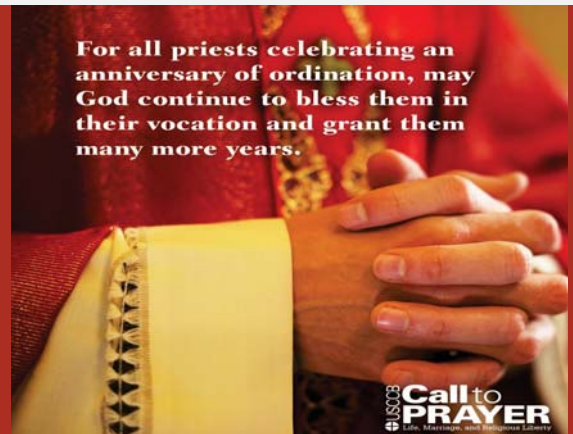

Pastor Message

Dear brothers and sisters, as we celebrate the Seventh Sunday of Easter, the Church invites us to reflect prayerfully on the beautiful moment described in the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles. After Jesus was taken up into heaven, the Apostles returned to Jerusalem and gathered together in prayer with several women, including



Mary, the Mother of Jesus. Together they waited with hope and trust for the coming of the Holy Spirit. This was the first Novena to the Holy Spirit — nine days of faithful prayer, unity, and expectation before Pentecost.

This sacred gathering reminds us that the Church is born from prayer and strengthened by the presence of the Holy Spirit. Just as

the Apostles waited with confidence for God's promise to be fulfilled, we too are called to open our hearts to the Spirit's guidance and grace in our daily lives. During these final days before Pentecost, let us ask the Holy Spirit to renew our parish with deeper faith, joy, and courage to witness to Christ.

Mensaje del Padre Mariano
