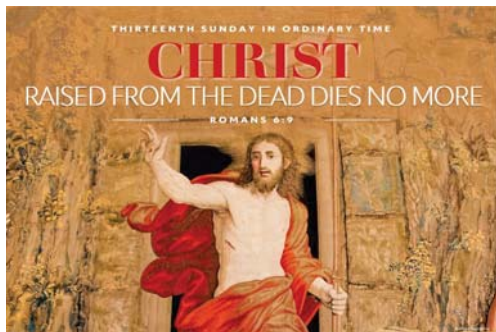

Pastor Message

In this Sunday's second reading, St. Paul invites us to contemplate one of the deepest mysteries of our faith: through Baptism, we are united to the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. He writes, "We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might



live in newness of life. If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him" (Romans 6:4, 8). These words speak powerfully to our hearts as we recall the tragedy that a family in Acushnet experienced three weeks ago with the sudden loss of their child. As a parish community, we continue to pray for the par-

ents, relatives, and friends who are carrying the heavy burden of grief. Their sorrow reminds us how fragile life can be and how helpless we often feel before the reality of death.

The mystery of death has challenged humanity throughout the ages. Human reason alone cannot fully explain it or remove the pain it causes. Yet faith in Christ Jesus allows us to see beyond what our eyes can perceive. In His death on the Cross and His glorious resurrection, Jesus transformed death forever. What once appeared to be an end became, through Him, the doorway to eternal life.

Baptism is not simply a ceremony or a family celebration. It is a profound participation in the Paschal Mystery of Christ. Through the waters of Baptism, we die to sin and are reborn as children of God. We become members of Christ's Body and heirs to the promise of resurrection. Therefore, when we face the death of a loved one, we grieve, but not without hope. We trust in the Lord who conquered death and opened the gates of heaven to those who believe in Him.

As we reflect on this mystery, let us also express our gratitude to all who participated in the 85th Annual Catholic Appeal of the Diocese of Fall River. Through your generosity and commitment, the 2026 Catholic Appeal has raised an inspiring \$3,333,229. Your support strengthens the many ministries, charitable works, and outreach programs that bring Christ's love and hope to countless individuals and families throughout our diocese.



May the Lord continue to bless our parish community, comfort all who mourn, and deepen our faith in the promise that those who die with Christ shall also live with Him forever.

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, la segunda lectura de este domingo nos invita a contemplar uno de los misterios más profundos de nuestra fe cristiana: por el Bautismo somos incorporados a la muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo. San Pablo nos recuerda: «Fuimos sepultados con Él por el Bautismo en la muerte, para que, así como Cristo resucitó de entre



los muertos por la gloria del Padre, también nosotros llevemos una vida nueva. Y si hemos muerto con Cristo, creemos que también viviremos con Él» (Rm 6, 4.8).

Estas palabras adquieren un significado especial cuando recordamos la tragedia que una familia de Acushnet vivió hace tres semanas con la repentina pérdida de su hijo. Como co-

munidad de fe, seguimos unidos en oración por los padres, familiares y amigos que sufren esta dolorosa ausencia. Ninguna palabra humana puede aliviar completamente una herida tan profunda, pero podemos acompañarlos con nuestra cercanía, nuestro cariño y, sobre todo, con nuestra oración.

La muerte sigue siendo uno de los grandes misterios de la existencia humana. Frente a ella experimentamos tristeza, incertidumbre y muchas preguntas. ¿Por qué sucede? ¿Por qué tan pronto? ¿Por qué a una familia que tanto ama a su hijo? Son interrogantes que muchas veces quedan sin respuesta. Sin embargo, la fe en Cristo Jesús nos permite mirar más allá del dolor inmediato y descubrir una esperanza que no decepciona.

Por el Bautismo hemos sido unidos a Cristo. Así como Él pasó por la muerte para entrar en la gloria de la resurrección, también nosotros estamos llamados a compartir su victoria. El Bautismo no es solamente una celebración o una tradición familiar; es una participación real en el misterio pascual de Cristo. En las aguas bautismales morimos al pecado y nacemos a una vida nueva como hijos e hijas de Dios. Por eso, para quienes creen en Cristo, la muerte

no tiene la última palabra.

Esta esperanza cristiana no elimina las lágrimas ni el sufrimiento, pero nos sostiene en medio de ellos. Sabemos que el Señor resucitado permanece con nosotros y cumple sus promesas. Aquellos que mueren unidos a Cristo participarán también de su vida eterna.

Aprovechamos también esta oportunidad para expresar nuestro sincero agradecimiento a todos los que han participado en la 85.ª Campaña Católica Anual de la Diócesis de Fall River. Gracias a su generosidad, la Campaña Católica de 2026 ha recaudado hasta el momento \$3,333,229. Su apoyo fortalece las obras pastorales, educativas y caritativas de nuestra diócesis y lleva la esperanza de Cristo a muchas personas necesitadas.

Que el Señor consuele a quienes sufren, fortalezca nuestra fe y renueve en todos nosotros la esperanza de la resurrección y de la vida eterna.

Liturgia

¿Por qué tenemos velas votivas en nuestra parroquia?

Las velas votivas son una hermosa expresión de oración y fe. Cuando encendemos una vela ante un santo, su luz simboliza nuestra fe y nuestra confianza en la intercesión de ese santo ante Dios. La llama también representa la intención particular que presentamos en oración: ya sea por el eterno descanso de un ser querido, la salud de una persona enferma, una situación difícil, el regreso de un familiar a la fe o cualquier otra necesidad personal.

La vela encendida es un recordatorio visible de nuestra oración y de nuestra esperanza en el amor y la providencia de Dios. Incluso después de que dejamos la iglesia, la llama continúa simbolizando la intención que hemos confiado al Señor. Y si la vela llegara a apagarse, podemos estar seguros de que Dios ya ha escuchado nuestra oración; Su atención y Su amor por nuestras necesidades no dependen de la llama misma.

Las velas votivas nos ayudan a expresar exteriormente lo que llevamos en el corazón y nos recuerdan que estamos llamados a perseverar en la oración y a confiar en la voluntad de Dios.

Animo a todos a hacer uso de las velas votivas disponibles en nuestra iglesia. Son una forma sencilla, pero profundamente significativa, de poner nuestras intenciones en las manos de Dios y de unirnos más íntimamente a la oración de toda la Iglesia.

Al reunirnos para la Santa Misa y otras celebraciones sagradas, recordamos que la manera en que nos vestimos refleja nuestro respeto por la ocasión y por aquellos con quienes nos encontramos. En muchos lugares existe un protocolo de vestimenta para asistir a eventos importantes o para encontrarse con personas distinguidas. ¡Cuánto más debemos ser conscientes de ello cuando nos presentamos ante la presencia de Dios!

Cuando entramos en la iglesia, venimos a adorar al Señor, a ofrecerle nuestras oraciones y sacrificios, y a encontrarnos con Él en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Nuestra forma de vestir debe reflejar la santidad de este encuentro. Vestir con modestia, respeto y decoro no tiene que ver con la moda ni con juzgar a los demás; es una manera de expresar nuestra reverencia a Dios y nuestro respeto por la santidad de Su casa.

La Sagrada Escritura nos recuerda que nuestros cuerpos son templos del Espíritu Santo. Por ello, la forma en que nos presentamos debe reflejar la dignidad que Dios nos ha concedido y nuestra conciencia de que estamos entrando en un lugar sagrado. Animamos cordialmente a todos —niños, jóvenes y adultos— a elegir una vestimenta adecuada para la Santa Misa y los actos religiosos. De esta manera, contribuimos a crear un ambiente de oración, recogimiento y devoción, tanto para nosotros mismos como para quienes nos rodean. Agradecemos sinceramente su colaboración para preservar el sentido de lo sagrado en nuestra parroquia y su compromiso de honrar al Señor en todo lo que hacemos. Que Dios bendiga abundantemente a cada uno de ustedes y a sus familias.

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
