In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus compares the Kingdom of Heaven to a treasure hidden in a field and to a pearl of great price. In both parables, the person who discovers the treasure recognizes its incomparable value. With wisdom and joy, he willingly sells everything he owns to obtain it. Jesus is teaching us that the Kingdom of God is worth more than anything this world can offer. A wise person knows where to invest his or her life—not in temporary riches, but in the eternal treasures that lead to everlasting life.

God has not left us alone to figure this out. He has given us the gift of the Holy Spirit, who enlightens our minds, strengthens our hearts, and guides our decisions. The Holy Spirit helps us distinguish right from wrong, choose what pleases God, and live faithfully in a world filled with distractions and tempta-

St. Paul reminds us with great hope that "all things work together for good for those who love God." Even the trials, disappointments, and challenges we face can become opportunities for grace when we trust in God's loving plan. Nothing is wasted in the hands of God.

This week, let us ask our Heavenly Father for the gift of wisdom above all else. May He grant us understanding hearts to recognize the true treasure of His Kingdom and the strength to seek it above everything else.

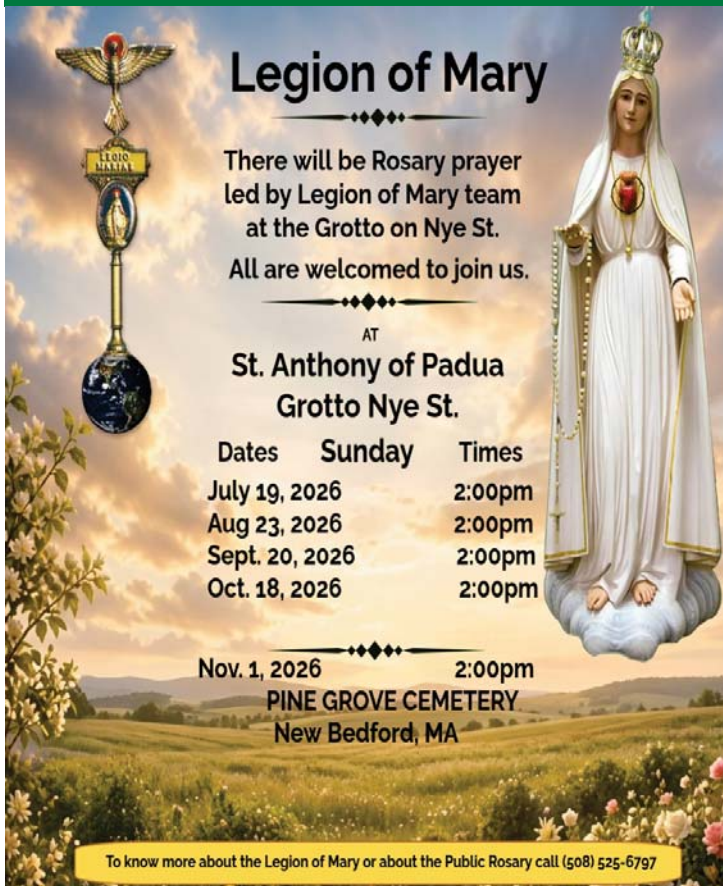

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Imagínese por un momento que usted está en el lugar del rey Salomón. Dios se le aparece y le dice: "Pídemelo que quieras, y yo te lo concederé." ¿Qué le pediría? Quizás pensaríamos en salud, paz para nuestra familia, seguridad económica o éxito en nuestros proyectos. Todas esas peticiones son buenas, pero la respuesta de Salomón



nos enseña cuál debe ser nuestra prioridad. Salomón le pidió a Dios "un corazón capaz de escuchar para gobernar a tu pueblo y distinguir entre el bien y el mal." No pidió riquezas, poder ni una larga vida; pidió sabiduría para cumplir fielmente la misión que Dios le había confiado. Su oración agradó

tanto al Señor que, además de concederle sabiduría, lo bendijo abundantemente.

Jesús nos hace una promesa aún más grande cuando dice: "Todo lo que pidan al Padre en mi nombre, Él se lo concederá." Por eso, al acercarnos a nuestro Padre celestial en la oración, también nosotros debemos pedir, antes que nada, la sabiduría para reconocer su voluntad y la fortaleza para cumplirla. Necesitamos un corazón prudente que sepa discernir entre el bien y el mal y que tome decisiones según el Evangelio.

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús compara el Reino de los Cielos con un tesoro escondido en un campo y con una perla de gran valor. En ambas parábolas, quien encuentra el tesoro reconoce inmediatamente su inmenso valor. Con alegría vende todo lo que posee para comprar el campo o adquirir la perla preciosa. Jesús nos enseña que la persona verdaderamente sabia sabe reconocer lo que vale la pena y está dispuesta a dejar todo por alcanzar el mayor de los tesoros: el Reino de Dios.

El Señor no nos deja solos en este camino. Nos ha dado el don del Espíritu Santo para

iluminar nuestra mente, fortalecer nuestro corazón y guiarnos en nuestras decisiones. El Espíritu Santo nos ayuda a vivir en medio del mundo sin perder de

vista nuestra meta final: dar gloria a Dios y alcanzar la salvación de nuestra alma. Con su ayuda aprendemos a invertir nuestra vida en aquello que tiene valor eterno.

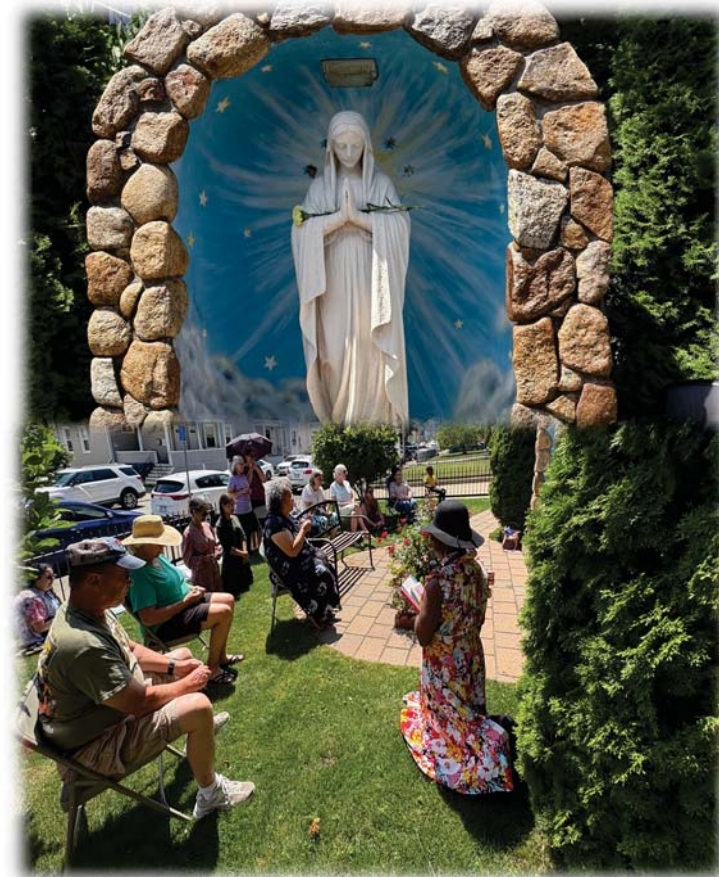

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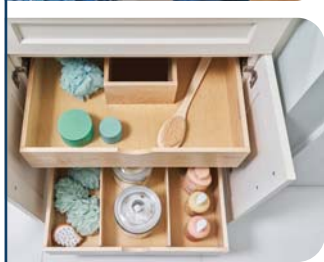
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
