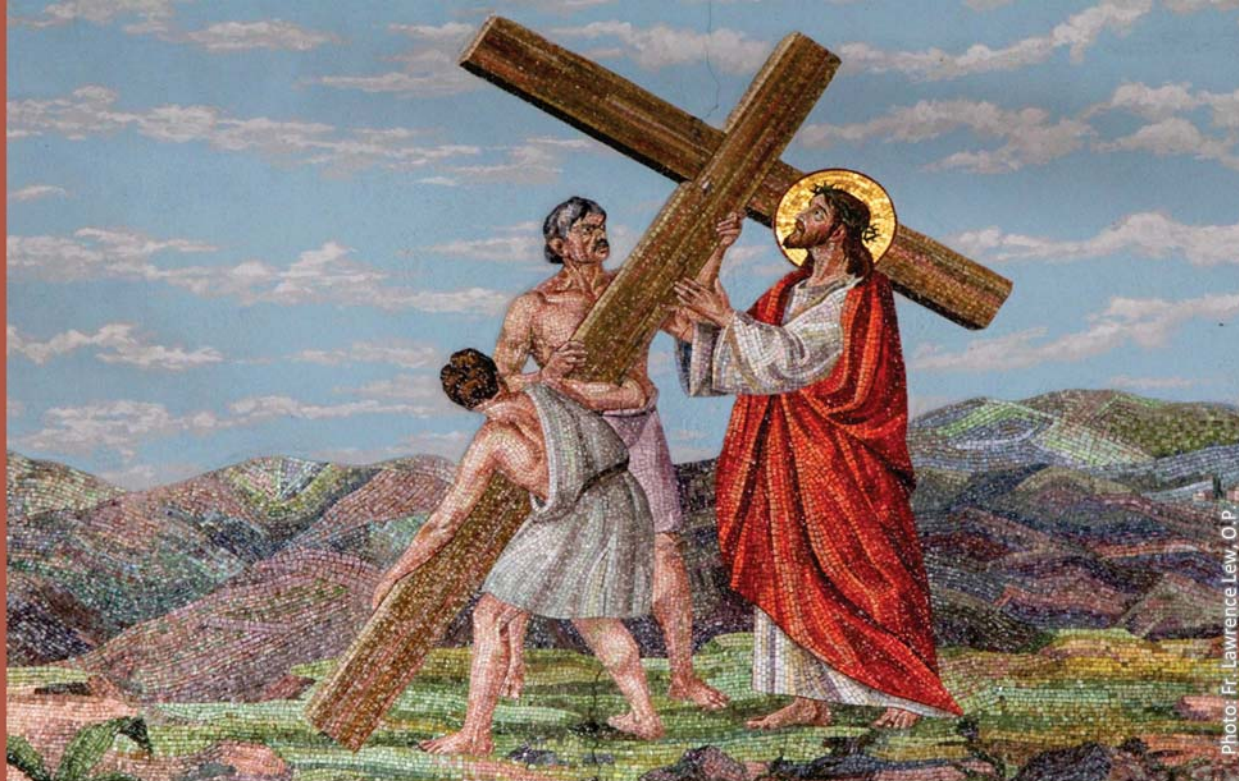

Pastor Message

Dear brothers and sisters, This Twenty-Second Sunday invites us to reflect deeply on the dialogue between Jesus and the Apostle Peter. After Jesus reveals that He must suffer, be rejected, and ultimately give His life, Peter takes Him aside and begins to rebuke Him: "God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you." Peter believes he

is protecting Jesus, defending Him, and even doing what is right. Yet Jesus responds sternly: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."

Peter's words came from love, but his understanding was shaped by a worldly way of thinking. He could not yet see that the path of Jesus was the path of the cross, sacrifice, obedience, and love.

We, too, can sometimes fall into the same temptation. We may convince ourselves that we are doing God's will while rejecting suffering, avoiding sacrifice, or trying to "kick away" the cross that God places before us. We can easily confuse our plans and desires with God's plan.

The world often presents an agenda that is contrary to the message of Jesus. Let us not be naïve and allow the world to dictate what we believe, how we live, or what we value. Instead, let us listen to Jesus and seek to think as God does. Following Christ does not mean choosing the easiest path; it means trusting Him, even when the way leads through sacrifice and the cross.

As we continue our journey as a parish community, we are also grateful for the work taking place in our church. The restoration inside the church and the work on the stained-glass windows continue. These projects are helping pre-

serve what has been and it is a "hallmark" in the city of New Bedford.

Thank you sincerely for your prayers, generosity, encouragement, and support in making this restoration a reality. Your commitment to our parish is a blessing, and together we continue to build and preserve a place where faith can be celebrated and witness.

May the Lord give us the grace to see beyond the ways of the world, embrace the cross with faith, and follow Him faithfully.

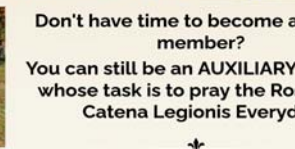

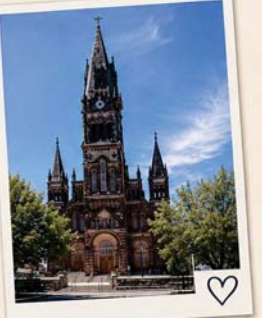

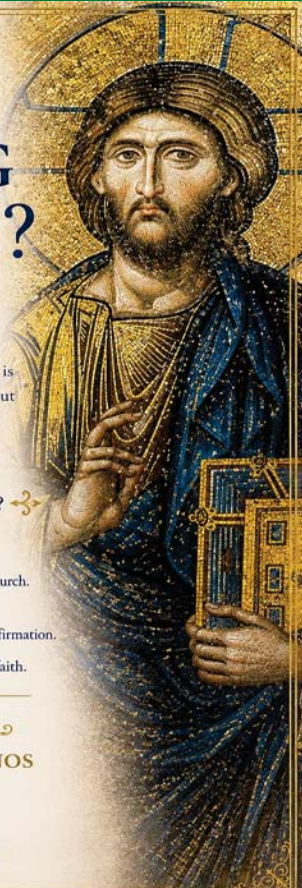

Saint Teresa of Calcutta

1910–1997

FEAST DAY: SEPTEMBER 5

Raised in a deeply Catholic family in Albania, Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu joined the Sisters of Loreto in 1928 and took the name Teresa. The community sent her to Kolkata, India, where she taught children for two decades. In 1946 Teresa heard God's call to quench the thirst of Jesus by caring for the poorest of the poor. She left the Sisters of Loreto to rescue the sick and destitute in the slums of Kolkata -- one at a time. Many volunteers soon joined her and she formed them into her religious order, the Missionaries of Charity. Teresa's manifest goodness and her unique media savvy attracted global attention, drawing many people to God. Many regard her as the greatest Catholic evangelist of the 20th century. She was beatified in 2003 and canonized in 2016.

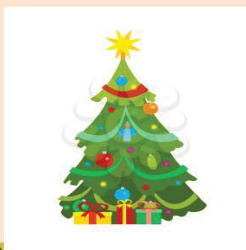

Mensaje del Padre Mariano

Queridos hermanos, en este Vigésimo Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, el Evangelio nos invita a reflexionar profundamente sobre el diálogo entre Jesús y el apóstol Pedro. Después de anunciar que tendría que sufrir, ser rechazado y entregar su vida, Pedro lleva a Jesús aparte y comienza a reprenderlo: «¡Dios no lo permita,

Las palabras de Pedro nacían del amor, pero estaban influenciadas por una manera de pensar humana y mundana. Pedro todavía no comprendía que el camino de Jesús sería el camino de la cruz, del sacrificio, de la obediencia y del amor entregado hasta el final.

También nosotros podemos caer en la misma tentación. A veces pensamos que estamos haciendo la voluntad de Dios cuando, en realidad, estamos tratando de evitar todo sufrimiento, rechazando el sacrificio o intentando quitar de nuestro camino la cruz que el Señor nos invita a cargar. Podemos llegar a confundir nuestros deseos, nuestros planes y nuestra manera de ver las cosas con la voluntad de Dios.

Señor! Eso no te sucederá jamás». Pedro pensaba que estaba protegiendo a Jesús, defendiéndolo y haciendo lo correcto. Sin embargo, Jesús le responde con firmeza: «¡Aléjate de mí, Satanás! Eres para mí un obstáculo, porque no piensas como Dios, sino como los hombres».

El mundo y sus criterios muchas veces son contrarios al mensaje de Jesús. Por eso, no seamos ingenuos permitiendo que el mundo dicte lo que debemos creer, valorar o vivir. Nuestra guía debe ser Cristo. No estamos llamados a pensar solamente como piensa el mundo, sino a aprender a pensar como

Dios y a confiar en Jesús, incluso cuando el camino incluye dificultades y sacrificios.

Como comunidad parroquial, también seguimos adelante con los trabajos de restauración de nuestra iglesia. Continúa la renovación del interior del templo y la restauración de los vitrales.

Agradecemos sinceramente sus oraciones, generosidad y apoyo. Gracias a ustedes, este proyecto de restauración sigue haciéndose realidad. Que Dios bendiga abundantemente a todos quienes han contribuido y continúan apoyando nuestra parroquia.

Que el Señor nos conceda la gracia de abrazar nuestra cruz con fe, confiar en su voluntad y seguir siempre sus pasos.
