From the Choir Loft

From the Choir Loft: Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

"Be built up like living stones, into a spiritual house, a holy priesthood." (1 Peter 2:5)

Today we celebrate the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, the cathedral of Rome and the "mother church" of all

Catholic churches. This feast invites us to reflect not only on sacred buildings but on a deeper reality: we

ourselves are temples of the Holy Spirit, built upon the one foundation of Jesus Christ.

Our opening hymn, *God, We Praise You*, echoes the praise that fills both heaven and earth around God's throne.

The second verse lifts up "true apostles, faithful prophets, saints who set their world ablaze," reminding us that

the Church is not merely stones and mortar but a living body of believers across the ages. Like the water

flowing from Ezekiel's temple that brings life wherever it goes, the Church spreads God's grace throughout the

world, bearing fruit in every generation.

At the Offertory, *The Church's One Foundation* proclaims the truth at the heart of today's second reading: "The

Church's one foundation is Jesus Christ her Lord." Saint Paul reminds us that "no one can lay a foundation other

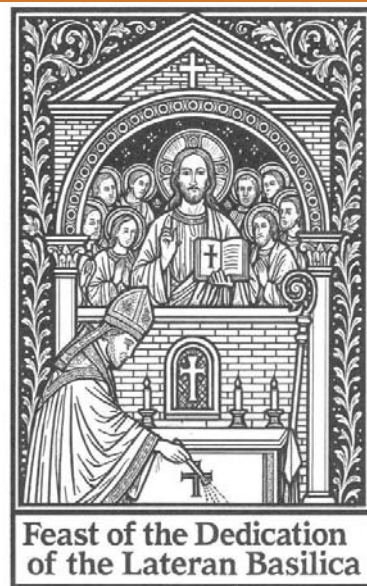
than the one that is there, namely, Jesus Christ." This hymn celebrates the mystery that we, though scattered

across nations and centuries, are "yet one o'er all the earth"—one Body united by "one Lord, one faith, one

birth" and nourished by "one holy Food." Just as Jesus cleansed the physical temple in the Gospel, he has made us temples of the Holy Spirit through his own Blood, calling us to holiness.

The Communion Antiphon from 1 Peter captures this beautifully: "Be built up like living stones, into a spiritual house, a holy priesthood." We are not passive bricks but living stones, each of us part of God's dwelling place on earth. As we receive the Eucharist, we become what we receive—the Body of Christ, that great temple not made by human hands.

Our recessional hymn, "Faith of Our Fathers," sends us forth with the call to preserve and pass on this living faith. The Lateran Basilica has stood for centuries as a sign of the Church's endurance, but the true temple is the one we carry within us and build together as the Body of Christ. May we be faithful stewards of this sacred trust, living stones bringing life to the world like the waters flowing from the temple.

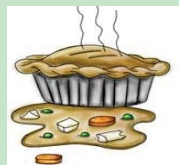

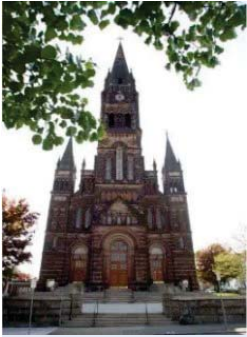
