Pastor Message

Dear parishioners, this Sunday's Gospel presents us with the familiar parable of the sower who went out to sow. As the seed was scattered, it fell on different kinds of ground: the path, rocky soil, among thorns, and on rich soil. Jesus explains that the seed is the Word of God, the words of eternal life, and the different kinds of soil represent the differ-

ent dispositions of our hearts. The same Word is proclaimed to everyone, yet each person receives it differently. This Gospel invites us to examine ourselves. How do I receive the Word of God in my life? Do I come to Mass prepared to listen with an open heart? Do I truly pay attention to the readings, the Gospel, and the homily, or do I

allow distractions, worries, or indifference to keep the seed from taking root? God's Word has the power to transform our lives, but only if we allow it to grow within us. This week, I encourage you to reflect on the condition of your own heart and ask the Lord to make it fertile soil where His Word can bear abundant fruit.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has requested a special collection to assist those affected by the devastating earthquake in Venezuela. This collection will be taken on Sunday, July 26. Your generosity will bring hope and relief to many families who are suffering. Above all, let us continue to keep the people of Venezuela in our prayers, asking the Lord to strengthen them and bless all those who are providing aid.

I hope you are enjoying the beautiful summer weather. Take time to rest, stay cool, and enjoy these precious days with your family and loved ones. Even during the busy summer months, let us remember that Sunday Mass remains the center of our Christian life. I look forward to seeing you in church each weekend.

Work around our parish continues to move forward. Thank you for your continued generosity, patience, and support as we make improvements to our parish home.

This weekend I will be in Dallas, Texas, participating in the IVE meeting Conference together with faithful from the different parishes where we serve. Please keep the priests, sisters, and parishioners of St. Anthony's and Immaculate Conception in your prayers. Be assured that we will remember all of you in ours.

May God bless you and your families with His peace and abundant grace.

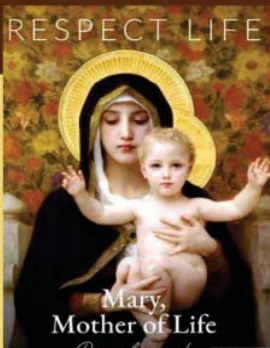

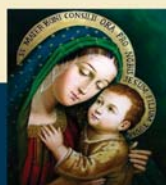
PILGRIM VIRGIN HOME VISTATION STATUE

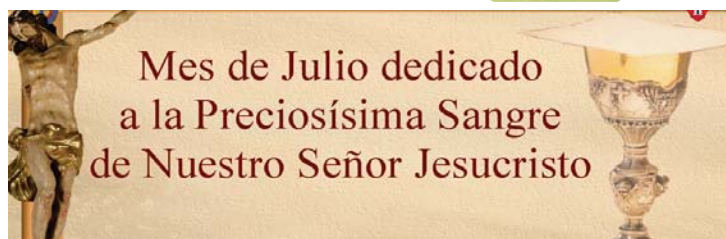
