

Pastor Message

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, as we enter the sacred season of Lent, a time traditionally marked by prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, I am often asked what I hope of my parishioners will focus on this year. My answer is simple yet profound: I invite you to join me in a fasting from social media. In our modern world, social media has become an



integral part of our daily lives. We check our phones countless times, scroll through feeds, and engage in digital conversations, and games, that often distract us from the present moment. While social media can be a tool for connection and information, it can also lead to overstimulation, and a loss of

precious time that could be spent in reflection or prayer.

Fasting during Lent is not just about giving up food or certain pleasures; it is about creating space for God in our lives. By choosing to step back from social media—whether it's Facebook, Instagram, X, or TikTok—we make a conscious decision to reclaim our attention and our hearts. This fast is not a rejection of technology but an opportunity to rediscover the joy of silence, the depth of prayer, and the wisdom found in scripture. Each moment we refrain from reaching for our devices is a moment we can turn inward, listen for God's voice, and nurture our spiritual lives.

I encourage you to approach this fast with intention and generosity. Consider setting specific times each day when you will disconnect from social media, especially at night; go to sleep earlier. I also make sure myself that I disconnect from my phone each evening at 9:00 PM, except on nights I am on hospital call. This helps me unwind and ensures I get a restful night without digital distractions. Use this newfound time for daily

prayer, meditation, or reading the Gospel: early in the morning. Let this be a season where you cultivate interior silence—an environment where God's presence can

be felt more deeply. When you are tempted to check your phone, pause and offer a prayer instead, or read a passage of scripture. Allow your fast to become a source of spiritual renewal and healing, opening your heart to the grace that Lent offers.

Let us journey together, seeking not only to abstain but to grow, to listen, and to be present to God and one another. May this Lenten practice draw us closer to Christ and transform our home, parish, community into a place of peace, reflection, and love.

Wishing you a blessed and fruitful Lent


What is Lent?

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by [giving alms](#); and we practice self-control through [fasting](#). We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Contemplate the meaning and origins of the Lenten fasting tradition in this [reflection](#). In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446).

In Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the [Order of Christian Initiation of Adults](#), a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics.



Del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos, al iniciar este tiempo de Cuaresma, nuestro corazón se dispone al encuentro con Dios a través de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna, siguiendo el ejemplo de Jesús en el desierto. Muchos me han preguntado: "¿Qué nos invita a hacer este año, Padre, durante la Cuaresma?" Tras mucha reflexión y oración, siento en mi corazón que necesitamos un ayuno que responda a los desafíos particulares de nuestro tiempo.



Vivimos en una época en la que las redes sociales y el uso de dispositivos digitales ocupan gran parte de nuestras jornadas. Sin darnos cuenta, muchas veces caemos en la trampa de la distracción constante, la comparación, la ansiedad y la superficialidad. Por eso, los invito especialmente este año a practicar el ayuno de redes sociales. No se trata simplemente de dejar de usar el teléfono o la computadora, sino de abrir un espacio en nuestro interior para el silencio y la escucha profunda de la voz de Dios.

El ayuno es mucho más que privarse de alimentos; es desprenderse de aquello que nos aleja de lo esencial. Al reducir nuestro consumo de redes sociales, ganamos tiempo y libertad interior para la oración serena, la lectura meditativa de la Palabra y el encuentro auténtico



con quienes nos rodean. Este sacrificio voluntario nos ayuda a reconocer dónde está puesta nuestra atención y a redirigirla hacia el Señor, fuente de todo sentido y plenitud.

Imaginen cuánto bien haría a nuestra vida espiritual dedicar cada día, aunque sea unos minutos, a estar en silencio ante Dios, lejos del ruido digital. La Escritura nos recuerda: "cuando ores, entra en tu aposento, y cuando hayas cerrado la puerta, ora a tu Padre que está en secreto." (Mt 6,6). Este es el espíritu que deseo que vivamos juntos: un camino de silencio, recogimiento y apertura a la gracia.

Los animo a que, como comunidad, nos apoyemos mutuamente en este propósito. Que al ayunar de las redes sociales, podamos descubrir la belleza de la presencia de Dios en lo cotidiano, renovar nuestros lazos familiares y fortalecer nuestra fe. Que este sacrificio nos conduzca a una Pascua verdaderamente renovada, con corazones abiertos y atentos a la voz del Señor.

Que María, Madre del Silencio, nos acompañe y nos ayude a vivir una Cuaresma fecunda.


