Pastor's Message

Dear Brothers and sisters, as we continue enjoying our summer vacation, Pope Leo XIV recently made an important observation how we can best use of our vacation. He says "A break from work to restore physical strength, a chance to travel and contemplate the beauty of



nature, a time for reading and new friendships or to meditate and pray." Pope Leo will also be taking some time off to rest. From July 6 to 20, and then for a couple more days in August, he will be at the Pontifical Villas in Castel Gandolfo, a town about 25 kilometers

(approximately 16 miles) from Rome. Several Popes already mentioned that holidays should not be viewed as a time of idleness. The current Pope pointed out that during the holidays, we can rediscover the "always open, always new, always beautiful" creation. Nature with its "space, atmosphere, animals, things; the sea, mountains, plains, the sky with its dawns, its noons, its sunsets, and especially its starry nights" is "always deep and enchanting." Pope Saint Paul VI explained what he thought this period of rest should look like: "Let us ensure that this free time, which we call vacation, is not entirely spent in dissipation or selfishness. Relaxation, refreshment, recreation (in the etymological sense), yes, but intelligent and vigilant." He also highlighted that "holidays are a privileged time for good friendships, for getting to know places, customs, the needs of the people we do not usually approach, and for meeting new people worthy of our conversation" For saint John Paul II,

"one of the values of a holiday" is meeting others and spending time "in an unselfish way, for the pleasure of friendship and for sharing quiet moments together." For Pope Benedict XVI, it is vital to immerse oneself in nature, especially for "those who dwell in cities where the often frenzied pace of life leaves little room for silence and reflection." Pope Francis emphasized that holidays can also be a good time to deepen one's spiritual journey, even while traveling between tourist destinations. May we continue to spend a wonderful holidays so that we may return back, rested, motivated and with renewed energy to start back our daily occupations. See you next Sunday! God bless you all and have a happy and blessed Sunday!

Liturgy's Corner



The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

WHAT IS THIS FEAST ALL ABOUT?

How are we to understand the Transfiguration? The story of the Transfiguration is also proclaimed on the second Sunday of Lent—a key part of Jesus' journey towards the Cross. The Catechism of the Catholic Church draws parallels between Jesus' Baptism and the Transfiguration. Jesus is baptized at the start of his public ministry. His baptism proclaims the mystery of our first regeneration—we die and rise again with Christ. The "Transfiguration 'is the sacrament of the second regeneration': our own Resurrection (St. Thomas Aquinas, STh III, 45, 4, ad 2). From now on we share in the Lord's Resurrection through the Spirit who acts in the sacraments of the Body of Christ. The Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he 'will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body (Phil 3:21)' (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 556). During the Prayer after Communion, we pray that God might "transform us into the likeness of your [his] Son, / whose radiant splendor you willed to make manifest / in his glorious Transfiguration." The Collect, or opening prayer, tells us that the mystery of the Transfiguration "prefigures our full adoption to sonship." The Transfiguration, initially revealed to Peter, James, and John, reveals to all of us a taste of what is yet to come.



The Transfiguration is the fourth of the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. Spend time praying the luminous mysteries at home today:

Mensaje del P. Mariano

Queridos hermanos, mientras seguimos disfrutando de nuestras vacaciones de verano, el Papa León XIV hizo recientemente una importante observación sobre cómo aprovecharlas al máximo. Dice: «Un descanso del trabajo para recuperar fuerzas físicas, una oportunidad para viajar y contemplar la belleza de la naturaleza, un tiempo para leer y hacer nuevas amistades o para meditar y orar». El Papa León también se tomará un tiempo libre para descansar. Del 6 al 20 de julio, y luego un par de días más en agosto, estará en las Villas Pontificias de Castel Gandolfo, una ciudad a unos 25 kilómetros de Roma. Varios Papas ya han mencionado que las vacaciones no deben verse como un tiempo de ocio. El Papa actual señaló que durante las vacaciones podemos redescubrir la creación «siempre abierta, siempre nueva, siempre hermosa». La naturaleza con su «espacio, atmósfera, animales, cosas; el mar, las montañas, las llanuras, el cielo con sus amaneceres, sus mediodías, sus atardeceres y, especialmente, sus noches estrelladas» es «siempre profunda y encantadora». El Papa San Pablo VI explicó cómo consideraba que debía ser este período de descanso: «Procuraremos que este tiempo libre, que llama-



mos vacaciones, no se dedique solo a la disipación o al egoísmo. Relajación, descanso, recreación (en el sentido etimológico), sí, pero inteligente y vigilante».

También destacó que «las vacaciones son un momen-

to privilegiado para hacer buenas amistades, para conocer lugares, costumbres, las necesidades de personas con las que no solemos tratar, y para conocer gente nueva con la que conversar».

Para San Juan Pablo II, «uno de los valores de las vacaciones» es encontrarse con otros y pasar tiempo «de forma desinteresada, por el placer de la amistad y para compartir momentos de tranquilidad».

El Papa Benedicto XVI, es vital sumergirse en la naturaleza, especialmente para «quienes viven en ciudades donde el ritmo de vida, a menudo frenético, deja poco espacio para el silencio y la reflexión». El Papa Francisco enfatizó que las vacaciones también pueden ser un buen momento para profundizar en el camino espiritual, incluso mientras se viaja entre destinos turísticos. Que sigamos disfrutando de unas maravillosas vacaciones para que regresemos descansados, motivados y con energías renovadas para retomar nuestras tareas diarias. ¡Nos vemos el próximo domingo!

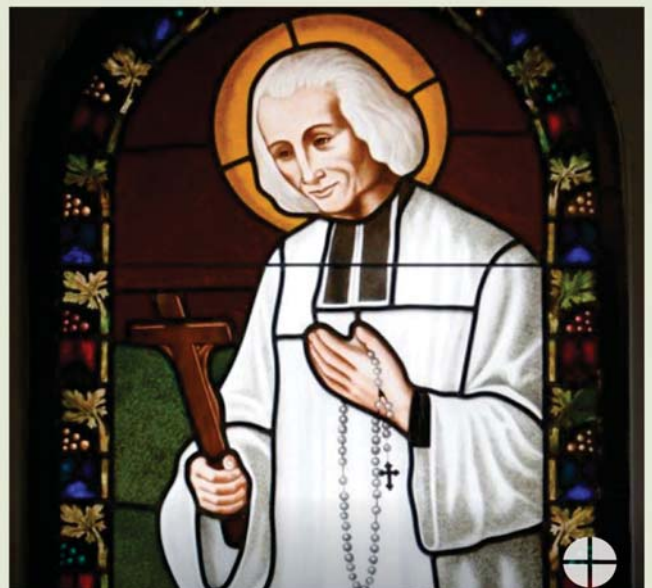

DÍA DE FIESTA: 4 DE AGOSTO

Juan nació cerca de Lyon, Francia, era hijo de un agricultor y por muchos años estudió para el sacerdocio. Finalmente, él fue ordenado, más que por otras cualidades, por su devoción y su buena voluntad. Pero Juan se convirtió en un modelo de sacerdote párroco en Arsen-Dombes, en donde prestó servicios por 40 años. Él se dedicó mucho a sus feligreses y se hizo famoso por su rigurosa prédica y por su discernimiento y saber en el confesionario. El Cura de Ars, como así lo llamaban, pasaba 18 horas al día escuchando las confesiones de los peregrinos que lo buscaban. Juan es el patrón de los sacerdotes y párrocos.
