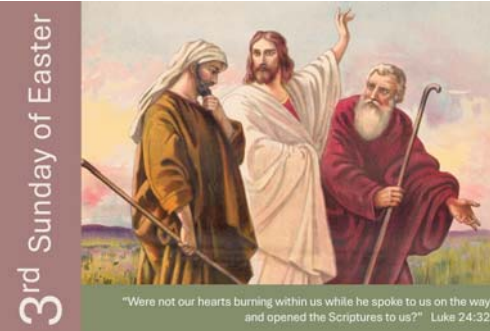

Pastor Message

Dear brothers and sisters, on this Third Sunday of Easter, we reflect on the moving story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, where the risen Jesus Christ draws near to two discouraged followers who cannot recognize him. Their hearts are heavy with confusion, grief, and shattered expectations. They had hoped for redemption, yet the

answered prayers, and quiet doubts. In those moments, our vision becomes clouded. Like the disciples, we speak about Jesus, we even long for him, yet we fail to see that he is already beside us. Our sadness narrows our perspective, and our lack of faith dims our awareness of his presence.

ing Jesus today? Is it fear, distraction, or disappointment? The risen Lord continues to walk with us, even when we feel lost or alone.



Jesus does not abandon them in their confusion. Instead, he walks with them, listens patiently, and gently opens the Scriptures to reveal a deeper truth: that suffering and glory are intertwined in God's plan. Even when unrecognized, he is guiding, teaching, and healing. Their hearts begin to burn within them, a quiet sign that grace is at work before their eyes are opened.

Let us ask for the grace to see with renewed faith. May our hearts burn with his presence, and may we recognize him not only in extraordinary moments, but in the quiet, daily journey of our lives.

cross seemed to silence that hope. As they walk away from Jerusalem, they also walk away from the community and from the promise they once believed.

It is only in the breaking of the bread that they finally recognize him. This moment reminds us that Jesus is made known in simple, sacred encounters—especially in the Eucharist. Yet how easily we miss him. We expect dramatic signs, while he comes in humble, ordinary ways.

As we return to our own Jerusalems, may we become witnesses like those disciples, who ran back with renewed joy to share the good news. Faith is not the absence of struggle, but the courage to trust that Jesus is present within it. Even in uncertainty, he is alive and near. Always calling us to hope and believe again. God bless you all!

Saint Mark the Evangelist

FIRST CENTURY | FEAST DAY — APRIL 25

According to the Acts of the Apostles, Mark's mother owned the house where the first Jerusalem Christians prayed and where Peter stayed after his miraculous release from prison (Acts 12:1-19). The New Testament also notes that Mark traveled with Paul and Barnabas on their mission to Antioch and that he was associated with both Paul and Peter in Rome. He may have written his Gospel, the shortest of the four, based on Peter's preaching while in Rome. By tradition, he was the martyred bishop of Alexandria, Egypt, with his relics later carried to Venice by Venetian merchants. In art, he is often symbolized by a lion. He is the patron saint of lions, lawyers, Venice, interpreters, and prisoners.

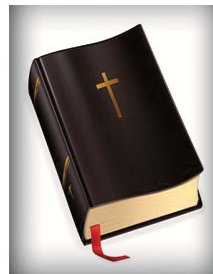

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos, en este Tercer Domingo de Pascua, la Iglesia nos invita a meditar el hermoso relato del encuentro entre los discípulos de Emaús y Jesús resucitado. Este pasaje nos muestra con claridad cómo la tristeza, el desánimo y la falta de fe pueden impedirnos reconocer la presencia viva

de Jesús en nuestro camino cotidiano. No lo reconocen, porque sus ojos están velados por la tristeza.

También nosotros vivimos situaciones similares. Cuando enfrentamos dificultades, pérdidas o incertidumbres, es fácil caer en la desesperanza. Muchas veces hablamos de Dios, incluso rezamos, pero no somos capaces de percibir que Él está a nuestro lado. Nuestra falta de fe y nuestras preocupaciones nublan nuestra visión y nos impiden descubrir su presencia amorosa.

Jesús no se impone, sino que acompaña con paciencia. Escucha, pregunta y luego ilumina sus corazones explicando las Escrituras. Les ayuda a comprender que el sufrimiento no es el final, sino parte del camino hacia la gloria. Poco a poco, algo cambia dentro de ellos: sienten arder su corazón, aunque aún no logran reconocerlo plenamente.

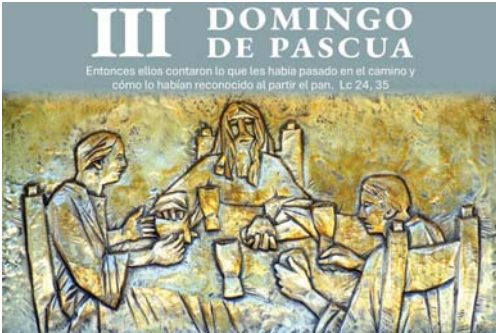
Es en el gesto sencillo de partir el pan cuando finalmente sus ojos se abren. En ese momento descubren que era Él quien caminaba con ellos todo el tiempo. Este signo nos recuerda que Jesús se hace presente

de manera especial en la Eucaristía, pero también en los pequeños gestos de amor, en la escucha a los tristes y los necesitados.

Este Evangelio nos invita a preguntarnos: ¿qué nos impide reconocer a Jesús hoy? ¿La tristeza, el miedo, la rutina o la falta de fe? Él sigue caminando a nuestro lado, incluso cuando no lo vemos.

Pidamos la gracia de tener un corazón atento y una mirada renovada. Que sepamos reconocer a Cristo en nuestra vida diaria y que, como los discípulos, podamos levantarnos con alegría para anunciar que Él vive. Porque, aun en medio de la oscuridad, Jesús nunca deja de acompañarnos.
