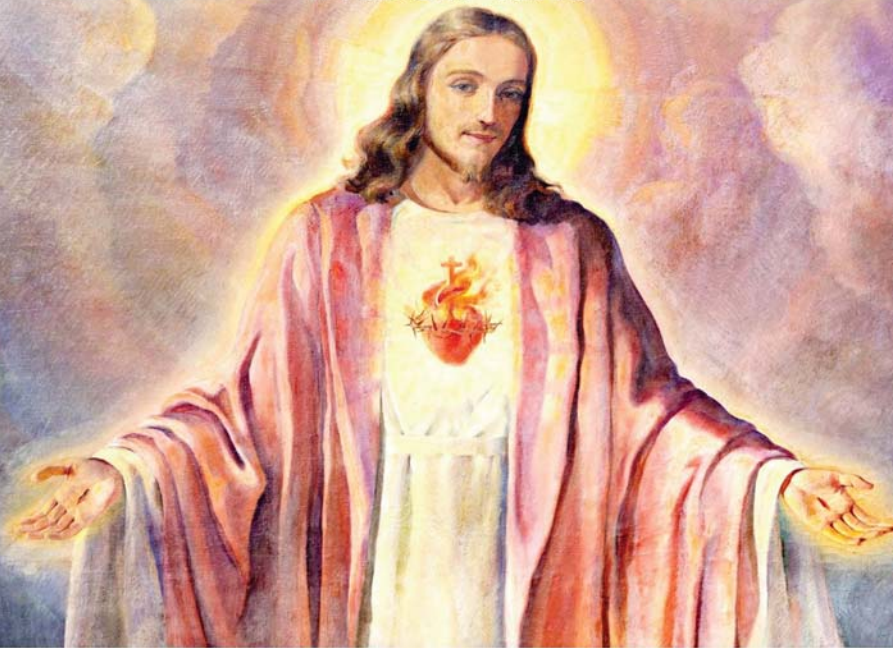

Pastor Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters, this Sunday, Jesus continues to teach us through parables. Last week we reflected on the Parable of the Sower and the different ways people receive the Word of God. This week, the Lord presents another lesson: the Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds. Jesus tells us that while everyone was asleep, the enemy came

and sowed weeds among the wheat. Later, Jesus Himself explains the meaning of the parable. The good seed represents the children of the Kingdom, while the weeds are the work of the evil one. This Gospel invites each of us to examine our own hearts. Through Baptism, God planted within us the seed of faith and entrusted us with His Word. How are we receiving that gift today? Are we nurturing it through prayer, the sacraments, and acts of charity, or have we become spiritually "asleep," allowing the evil one to sow the weeds of indifference, resentment, doubt, or sin? It is not enough simply to have ears that hear. Jesus calls us to listen attentively, to welcome His Word into our hearts, and to put it into practice every day. When we remain awake in faith, rooted in Christ and nourished by His grace, the good seed grows and bears abundant fruit. Let us ask the Lord to keep us vigilant so that our lives may reflect His love and truth in all that we do.

Last week, twenty-one of us, together with the Sisters and parishioners from St. Anthony's and Immaculate Conception, had the blessing of attending the IVE Conference in Dallas, Texas. The conference focused on the family and on helping families become joyful witnesses of the Gospel in today's world. There were inspiring presentations for adults as well as special programs and activities for children, teenagers, and young adults. We are grateful for this opportunity

and pray that the fruits of the conference will strengthen our families and enrich our parish communities.

I also invite everyone to join us for our Parish Picnic next Sunday, July 26, at Cathedral Camp. I hope to see many families there as we enjoy an evening of fellowship, friendship, and fun. Gathering together outside of church is another wonderful way to strengthen the bonds that unite us as one parish family.

Next weekend, we will take up a special collection to assist those affected by the recent earthquake in Venezuela. Your generosity is a beautiful witness of Christian charity and solidarity with those who are suffering. Thank you for your continued kindness, compassion, and prayers for our brothers and sisters in need. May the Lord keep us awake in faith, attentive to His Word, and generous in love toward one another. God bless you and your families.

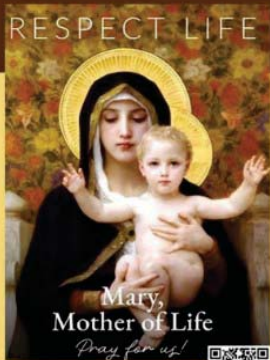

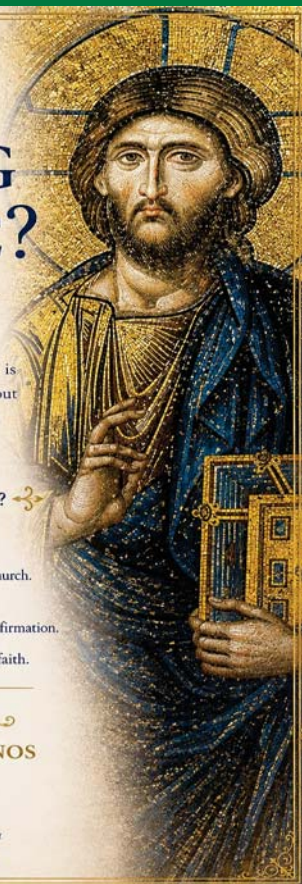

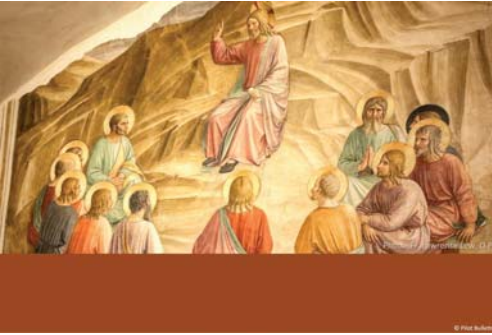

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos, en este XVI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, el Señor continúa enseñándonos por medio de las parábolas. Después de la parábola del sembrador, el Evangelio nos presenta una nueva enseñanza: la parábola del trigo y la cizaña. Jesús nos dice que, mientras los sembradores dormían, vino el enemigo



y sembró cizaña en medio del trigo. Más adelante, el mismo Jesús ofrece la mejor interpretación de esta parábola, ayudándonos a comprender que la buena semilla representa a los hijos del Reino, mientras que la cizaña es obra del maligno.

Esta enseñanza nos invita a hacer un examen sincero de nuestra vida espiritual. En el Bautis-

mo, Dios sembró en nuestros corazones la semilla de la fe y nos regaló su Palabra para que creciera y diera fruto. Sin embargo, el Evangelio nos plantea una pregunta muy importante: ¿cómo estamos recibiendo hoy esa Palabra de Dios? ¿Estamos despiertos y vigilantes en la fe, o nos hemos quedado "dormidos", permitiendo que el enemigo siembre en nosotros la cizaña del pecado, la indiferencia, la división o el desánimo?

No basta con tener oídos para oír. El Señor nos llama a escuchar con atención, a acoger su Palabra con un corazón abierto y a ponerla en práctica cada día. Solo así la buena semilla podrá crecer y producir abundantes frutos de amor, esperanza y santidad. Pidamos al Señor la gracia de permanecer vigilantes, alimentando nuestra fe con la oración, los sacramentos y el servicio generoso a los demás.

La semana pasada, veintiuno de nosotros, junto con las Hermanas y feligreses de las parroquias de San Antonio y de la Inmaculada Concepción, tuvimos la alegría de participar en la Conferencia del IVE, celebrada en Dallas, Texas. El tema central fue la familia y cómo fortalecerla para que sea un auténtico testimonio del Evangelio en el mundo de hoy. Además

de las conferencias para los adultos, hubo actividades especiales para niños, adolescentes y jóvenes, ofreciendo a cada uno la oportunidad de crecer en la fe y compartir con otras familias. Damos gracias a Dios por esta hermosa experiencia y pedimos que los frutos de este encuentro se reflejen en nuestras comunidades.

Les recuerdo también que el próximo domingo 26 de julio celebraremos nuestro Picnic Parroquial en Cathedral Camp. Espero que muchas familias puedan acompañarnos para compartir una tarde de alegría, convivencia y fraternidad como una sola familia parroquial.

Asimismo, el próximo fin de semana realizaremos una colecta especial para ayudar a las víctimas del reciente terremoto en Venezuela. 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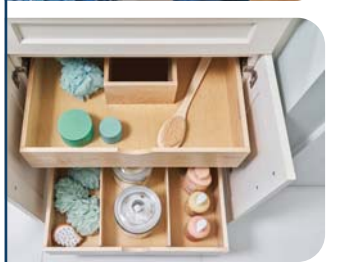
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
