The readings for this Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time invite us to reflect on the deepest hunger of the human heart and on the only One who can truly satisfy it. In the Gospel according to St. Matthew, Jesus compassionately feeds the hungry crowd with only a few loaves of bread. Everyone eats until they are satisfied, and there are

is the Bread of Life that strengthens us, heals us, and fills our hearts with the grace that no earthly food can provide. God's generosity is never exhausted. There is always more than enough for those who come to Him with faith.

The first reading from the prophet Isaiah echoes this same invitation. The prophet asks, "Why spend your money for what is not bread, your wages for what fails to satisfy?" How often we seek fulfillment in material possessions, worldly success, or temporary pleasures, only to discover that they leave us wanting more. Isaiah calls us instead to come freely to the Lord, who offers us "wine and milk without price." These are beautiful signs of God's abundant blessings and His unconditional love. The Lord alone can satisfy the deepest desires of our hearts because He alone is the source of life.

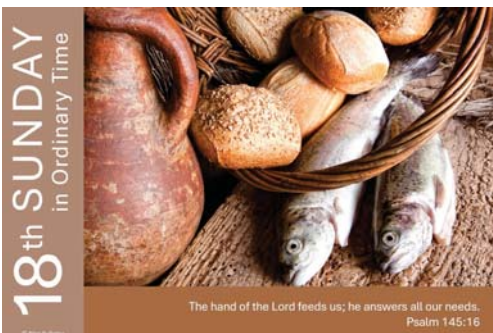
As we reflect on these readings, may we examine where we invest our time, our energy, and our hearts. May we choose what truly lasts: a deeper relationship with God, faithful participation in the Holy Eucharist, and lives of charity, justice, and service.
