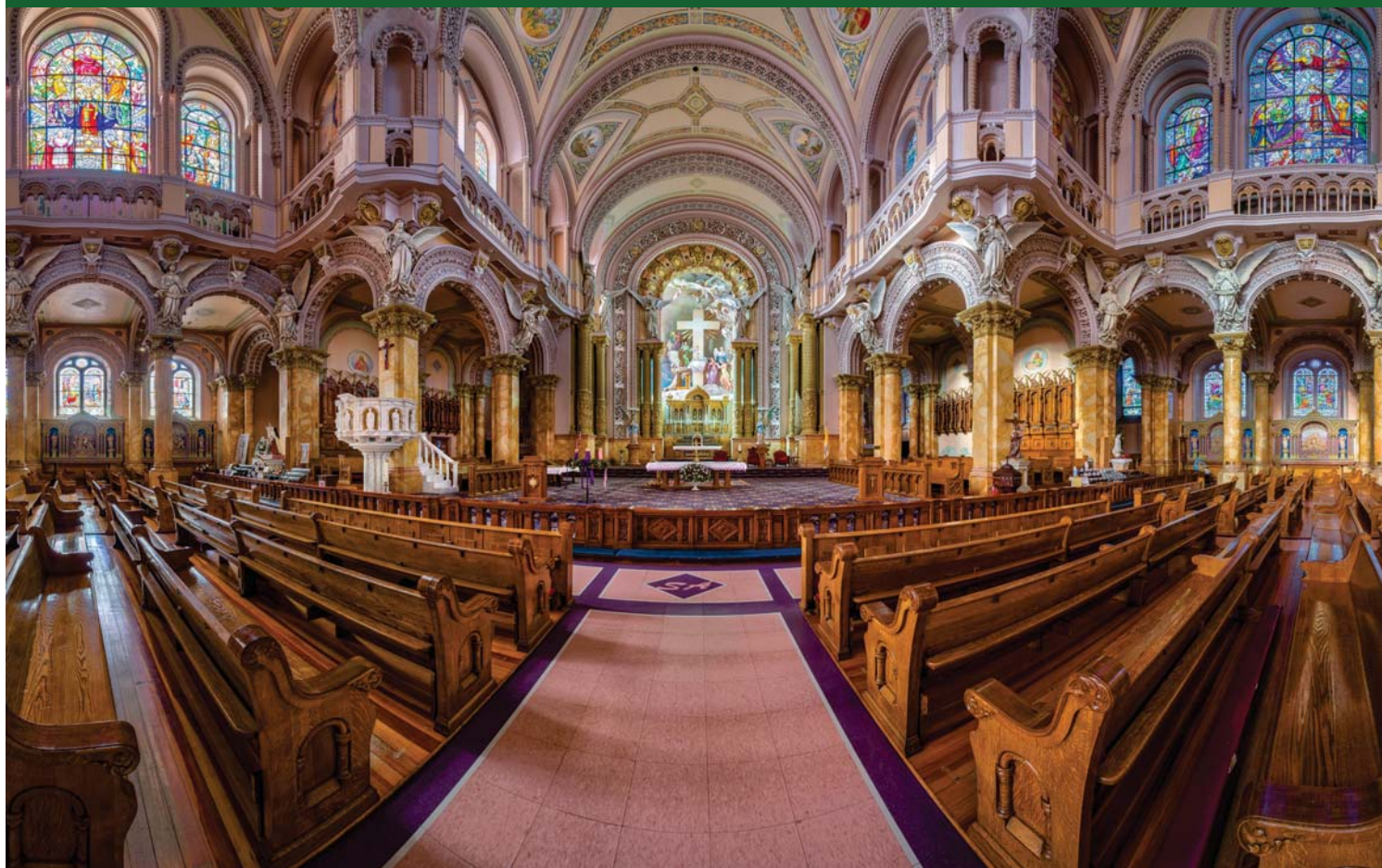

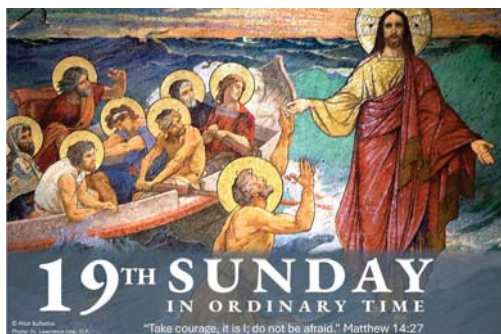

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Querida familia parroquial: como muchos de ustedes ya habrán notado, nuestra parroquia continúa avanzando en su proceso de restauración. Después de los trabajos realizados en el exterior del templo, ahora hemos comenzado una nueva etapa en el interior de nuestra iglesia. La empresa Tiede-



man será la encargada de reparar la parte del techo donde el revestimiento se ha desprendido. Esta restauración es necesaria para conservar la belleza, la seguridad y la integridad de nuestra hermosa parroquia.

Se estima que estos trabajos tendrán una duración aproximada de seis a ocho meses. Durante este tiempo, es posible que experi-

mentemos algunas incomodidades o cambios temporales en el uso de ciertos espacios. Les agradecemos de corazón su paciencia, comprensión y colaboración. De manera especial, quiero expresar mi sincero agradecimiento por la generosidad con la que continúan apoyando a nuestra parroquia mediante sus oraciones, su tiempo y sus aportaciones económicas. Gracias a su compromiso, seguimos fortaleciendo nuestra comunidad de fe.

También me complace informarles que el próximo proyecto será la renovación del piso del salón parroquial. Este importante trabajo ya ha recibido la aprobación de nuestro Obispo y del Comité Diocesano de Construcción. Con la ayuda de Dios y el apoyo de todos ustedes, continuaremos mejorando nuestras instalaciones para servir mejor a toda la comunidad parroquial.

Las lecturas de este domingo nos ofrecen un hermoso mensaje de esperanza y confianza. En la primera lectura, el profeta Elías descubre que Dios no se manifiesta en el viento fuerte, ni en el terremoto, ni en el fuego, sino en el suave murmullo de una brisa.

Así nos enseña que el Señor muchas veces habla a nuestro corazón en el silencio y en la serenidad.

En el Evangelio, Jesús anima a Pedro en medio de la tormenta diciéndole: «No tengas miedo». Mientras Pedro mantiene su mirada fija en Jesús, puede caminar sobre las aguas. Cuando el miedo lo invade, el Señor extiende inmediatamente su mano para sostenerlo. Este pasaje nos recuerda que, aun en los momentos de mayor dificultad, Cristo nunca nos abandona.

Que también nosotros aprendamos a confiar como el profeta Elías y como san Pedro. En medio de las pruebas, de las incertidumbres y de los desafíos de la vida, recordemos que nuestro Padre celestial siempre camina a nuestro lado. Jesús está al mando de nuestras vidas y jamás deja de acompañarnos con su amor y su misericordia. Gracias por su paciencia, su generosidad y su fidelidad a nuestra parroquia. ¡Feliz domingo!
