

## Mensaje del Padre Marcelo

«Jesús estaba en oración...

‘Señor, enséñanos a orar’»

Hoy, Jesús en oración nos enseña a orar. Fijémonos bien en lo que su actitud nos enseña. Jesucristo experimenta en muchas ocasiones la necesidad de encontrarse cara a cara con su Padre. Lucas, en su Evangelio, insiste sobre este punto.



¿De qué hablaban aquel día? No lo sabemos. En cambio, en otra ocasión, nos ha llegado un fragmento de la conversación entre su Padre y Él. En el momento en que fue bautizado en el Jordán, cuando estaba orando, «y vino una voz del cielo: ‘Tú eres mi hijo; mi amado, en quien he puesto mi complacencia’» (Lc 3,22). Es el paréntesis de un diálogo tiernamente afectuoso.

Cuando, en el Evangelio de hoy, uno de los discípulos, al observar su recogimiento, le ruega que les enseñe a hablar con Dios, Jesús responde: «Cuando oréis, decid: ‘Padre, santificado sea tu nombre...’» (Lc 11,2). La oración consiste en una conversación filial con ese Padre que nos ama con locura. ¿No definía Teresa de Ávila la oración como “una íntima relación de amistad”: «estando muchas veces tratando a solas con quien sabemos que nos ama»?

Benedicto XVI encuentra «significativo que Lucas sitúe el Padrenuestro en el contexto de la oración personal del mismo Jesús. De esta forma, Él nos hace participar de su oración; nos conduce al interior del diálogo íntimo del amor trinitario; por decirlo así, levanta nuestras miserias humanas hasta el corazón de Dios».

Es significativo que, en el lenguaje corriente, la oración que Jesucristo nos ha enseñado se resuma en estas dos únicas palabras: «Padre Nuestro». La oración cristiana es eminentemente filial.

La liturgia católica pone esta oración en nuestros labios en el momento en que nos preparamos para recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo. Las siete peticiones que comporta y el orden en el que están formuladas nos dan una idea de la conducta que hemos de mantener cuando recibamos la Comunión Eucarística.



## Registración Parroquial

¿Esta usted y su familia registrado?

Si tiene más de 18 años y asiste a Misa con regularidad, le pedimos que se registre como miembro de la Parroquia de San Antonio de Padua.

Tres razones principales por las que es importante registrarse:

### 1. Facilita la preparación sacramental cuando llegue el momento.

El bautismo, la registración en la catequesis, ser padrinos de bautismos o confirmaciones, y especialmente casarse (ya sea que se case en esta parroquia, en otra parroquia o tenga una boda católica internacional) todo esto involucran la importancia de la participación parroquial. Si usted es un parroquiano no registrado, esto retrasará mucho el proceso.

### 2. Cartas de recomendación.


