Pastor Message

As we gather this Sunday as one family of faith, our hearts are called to prayer, compassion, and action. This week, we especially remember the people of Colombia who have suffered the devastating 7.4-magnitude earthquake. Many families are grieving the loss of loved ones, while others have lost their homes and possessions. We pray that

the coming weeks to assist our brothers and sisters in Colombia. Let us give generously, remembering that whatever we do for those who are suffering, we do for Christ Himself.

At the same time, we are called to pray for our own Commonwealth of Massachusetts. This past Monday, Governor Maura Healey signed legislation changing the state's restrictions concerning abortions after 24 weeks of pregnancy. The new law provides that "an abortion may be performed by a physician based upon the professional judgment of the physician."

Our Christian values call us to defend the vulnerable and uphold the sacred gift of human life at every stage. Let us pray for our governor, legislators, medical professionals, mothers, fathers, families, and especially for every child whose life is vulnerable. May God give our society wisdom, compassion, and courage to protect and cherish every human person.

As we ponder these concerns, we recall the words of the prophet Isaiah: "Observe what is right, do what is just... all who keep the

sabbath free from profanation and hold to my covenant, then I will bring to my holy mountain." The mountain in Scripture points us toward the presence of God and, ultimately, the hope of heaven. May our lives reflect faithful obedience to God's commands and a sincere desire to walk with Him.

Finally, let us ask for the faith of the Canaanite woman in today's Gospel—a faith that trusted Jesus even in the midst of hardship. May we never lose hope, but approach the Lord with humility, persistence, and confidence. May Jesus strengthen our families, heal those who suffer, guide our community, and deepen our love for every human life.

Happy Sunday to everyone, and may God bless you and your families.

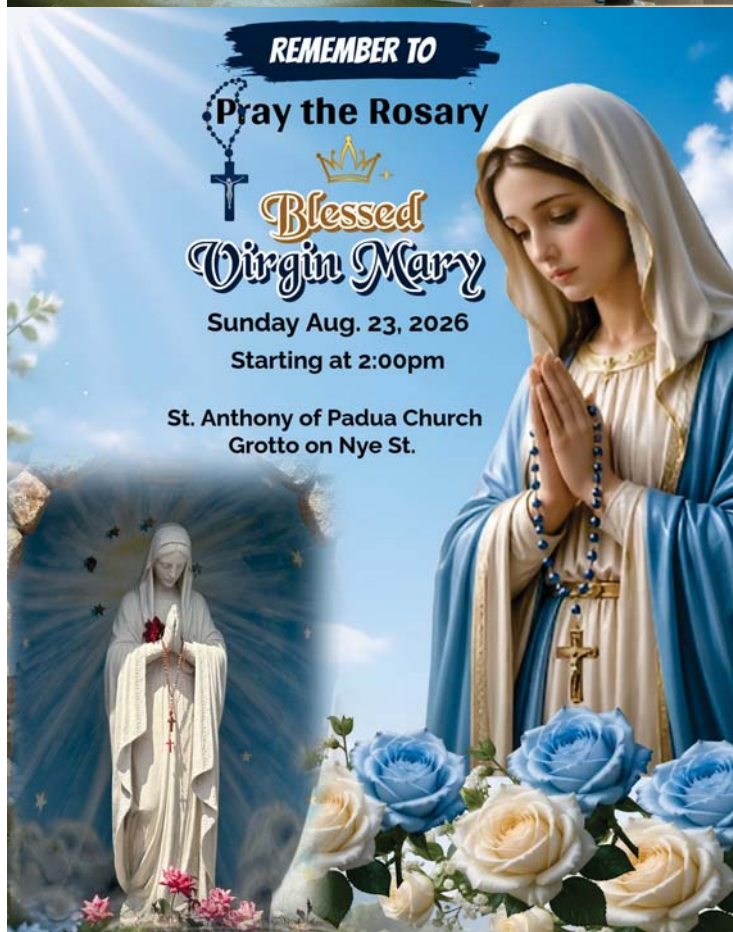

Responding to the Invitation to Make Rosaries for Bishop Fulton Sheen Canonization.

A group of faithful from the parish Legion of Mary, and parishioners with other faithful from the Franciscan Friars of the Immaculate - MIM and the Fatima Cenacle came together to help make the World Mission Rosary that was designed by Archbishop Sheen 75 years ago. The introduction of the World Mission Rosary was a concrete way to inspire Catholics to live out their baptismal call of mission through prayer to Our Lady, Queen of Apostles, for the success of the Church's missionary efforts across the world. Each decade of colored beads represents a different region of the world, inviting the faithful to pray for the people and needs of every continent where the Church and missionaries continue its mission of evangelization to share the Good News of Jesus. The nationwide effort to collect 75,000 handmade World Mission Rosaries for Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen's beatification schedule for Sept. 24, 2026 was initiated by Sister Jude Andrew Link, a Dominican Sister of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist based in Peoria, Illinois

The rosaries are to be handed out to attendees at his upcoming beatification Mass in St. Louis can pray together using his signature design. A special thank you to all involved and especially our Sister in Christ Mrs. Pat Greene our Rosary Making instructor. A Total of 250 Rosaries were mailed for the cause.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo: En este domingo, nuestros corazones se unen en oración por nuestros hermanos y hermanas de Colombia que han sufrido las consecuencias del devastador terremoto de magnitud 7.4 ocurrido recientemente. Muchas familias lloran la pérdida de sus seres



queridos, mientras otras han perdido sus hogares y sus pertenencias. Oremos por quienes han fallecido, para que Dios los reciba en su Reino; por los heridos y desplazados; y por todos aquellos que todavía buscan a sus familiares. Que el Señor conceda fortaleza, consuelo y esperanza a todo el pueblo colombiano.

Como comunidad parroquial, tendremos una colecta especial en los próximos domingos, en fechas que serán anunciadas oportunamente, para ayudar a las familias afectadas. Invito a todos a participar generosamente, recordando que nuestra fe nos llama a acompañar a quienes sufren no solamente con nuestras palabras, sino también con nuestras obras de misericordia.

También quiero pedirles que oremos por nuestro estado de Massachusetts. Esta semana se ha aprobado una legislación que elimina ciertas restricciones para los abortos después de las 24 semanas de gestación y permite que estas decisiones se realicen basándose en el juicio profesional del médico.

Como cristianos, estamos llamados a responder con oración, caridad y una firme defensa de la dignidad de toda persona humana. Nuestros valores cristianos nos invitan a proteger a los más vulnerables y a sostener el don sagrado de la vida en todas sus etapas. Oremos por nuestros gobernantes, médicos, madres, padres y familias, para que Dios les conceda sabiduría, compasión y

respeto por toda vida humana.

Al reflexionar sobre estas realidades, recordemos las palabras de la primera lectura: "Observen lo que es justo, practiquen la justicia... a todos los que guardan el sábado sin profanarlo y se mantienen fieles a mi alianza, los conduciré a mi monte santo." El monte santo es también un signo de la presencia de Dios y de la esperanza del cielo. Dios nos promete la vida eterna cuando permanecemos fieles a sus mandamientos y caminamos en sus caminos.

Pidamos también la fe de la mujer cananea en el Evangelio: una fe perseverante, humilde y llena de confianza en Jesús. Que nosotros también confiemos en el Señor, especialmente en los momentos difíciles, para que Él pueda realizar grandes cosas en nuestras vidas. Que Dios bendiga a Colombia, a nuestro estado de Massachusetts, a nuestra comunidad parroquial y a todas nuestras familias. ¡Feliz domingo para todos!
