Pastor's message



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, in today's gospels Jesus is answering the question that someone asked, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" According to St. Cyril, Father of the Church, "The narrow gate signifies the labors and patience of the saints. Just as victory attests to the courage of the soldier in battle, so too does he who endures trials and temptations with unwavering patience become illustrious. It does not seem that the Savior satisfies the one who asks if there are many who are saved, when he says what is the way by which each one can be justified. But it should be noted that the Savior did not usually answer those who asked him, according to what they thought, when they did about unimportant things, but according to what could be useful to those who



listened to him. What could it matter to those who heard if there were many or few who were saved? It was more necessary to know the way by which each one could be saved. So out of his goodness, or by answering idle questions directly, he does so by speaking of what is most necessary." Our blessed Lord then, responded that in order to be saved, a Christian has to imitate him who to save the humankind, He had to endure the passion, crucifixion and death, in other words He went through the narrow gate. To be Christian in today's world is not an easy job, it means that we must start walking through narrow paths, which means,

avoiding certain places, people, circumstances, etc. A life simple dedicated to serve the Lord.

Christianity means a way of living which with God's grace we can bear witness to Christ. It will be awesome if each one of us can say as St. Paul did, "Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ." (I Cor 11:1) May we all respond to the Lord with generosity in doing his holy will on earth to gain eternal life.

"O God, who cause the minds of the faithful to unite in a single purpose, grant your people to love what you command and to desire what you promised, that, amid the uncertainties of this world, our hearts may be fixed on that place where true gladness is found. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Liturgy Corner

KYRIE ELEISON

confess..." the cantor will sing *kyrie eleison*, *Kriste eleison*, *kyrie eleison*. Is that Latin? No, it is not, it is a Greek word, which means "Lord, have mercy." This formula comes straight from the Gospel. Both the blind man of Jericho and the Canaanite woman cried, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Mk 10:46 and the lepers cried aloud, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" Lk 17:13.

This cry of supplication passed into the liturgy of Christians, for we too have to call upon the divine mercy. But it is obvious that this prayer pre-

supposes a previous declaration of our guilt. The *Kyrie* is a remnant of those litany dialogues, of those frequently long prayers which accompanied the procession of the celebrant up to the altar. It is originated in the Greek-speaking East, where the Spanish pilgrim Eteria heard it sung in Jerusalem about the year 390. you probably know that Greek, rather than Latin, was the prevalent liturgical language of the early

eighth century, the pope reduced the acclamations to just nine. The first three were addressed to God the Father. The second group of acclamations which in Rome became *Christe eleison* (Christ, have mercy on us), were addressed to God the Son; and the last three invocations to the Holy Spirit.

Nowadays the *Kyrie* is prayed by all, that is, alternately by the congregation and the choir or cantor. As a rule, each of the acclamations is said twice; but in some circumstances, it may be said more than twice, or a short verse (called a trope) may be interposed. If *Kyrie* is not sung, it is to be recited, either in English or in the original Greek.

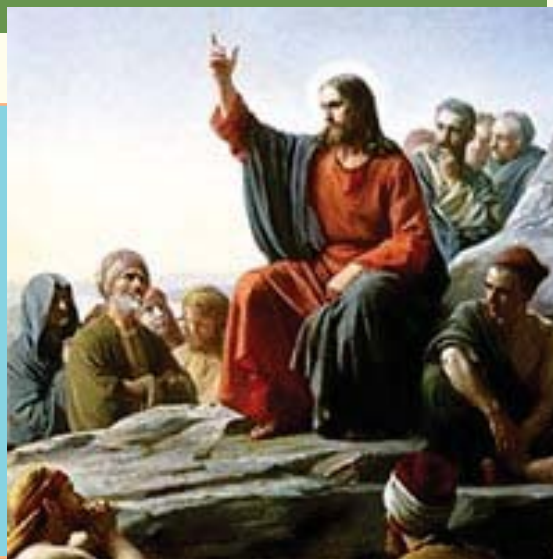

Mensaje del P. Marcelo

Señor, ¿son pocos los que se salvan?

Hoy, el evangelio nos sitúa ante el tema de la salvación de las almas. Éste es el núcleo del mensaje de Cristo y la “ley suprema de la Iglesia” (así lo afirma, sin ir más lejos, el mismo Código de Derecho Canónico). La salvación del alma es una realidad en cuanto don de Dios, pero para quienes aún no hemos traspasado las lindes de la muerte es tan solo una posibilidad. ¡Salvarnos o condenarnos!, es decir, aceptar o rechazar la oferta del amor de Dios por toda la eternidad.



Decía san Agustín que «se hizo digno de pena eterna el hombre que aniquiló en sí el bien que pudo ser eterno». En esta vida sólo hay dos posibilidades: o con Dios, o la nada, porque sin Dios nada tiene sentido. Visto así, vida, muerte, alegría, dolor, amor, etc. son conceptos desprovistos de lógica cuando no participan del ser de Dios. El hombre, cuando peca, esquiva la mirada del Creador y la centra sobre sí mismo. Dios mira incesantemente con amor al pecador, y para no forzar su libertad, espera un gesto mínimo de voluntad de retorno.

“Señor, ¿son pocos los que se salvan?” (Lc 13,23). Cristo no responde a la interpelación. Quedó entonces la pregunta sin respuesta, y también hoy, pues “es un misterio inescrutable entre la santidad de Dios y la conciencia del hombre. El silencio de la Iglesia es, pues, la única posición oportuna del cristiano” (San Juan Pablo II). La Iglesia no se pronuncia sobre quienes habitan el infierno, pero —basándose en las palabras de Jesucristo— sí que lo hace sobre su existencia y el hecho de que habrá condenados en el juicio final. Y todo aquel que niegue esto, sea clérigo o laico, incurre sin más preámbulos en herejía.



Somos libres para tornar la mirada del alma al Salvador, y somos también libres para obstinarnos en su rechazo. La muerte petrificará esa opción por toda la eternidad...

“Se entra en oración como se entra en la liturgia: por la puerta estrecha de la fe. A través de los signos de su presencia, es el rostro del Señor lo que buscamos y deseamos, es su palabra lo que queremos escuchar y guardar” (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n° 2.656)

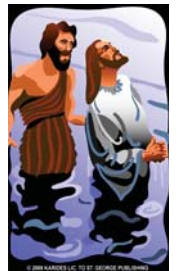
