## Pastor Message

Dear brothers and sisters, the account of Lazarus in gospel of John 11:1–45 offers one of the clearest and most powerful glimpses into the promise of the resurrection of our bodies. In this passage, we encounter grief, delay, faith, and ultimately, the undeniable authority of Jesus Christ over death itself.

Lazarus, a beloved friend of Jesus, falls ill

John 11:43

and dies. His sisters, Mary and Martha, are overwhelmed with sorrow, questioning why Jesus did not come sooner. Their pain reflects a reality we all understand—the deep anguish that comes with loss and the seeming finality of death. Yet, Jesus approaches this moment with a divine purpose that goes beyond immediate healing. He declares, “I

am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die.” In this statement, Jesus points not only to Lazarus’ impending restoration but to a greater truth about the destiny of all who believe.

When Jesus arrives at the tomb, He is deeply moved. He weeps alongside those who mourn, showing that God is not distant from human suffering. However, His compassion is not the end of the story. Standing before the sealed tomb, Jesus commands that the stone be rolled away. Despite doubt and the reality of decay, He prepares to demonstrate the power of God in a visible and undeniable way.

Then comes the defining moment: Jesus cries out in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out!” This is not a whisper, nor a symbolic gesture. It is a command. With that authoritative call, Lazarus emerges from the grave, still wrapped in burial cloths. This moment reveals something extraordinary—Jesus does not merely comfort in the face of death; He commands it. His voice carries authority over the grave itself.

This miracle is not only about Lazarus. It serves as a sign pointing forward to the res-

urrection of all believers. Just as Lazarus was called out of physical death, so too will those who belong to Christ be raised. The resurrection of our bodies is not an abstract hope, but a promised reality grounded in the power and authority of Jesus.

The loud call at the tomb signifies that death is not sovereign—Christ is. One day, that same commanding voice will call forth all who are in the graves. What happened in Bethany is a preview of what is to come: bodies restored, life renewed, and death defeated.

Therefore, this passage calls us to faith. It invites us to trust not only in Christ’s compassion but in His power. The resurrection of Lazarus reminds us that no grave is too sealed, no death too final, and no situation beyond the reach of the One who is the resurrection and the life.



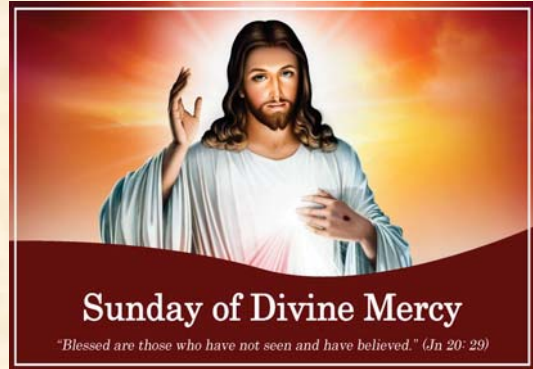

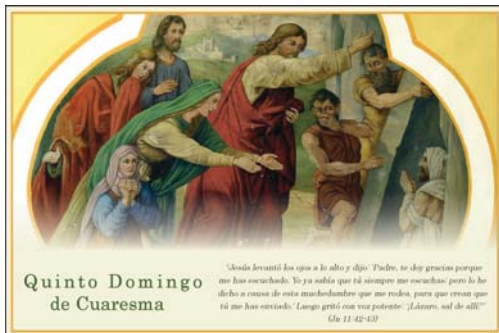
