

Pastor Message

On this Third Sunday of Lent the Gospel brings us to a well in Samaria, where Jesus meets a woman who came simply to draw water. She arrives with an ordinary jar, at an ordinary hour, carrying the weight of an extraordinary life. Yet in that moment, the ordinary becomes holy ground—because Jesus is already waiting there.



He begins with a simple request: “Give me a drink.” But He is not just asking for water; He is opening a door to her heart. Jesus sees her thirst more deeply than she can name it. She has known disappointment, broken relationships, and the exhausting effort of starting again. Like many people, she has tried to

satisfy an inner emptiness with whatever seemed to promise relief. Still, her soul remains dry.

Jesus then offers something shocking: “If you knew the gift of God... he would have given you living water.” This is not water that merely refreshes for a moment. It is the water that becomes “a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” In other words, Jesus is offering the Holy Spirit, God’s own life poured into our hearts—grace that cleanses, heals, strengthens, and renews us from within.

Lent is a season of holy honesty, and this Gospel invites us to stand with the Samaritan woman and let Jesus speak the truth in love. He does not shame her. He does not avoid her story. He draws her into it, and then leads her beyond it. He shows her that she is not defined by her past, her failures, or her reputation. She is seen, known, and still loved. And that love becomes the beginning of her conversion.

We Christians are called to do the same this Lent: to allow Jesus to meet us at the “well” of our daily lives and to let Him give us the water of everlasting life. This means, through prayer, repentance, and trust. It means bringing Him our emptiness, our wounds, and our sins, and believing that His mercy is stronger than them all.



When the woman encounters Jesus, she leaves her water jar behind and runs to tell others. A heart that has tasted living water cannot keep it to itself.

This Lent, may we come to Jesus with our thirst, and may we receive from Him the only water that truly satisfies: the grace that leads to eternal life.

Have a blessed Sunday and a fruitful Lent!

ESTACIONES DE LA CRUZ

Como practica de la cuaresma es tradicional y meritorio rezar las estaciones de la cruz durante la cuaresma. Todos los viernes de cuaresmas después de la misa de ingles de las 5:15pm en la iglesia mayor.



LA CONFESION. La Cuaresma es un periodo litúrgico muy significativo para los cristianos, especialmente para los católicos, pues representa cuarenta días de preparación para la Pascua. Este tiempo invita a la reflexión, el arrepentimiento y la conversión personal, con el propósito de acercarnos más a Dios y renovar nuestra vida espiritual. Dentro de este proceso, el sacramento de la confesión adquiere una relevancia especial, ya que nos permite reconocer nuestras faltas, recibir el perdón y comenzar de nuevo con un corazón limpio.

Acudir a la confesión durante la Cuaresma es fundamental porque nos ayuda a romper con el pecado y a vivir una auténtica reconciliación con Dios, con los demás y con nosotros mismos. El acto de confesar no solo consiste en admitir nuestros errores, sino en abrirnos a la misericordia divina, experimentando el amor y el perdón que solo Dios puede ofrecer. Además, este sacramento nos motiva a realizar obras de caridad, ayuno y oración, pilares esenciales de la Cuaresma, desde una perspectiva renovada y sincera.

La confesión también nos brinda paz interior, fortalece nuestra voluntad y nos anima a afrontar los desafíos del día a día con mayor esperanza. Es una oportunidad para dejar atrás el resentimiento, la culpa y la tristeza que a veces nos impiden avanzar. Al reconciliarnos con Dios, recuperamos la alegría de ser hijos suyos y nos preparamos adecuadamente para celebrar la Pascua, el acontecimiento central de la fe cristiana. Por eso, aprovechar este sacramento durante la Cuaresma es un gesto que nos transforma y nos permite vivir con mayor plenitud el verdadero sentido de este tiempo litúrgico.

Del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos, en este Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma, el Evangelio nos lleva a un pozo en Samaría, donde Jesús se encuentra con una mujer que llegó con un cántaro para sacar agua. Parece un momento común, pero allí ocurre algo decisivo: Jesús ya la está esperando. Él toma la iniciativa y le dice: “Dame de beber”. Con esa petición sencilla, el Señor abre un camino hacia lo más profundo del corazón humano.



La samaritana representa a tantas personas que cargan cansancio interior, heridas, decepciones y una sed que no se apaga. Ella fue al pozo buscando agua para el cuerpo, pero Jesús revela que hay otra sed: la del alma. Por eso le dice: “Si conocieras el don de Dios... él te daría agua viva”. Esa “agua viva” es la vida de Dios en nosotros, la gracia que renueva, el Espíritu Santo que transforma por dentro y hace brotar esperanza donde antes había sequedad.

Jesús no ignora la historia de la mujer. La conoce y, sin humillarla, la conduce a la verdad. Esto es clave: el Señor no acusa para destruir, sino que ilumina para sanar. En Cuaresma también nosotros



somos invitados a dejar que Jesús nos mire con esa misma misericordia, a permitirle tocar nuestras zonas difíciles: pecados que repetimos, heridas que escondemos, resentimientos que guardamos, y hábitos que nos alejan de la alegría.

La samaritana, al principio, discute y se defiende. Pero poco a poco se abre. Y cuando se abre, descubre algo grande: Dios la busca, Dios la escucha, Dios la dignifica. Entonces su vida cambia. Ella deja el cántaro —símbolo de sus viejas búsquedas— y corre a anunciar: “Vengan a ver a un hombre que me ha dicho todo lo que he hecho”. El encuentro con Cristo la convierte en testigo.

También nosotros, como cristianos, debemos permitir que Jesús nos dé en esta Cuaresma el agua de la vida eterna. ¿Cómo? Con una oración más sincera, con arrepentimiento verdadero, con el sacramento de la reconciliación, y con gestos concretos de caridad. No basta con “cumplir” prácticas religiosas; se trata de dejar que Cristo sacie nuestra sed más profunda.

Que este domingo nos acerque al pozo con humildad. Allí está Jesús, esperándonos, para ofrecernos el agua que no se acaba: su amor que salva y conduce a la vida eterna.
