Liturgy



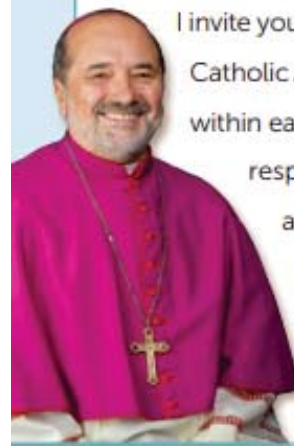
