

Pastor Message

The fourth Sunday of Lent places before us one of the most striking signs in the Gospel: Jesus gives sight to a man born blind (John 9:1–41). The disciples begin with a question that sounds familiar to us: “Who sinned?” They want an explanation, a label, a simple cause. Jesus refuses that way of thinking. He does not reduce suffering to blame. In-



stead, he reveals a different horizon: this man's life will become a place where “the works of God” can be made visible.

Then Jesus does something very concrete. He spits on the ground, makes clay, anoints the man's eyes, and sends him to wash in the Pool of Siloam. The healing is not magic; it is a meeting. Jesus enters the man's dark-

ness, touches it, and leads him step by step into light. The man returns able to see—but the deeper journey is only beginning. He must face confusion, opposition, and interrogation. The religious leaders, who claim to see clearly, cannot rejoice. Their certainty becomes a prison. In the end, the man who was blind not only sees with his eyes; he comes to see with faith. When Jesus asks, “Do you believe in the Son of Man?” he answers, “Lord, I believe,” and he worships.

This is why the Church proclaims this Gospel during Lent: it is not only about one man long ago. It is about us. There are forms of blindness that do not involve our eyes: the blindness of pride that cannot admit it is wrong; the blindness of fear that keeps us from changing; the blindness of prejudice that refuses to see the dignity of another; the blindness of sin that numbs the conscience. Sometimes we prefer the darkness we know to the light that will ask something of us.

Today we also pray in a special way for those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. Through Baptism they will be plunged into Christ's death and raised into his life. They

will be given a new way of seeing: seeing themselves as beloved children of the Father, seeing the Church as a home, seeing the world as a place where God is already at work, and seeing Jesus as Lord. The ancient Church called Baptism “illumination” because Christ's light opens what was closed.

For those of us already baptized, Lent is a time to let Jesus touch our blindness again. We must allow him to take it—without excuses, without blaming others, without pretending we can see on our own. If we bring our darkness to Christ, he will not shame us. He will heal us, and he will teach us to walk as children of the light.

Have a blessed Sunday and a fruitful Lent!

Queridos hermanos, En este cuarto domingo de Cuaresma la Iglesia nos regala el evangelio del ciego de nacimiento (Jn 9). No es solo la historia de una curación, sino el relato de un camino: de la oscuridad a la luz, de la confusión a la fe, de mirar con los ojos a ver con el corazón. Jesús se presenta como la Luz del mundo, y su luz no se reduce a iluminar una situación externa; entra en lo más hondo de la persona para recrearla.



Jesús ve a este hombre cuando otros solo ven un problema o un motivo para discutir: "¿Quién pecó?". Cristo rompe esa lógica que busca culpables. Para Él, la vida no es un lugar donde puede manifestarse la obra de Dios. Hace barro con saliva, lo unge y lo envía a lavarse en la piscina de Siloé. Es un gesto humilde, casi desconcertante: Dios utiliza lo sencillo para sanar; y pide una respuesta concreta. El ciego obedece, va, se lava... y comienza a ver.

Pero el milagro no termina en los ojos. A partir de ahí, el hombre entra en un proceso de crecimiento interior: primero habla de "ese hombre que se llama Jesús", luego reconoce que es "profeta", más tarde afirma que viene de Dios, y finalmente se postra y confiesa: "Creo, Señor". En cambio, los fariseos, seguros de su propio saber, se van cerrando. Ellos ven, pero no reconocen; analizan, pero no se dejan tocar; controlan la ley, pero pierden al Dios vivo. Esa es la verdadera ceguera: la del corazón que no quiere convertirse.



Por eso este domingo, llamado también *Laetare*, nos invita a alegrarnos: la luz ya está actuando en medio de nuestra Cuaresma. Y esa alegría se vuelve aún más concreta cuando pensamos en quienes serán bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual. Ellos se acercan a la fuente verdadera, a Cristo, para ser iluminados: el Bautismo es abrir los ojos a una vida nueva, ver el mundo desde la gracia, reconocer al Señor presente y aprender a caminar como hijos de la luz.

También nosotros, cristianos ya bautizados, necesitamos volver una y otra vez a ese lavatorio interior. Hay cegueras que se nos pegan: prejuicios, indiferencia ante el sufrimiento, orgullo espiritual, miedo a la verdad, costumbre de vivir "a medias". Hoy la Palabra nos pide humildad para reconocerlas y valentía para dejarnos sanar. Permitamos que Jesús "nos quite" la ceguera, aunque al principio duela ver lo que evitábamos. Acerquémonos a Él en la oración, en la reconciliación, en la caridad concreta; y digámosle con sencillez: "Señor, quiero ver". Entonces, como el ciego de nacimiento, podremos pasar de hablar de Dios a encontrarnos con Él, y nuestra vida se hará testimonio de su luz.
