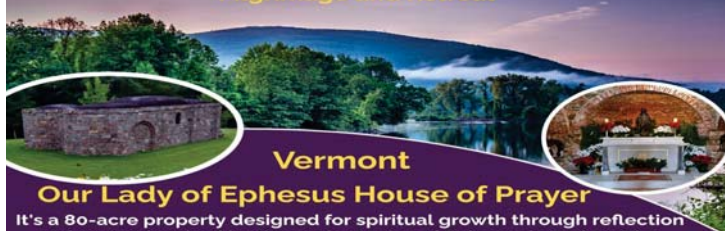

Mensaje del P. Mariano

Queridos hermanos, una vez más el Señor nos recuerda, a través del diálogo entre María y Marta, cuál es lo más importante de nuestra vida diaria. Betania está a unos tres kilómetros de Jerusalén. Jesús solía detenerse allí para descansar en casa de sus amigos antes de seguir hacia la ciudad santa. Los tres hermanos, Marta, María y Lázaro, eran muy amigos y cercanos a Jesús. Él se sentía como en casa en ese lugar, rodeado de alegría y cariño. Ahora Marta está angustiada porque quiere hacerlo todo a la perfección y se molesta un poco porque María simplemente no hace nada, más que estar a los pies de Jesús. Jesús le responde a Marta con un consejo cariñoso: «Marta, Marta, estás inquieta y preocupada...». Es como si le dijera: «Marta, estás preocupada por los asuntos del mundo, pero te olvidas de mí presencia; estás

profundamente preocupada por las tareas, pero descuidas la más importante de todas, que es la unión con Dios y la santidad personal. Si nuestras preocupaciones nos llevan a perder la presencia de Dios, esas preo-

cupaciones entonces no nos hacen bien, aunque tu trabajo en sí, sea bueno y necesario.

Jesús no juzga a Marta ni a María; responde a la pregunta de Marta señalando lo más importante en la vida: «María eligió la mejor parte y no se le será quitado». Nos preguntamos: ¿cuántas veces el Señor no nos reprocharía lo mismo? Nada justifica olvidar a Jesús en nuestro trabajo diario, ni siquiera en las preocupaciones más importantes: a veces decimos «tengo que hacer esto en casa! no puedo ir ahora mismo!, la semana que viene! y muchas otras cosas por el estilo. No podemos dejar de lado a quien es el Señor de todas las cosas por las cosas del mundo.

Tampoco podemos minimizar la importancia de la oración con la excusa de que estamos demasiado ocupados con el apostolado, con otras actividades y obras de caridad, etc. Estemos alerta y nunca permitamos que los asuntos mundanos se interpongan entre Dios y nosotros. Pidamos al Espíritu Santo que ponga a Dios por encima de todo, y luego a todo lo demás.

SIGLO I
DÍA DE FIESTA—26 DE JULIO

Aunque la Biblia no los menciona, Joaquín y Ana fueron nombrados como los padres de María en el Protoevangelio apócrifo de Santiago, el cual puede haberse originado en el siglo II. En esta historia, ellos están ancianos y no tienen hijos— así como Ana del Antiguo Testamento, madre de Samuel— cuando los ángeles les dieron la noticia que Ana iba a concebir un hijo. Ana fue una santa muy popular en la Inglaterra medieval y, para el año 1350, su fiesta ya se celebraba en el occidente y aunque varios papas autorizaron o suprimieron la fiesta de Joaquín ésta fue unida a la de Ana en 1969. Ellos son patronos de las parejas casadas; Ana es también patrona de las mujeres sin hijos, de las embarazadas y de los mineros.

“ En su casa vino al mundo María, trayendo consigo el extraordinario misterio de la Inmaculada Concepción; en su casa creció acompañada por su amor y su fe; en su casa aprendió a escuchar al Señor y a seguir su voluntad. Los santos Joaquín y Ana forman parte de esa larga cadena que ha transmitido la fe y el amor de Dios, en el calor de la familia, hasta María que acogió en su seno al Hijo de Dios y lo dio al mundo, nos los ha dado a nosotros. ¡Qué precioso es el valor de la familia, como lugar privilegiado para transmitir la fe!”
