Pastor's message

Dear brothers and sisters, once again the Lord reminds us through the dialogue between Mary and Martha what is the most important part of our daily schedule. To appreciate much better the answer of Our Blessed Lord, we have to know the circumstances of the event. Bethany lies about two miles from Jerusalem. Jesus would stop there to rest in the home of his friends before going on up to the holy city. The three siblings, Martha, Mary and Lazarus were very friends and close to Jesus. He

felt at home in that place, surrounded by joy and affection. Now Martha is anxious because she wants to do everything to perfection and get a little bit upset that Mary is just "doing nothing" but being at the feet of Jesus. Jesus responds to Martha with an affectionate counsel, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and

troubled about many things, one thing is needful. Mary has chosen the good portion, which shall not be taken away from her." It is as if he said, Martha, you are worried about worldly affairs, but you are forgetting about me. You are deeply concerned about important tasks, but you are neglecting the most important one of all, which is union with God, personal sanctity. If your worries lead you to loose the presence of God while you work, those worries are not good for you, even though your work itself be good and

necessary. Jesus does not pass sweeping judgment on Martha or Mary, he responds to Martha's question by pointing to what is most important in life that being the presence of Christ into the house. How often might not the Lord make the same reproach to us? Nothing can justify for-



getting Jesus in our daily work, not even the most important of concerns. I have to do this at home, I cannot go right now, next week and many other things like that. We cannot put him who is the Lord of all things aside for the sake of the things of the Lord. We cannot minimize the importance of prayer with the excuse that we are too busy with apostolate, with others activities and works of charity, etc. Let us be on guard and never allow worldly matters to interfere between God and us. Ask the Holy Spirit to put God above all things, then the rest.

Liturgy Corner

Have you ever wonder about the silence in the liturgy? At time we forget what important is the silence in the liturgy. God speaks to us in the silence of our hearts. If we make silence within us we will be able to hear clearly and audible the voice of God and carrying it in our life. This is the passage of the scripture that tells us where to find God.

"The Lord said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by." Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake came a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper. When Elijah heard it, he pulled his

cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave. Then a voice said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?" (1 King 19:11-13)

Number 45 of the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (Third and Emended Typical Edition, 2008) prescribes:



Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times. Its purpose, however, depends on the time it occurs in each part of the celebration. Thus within the Act of Penitence and again after the invitation to pray, all recollect themselves; but at the conclusion of a reading or the homily, all meditate briefly on what they have heard; then after Communion, they praise and pray to God in

their hearts. Even before the celebration itself, it is commendable that silence be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred action in a devout and fitting manner.

Paragraph 30 of the Liturgy Constitution, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, likewise prescribes: "And at the proper times all should observe a reverent silence." Number 56 of the General Instruction specifies better the importance of silence within the Liturgy of the Word, while number 78 makes the same clear for the Liturgy of the Eucharist: "The Eucharistic Prayer demands that all listen to it with reverence and in silence." Number 84 then underscores the importance of the observance of silence as a means of good preparation for the reception of Holy Communion: "The priest prepares himself by a prayer, said quietly, that he may fruitfully receive Christ's Body and Blood. The faithful do the same, praying silently."






