



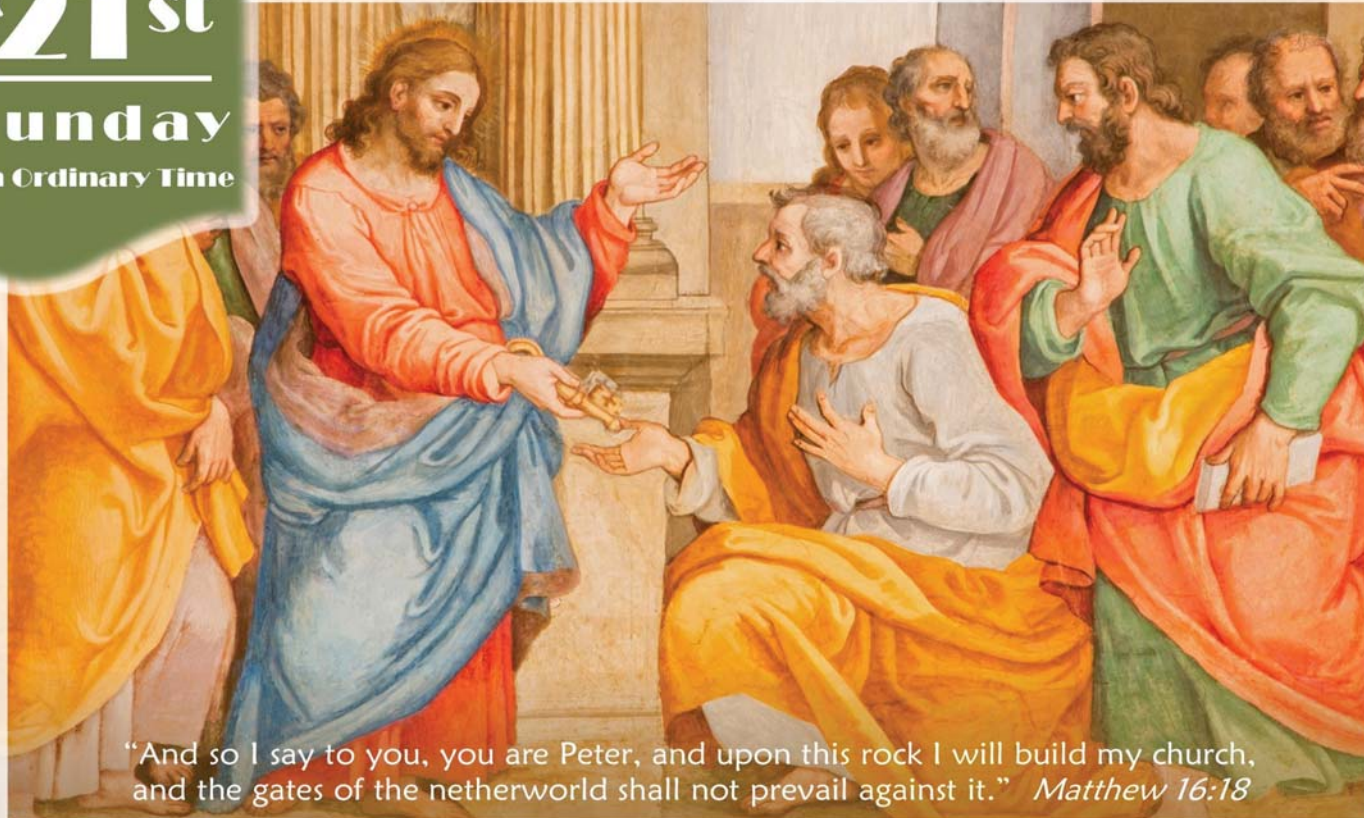

Pastor Message

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, at the end of this week, our children and young teens will begin their classes, and with them, our catechism and faith formation programs will also begin. Let us pray this Sunday for all our students and teachers. May this time of renewal after vacation bring them enthusiasm and joy, with hearts eager to learn, grow, and go deeper in their faith.

This year, we are also beginning adult classes in Portuguese for those preparing for First Communion and Confirmation. If you know someone who is returning to church, seeking to reconnect with the faith, or simply desires to learn more about Jesus and the Catholic faith, please invite them to join us on Friday evenings in the school gym at the Immaculate Conception Parish. Sometimes a simple invitation can become the first step toward a renewed relationship with God.

I invite all parishioners to participate in the Novena for the Nation, by joining together in praying the Holy Rosary and Eucharistic Adoration. At St. Anthony Parish, it will take

place on Wednesday, August 26, at 6:00 p.m. We look forward to seeing you there!

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus asks His disciples a very important question: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" Jesus is asking that same question of us today: Who do we say that He is? Are we able to answer with faith and confidence? Do we truly know who our Lord is?

Knowing Jesus is not something we should take for granted. This is why it is so important to know and deepen our faith. Jesus is not simply one teacher among many; He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. The more we know Him, the more deeply we can love Him, follow Him, and recognize His presence in our daily lives.

Peter was able to give the right answer because our Heavenly Father gave him a special grace to recognize Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God. We, too, have received wonderful gifts from our Heavenly Father. Through Baptism, we have received the gifts of faith, hope, and love. Yet these

gifts must be nurtured and strengthened throughout our lives.

Let us therefore ask our Heavenly Father to increase our faith and our desire to know Jesus more and more. Let us not allow our faith to remain something we practice only on Sundays. Let us seek to understand it, live it, and share it with others.

Dear friends, this new year of faith formation is an opportunity for all of us to grow closer to Christ. Bring your children, encourage our young people, and invite adults who desire to return or deepen their faith.

Come to Faith Formation, and come to know Jesus more deeply!

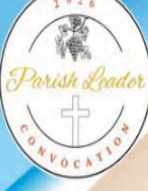

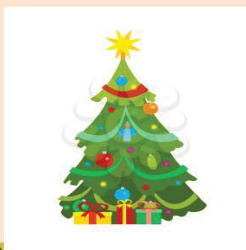

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos: al finalizar esta semana, nuestros niños y jóvenes comenzarán nuevamente sus clases y, con ellas, también nuestras clases de catequesis y formación en la fe. Después de este tiempo de descanso y vacaciones, pidamos al Señor que renueve el corazón de todos nuestros estudiantes y maestros, para que puedan comenzar este nuevo año con entusiasmo, alegría y un profundo deseo de aprender y crecer en la fe.

Este domingo, oremos especialmente por nuestros niños, adolescentes, jóvenes, catequistas y maestros. Que el Espíritu Santo los acompañe y les conceda la sabiduría, paciencia y alegría necesarias para aprender y enseñar. Que cada encuentro de formación sea una oportunidad para conocer más profundamente a Jesucristo, amar nuestra fe y descubrir cómo vivirla cada día.

Si conocen a alguien que está regresando a la Iglesia, o a alguna persona que desea aprender más sobre nuestra fe, los invito a hacerle una invitación personal. Los domin-

gos, después de la Misa de las 8:00 a. m., tendremos clases de formación en la fe en español en el salón parroquial para aquellos adultos que necesitan recibir la primera comunión o confirmación. Quizás una sencilla invitación sea precisamente lo que alguien necesita para comenzar o continuar su camino de fe.

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús hace a sus discípulos una pregunta muy importante: «¿Quién dice la gente que es el Hijo del Hombre?». Esta pregunta no pertenece solamente al pasado. Hoy Jesús también nos la dirige a nosotros: ¿Quién dices tú que soy? ¿Somos capaces de responder correctamente? ¿Conocemos verdaderamente quién es nuestro Señor?

Pedro pudo responder correctamente porque recibió una gracia especial de nuestro Padre celestial. También nosotros, por medio del Bautismo, hemos recibido grandes dones de Dios: la fe, la esperanza y el amor. Estos dones son una semilla que debemos cuidar y hacer crecer durante toda nuestra

vida. Por eso necesitamos pedir constantemente a nuestro Padre celestial que aumente nuestra fe y nos conceda un deseo cada vez mayor de conocer a Jesús, amarlo y seguirlo.

Conocer nuestra fe no es solamente aprender información religiosa. Es conocer a una Persona que nos ama y que ha entregado su vida por nuestra salvación. Jesús nos dice que Él es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Cuanto más lo conocemos, más profundamente podemos confiar en Él y caminar con Él.

Por eso, queridos hermanos, ¡vengan a la catequesis! Abramos nuestro corazón a la gracia de Dios y permitamos que nuestra fe crezca cada día.
