This achievement would not have been possible without your unwavering support, generosity, and prayers. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to each and every one of you who

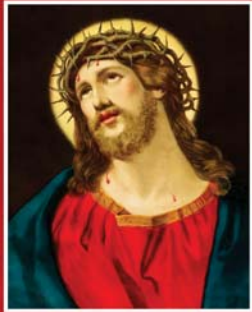
contributed in any way. Your commitment to our parish is a true testament to the strength and unity of our community.

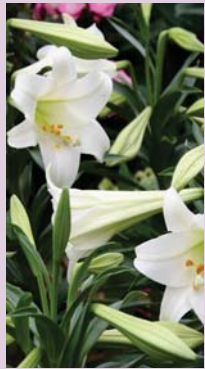

Our Diocesan policy of the Essential Three requires that all who minister work, or volunteer in the Diocese complete background screening, training and agree to a code of conduct. 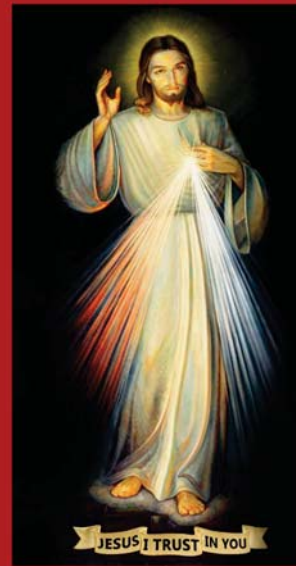

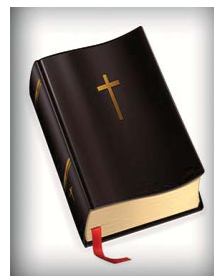

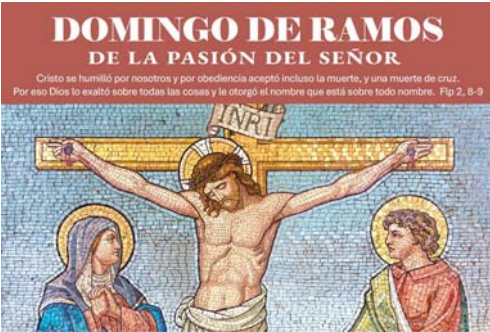
