

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear brothers and sisters, once again, we are about to begin the holy season of Lent. This season is, in the words of Pope Benedict XVI, "a privileged time of interior pilgrimage towards our heavenly Father who is the fount of



mercy. Lent is a pilgrimage in which his own son Jesus accompanies us through the desert of our poverty, sustaining us on our way towards the intense joy of Easter." (Message for Lent 2006) This annual period of exercises of piety is compose by penance, fasting, and almsgiving, and the aim is preparation for the coming celebration of Easter, and renewal of our spiritual soul through a personal conversion. It

is modeled in part on the forty days that Jesus spent in the desert prior to beginning his public ministry. The penance, fasting, and almsgiving are meant to help lead the believer to ongoing conversion and a deeper faith in

the Lord who redeemed us. The use of ashes is originated in both Old and New Testament. Ashes symbolize mourning, mortality, and penance. In the Book of Esther, Mordecai put on sackcloth and ashes when he heard of the decree of King Ahasuerus to kill all the Jewish people in

the Persian Empire (Esther 4:1). Job repented in sackcloth and ashes (Job 42:6). Prophesying the Babylonian captivity of Jerusalem, Daniel wrote, "I turned to the Lord God, pleading in earnest prayer, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes" (Daniel 9:3). King David after he had sinned, kept strict fast and passing his nights on the ground with ashes (cfr.2 Samuel 12:16); when Jonah preached that Nineveh will be de-

stroyed: "With that, the Ninevites shewed faith in God, rich and poor alike, proclaiming a fast and putting on sack-



cloth" (Jonas 3:5) Jesus made reference to ashes, "If the miracles worked in you had taken place in Tyre and Sidon, they would have reformed in sackcloth and ashes long ago" (Matthew 11:21) May all of us take serioursly this holy pilgrimage we are about to start so that we may grasp that our life is short, that sooner or later we have to meet our heavenly Father and give account of our stewardship, that this lent may be the best one, one that we want to empty ourselves of earthly attachments so that Christ may live within us. God bless you all.

LITURGY CORNER

Laws of Days of Abstinence: Current Practices

- Begins on one's 14th birthday
- Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent
- Obliges abstention from flesh meat

Laws of Days of Penance: Current Practice

- Applies to all the Faithfull
- Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent

Laws of Day of Fast: Current Practice

- Applies to everyone aged 18 to 59, inclusive.
- One full meal permitted, and two other meals may be taken which, when combined, are less than a full meal.

The obligation to do penance is lifted on Fridays that are also celebrated as a solemnity. For example this year we have March 25th: Solemnity of the Annunciation.

The Law of the Eucharistic Fast: Current Legislation

Under the New Code of Canon Law, the Fast for Holy Communion is one hour before the reception of the Holy Eucharist.



During the Season of Lent:

- The Gloria is omitted on Sundays.
- ◆ Lent runs from Ashe Wednesday until the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday which then begins the Sacred Paschal Triduum.
- The Alleluia is suppressed, also the word Alleluia wherever it occurs. The Alleluia verse is replace by Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!
- During Lent the altar should not be decorated with flowers, and musical instruments may be played only to give necessary support to the singing.
- On the Fourth Sunday of Lent ("Laetare") and on Solemnities and Feasts, musical instruments may be played and the altar decorated with flowers.



Mensaje del P. Marcelo

El Nombre del Señor es santo.

El segundo mandamiento prescribe respetar el nombre del Señor. Pertenece, como el primer mandamiento, a la virtud de la religión y regula más particularmente el uso



de nuestra palabra en las cosas santas. Entre todas las palabras de la Revelación hay una, singular, que es la revelación de su Nombre. Dios confía su Nombre a los que creen en Él; se revela a ellos en su misterio personal.

El don del Nombre pertenece al orden de la confidencia y la intimidad. "El nombre del Señor es santo". Por eso el hombre no puede usar mal de él. Lo debe guardar en la memoria en un silencio de adoración amorosa (cf Za 2, 17). No lo empleará en sus propias palabras, sino para bendecirlo, alabarlo y glorificarlo (cf Sal 29, 2; 96, 2; 113, 1-2).

La diferencia respecto a su Nombre expresa la que es debida al misterio de Dios mismo y a toda la realidad sagrada que evoca. El sentido de lo sagrado pertenece a la virtud de la religión: «Los sentimientos de temor y de "lo sagrado" ¿son sentimientos cristianos o no? [...] Nadie puede dudar razonablemente de ello. Son los sentimientos que tendríamos, y en un grado intenso, si tuviésemos la visión del Dios soberano.

Son los sentimientos que tendríamos si verificásemos su presencia. En la medida en que creemos que está presente, debemos tenerlos. No tenerlos es no verificar, no creer que está presente» (Juan Enrique Newman, Parochial and Plain Sermons, v. 5, Sermon 2).

El fiel cristiano debe dar testimonio del nombre del Señor confesando su fe sin ceder al temor (cf Mt 10, 32; 1 Tm 6, 12). La predicación y la catequesis deben estar penetradas de adoración y de respeto hacia el nombre de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica # 2142
