

Pastor's message

Dear brothers and sisters today in the gospel reading Jesus sends out a number of disciples to proclaim the kingdom of God. He knows that the time was short and the work too much. He calls and sends disciples in pair, seventy-two of them says the gospel.

Jesus sends them out with instructions, "carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals, salute no one on the road..." in other words, don't worry about bag packing, this is not a picnic. Jesus also gives them power because he knew that the mission would be dangerous, to the point that some of them pride themselves that they have seen Satan falling



like lightning from the sky. Jesus still sends out his disciples into the world today and his disciples are all us who call ourselves Christians. The mission of Jesus didn't finish when he died, his mission continues today as we answered promptly our vocation to be the light of the world. The new missionaries are all of us in the vocation we answer to the Lord, either husband or

wife, widow, widower, single person. Are you willing to say Yes to Jesus? Then, let's work that his message may reach to the end of the world. Let's work so that our parish of St. Anthony will continue flourishing with parishion-

ers who will fill the church in praise and thanksgiving to God. Let us commit ourselves to invite one more person to get to know Christ and his gospel. Lord we say yes to you at all times.

Happy 4th of July: "America was founded on the truth that all men and women are created equal, with God-given rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. This truth was grievously denied by the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade ruling, which legalized and normalized the taking of innocent human life. We thank God today that the Court has now overturned this decision. We pray that our elected officials will now enact laws and policies that promote and protect the most vulnerable among us."

Hoy, la Iglesia contempla como, además de los Doce, había numerosos discípulos que seguían al Señor y habían sido llamados por Él. De entre todos aquellos discípulos, Jesucristo elige setenta y dos para una misión concreta. Les exige —lo mismo que a los Apóstoles— total desprendimiento y abandono completo en la Providencia divina.

El Concilio Vaticano II, en el Decreto Apostolicam actuositatem, nos recuerda que desde el Bautismo cada cristiano es llamado por Cristo a cumplir una misión. La Iglesia, en nombre del Señor, «ruega encarecidamente a los laicos que gustosa generosidad de ánimo, a Cristo que los invita con mayor insistencia, y a los impulsos del Espíritu Santo. Sientan los jóvenes que esa llamada va dirigida a ellos de modo particular; recíbanla con entusiasmo y magnanimitad. Es el propio Señor el que invita de nuevo a todos los laicos, por medio de este santo Concilio, a que se le unan cada día más íntimamente y a que, sintiendo como propias sus cosas, se asocien a su misión salvadora; de nuevo los envía a todas las ciudades y lugares a donde Él ha de ir, para que, con las diversas formas y maneras del único apostolado de la Iglesia que deberán adaptar constantemente a las nuevas necesidades de los tiempos, se le ofrezcan como cooperadores, abundando sinceramente en la obra del Señor y sabiendo que su trabajo no es inútil delante de Él» (n.33).


