

#### Comfort The Sick....


The Office of Pastoral Ministry to the Sick ministers to the sick and dying of all faiths and spiritual walks in all of the hospitals in the diocese. It offers a network of full and part-time chaplains who provide much-needed support in the form of visits, prayer, distribution of Communion, and administration of the Sacrament of the Sick to thousands of individuals.

*"I find a lot of holy moments throughout the day at the hospital. A lot of people, like the elderly, they don't get to Mass as often as they once did, because they don't drive anymore. They'll tell me, 'I haven't been since the beginning of COVID,' or 'I don't get out there.' And I reassure them, I say, 'Well, the Church comes out to you today.' And that's a beautiful thing. They receive Holy Communion, like they might not have in a few years. 



## Mensaje del Padre Marcelo

### EL BUEN PASTOR CONOCE SUS OVEJAS

Hoy, en el Evangelio, Jesús usa dos imágenes referidas a sí mismo: Él es el pastor. Y Él es la puerta. Jesús es el buen pastor que conoce a las ovejas. «Las llama una por una» (Jn 10,3). Para Jesús, cada uno de nosotros no es número; tiene con cada uno un contacto personal. El Evangelio no es solamente una doctrina: es la adhesión personal de Jesús con nosotros.

Y no sólo nos conoce personalmente. También personalmente nos ama. “Conocer”, en el Evangelio de san Juan, no significa simplemente un acto del entendimiento, sino un acto de adhesión a la persona conocida. Jesús, pues, nos lleva en su Corazón a cada uno. Nosotros también lo hemos de conocer así. Conocer a Jesús no implica solamente un acto de fe, sino también de caridad, de amor. «Examinaos si conocéis —nos dice san Gregorio Magno, comentando este texto— si le conocéis no por el hecho de creer, sino por el amor». Y el amor se demuestra con las obras.

Jesús es también la puerta. La única puerta. «Si uno entra por mí, estará a salvo» (Jn 10,9). Y poco más allá recalca: «Nadie va al Padre sino por mí» (Jn 14,6).


Hoy, un ecumenismo mal entendido hace que algunos sepiensen que Jesús es uno de tantos salvadores: Jesús, Buda, Confucio..., Mahoma, ¡qué más da! ¡No! Quien se salve se salvará por Jesucristo, aunque en esta vida no lo sepa. Quien lucha por hacer el bien, lo sepa o no, va por Jesús. Nosotros, por el don de la fe, sí que lo sabemos. Agradezcámolo. Esforcémonos por atravesar esta puerta, que, si bien esestrecha, Él nos la abre de par en par. Y demos testimonio de que toda nuestra esperanza está puesta en Él.

«Entra por la puerta el que entra por Cristo, el que imita la pasión de Cristo, el que conoce la humildad de Cristo, que siendo Dios se ha hecho hombre por nosotros» (San Agustín) «Jesucristo promete conducir las ovejas a los “pastos”, a las fuentes de la vida. Pero, ¿cuál es el alimento del hombre? Él vive de la verdad y de ser amado por la Verdad. Necesita a Dios, al Dios que se le acerca y le muestra el camino de la vida» (Benedicto XVI)



«La Iglesia, en efecto, es el redil cuya puerta única y necesaria es Cristo (Jn 10,1-10). Es también el rebaño cuyo pastor será el mismo Dios, como Él mismo anunció (cf. Is 40,11). Aunque son pastores humanos quienes gobiernan a las ovejas, sin embargo es Cristo mismo el que sin cesar las guía y alimenta; Él, el Buen Pastor y Cabeza de los pastores, que dio su vida por las ovejas» (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, nº 754)
